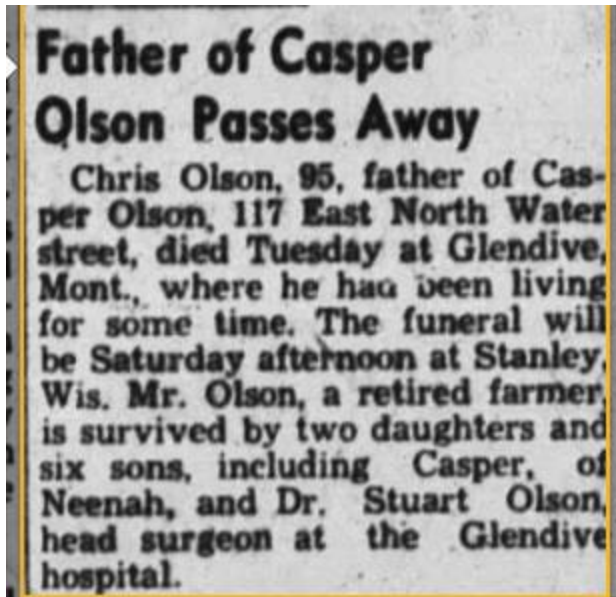
### OLSON SERVICES.

Stuart A. Olson practiced medicine in Glendive for 34 years, serving as chief surgeon of Northern Pacific Hospital from 1958 until retiring in 1970. He then entered Republican politics, serving in the House of Representatives from Dawson County from 1971 to 1976 and in the Senate from 1976 to 1982 when he retired.
