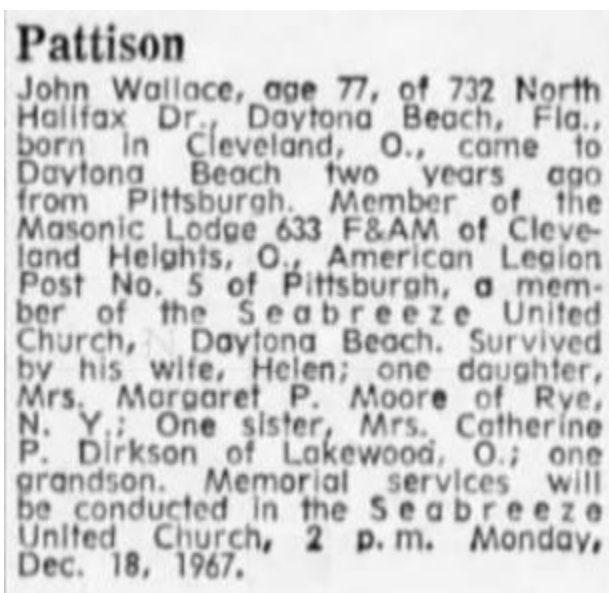

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Will & Codicil

I, Carrie Brew Pattison, of Cleveland, Ohio, being of full age and of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills by me heretofore made.

First: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate.

Second: I give and bequeath my diamond ring unto my granddaughter, Catherine Margaret Dirkson. Any transfer or inheritance tax attaching thereto shall be paid from the residue of my estate.

Third: I direct my Executors hereinafter named to erect an appropriate marker at my grave in the Ellen M. Brew lot in Section 23, Lot 68, Lakeview Cemetery, Cleveland, Ohio, and to endow my grave with perpetual care.

Fourth: I desire to treat my three children all alike and in order that my estate may be protected and preserved, my Executors must have ample opportunity for conversion of my estate into cash. I realize that the market is not now and may not at the time of my death be broad enough or favorable enough to permit an early and, at the same time, an advantageous conversion of my securities or interests in real estate. Hence immediate division or distribution of my estate may not be possible and should not be forced. Consequently I direct that all my real estate or interests in real estate be sold and converted into cash by my Executors, but it is my special intention and purpose hereby to give my Executors unlimited discretion as to the time, manner and terms of actual sale or conversion. In the meantime, my Executors shall have power to lease, repair, restore or mortgage such real estate and the improvements thereon.

Fifth: As respects the securities of which I may die possessed, I authorize my Executors, without liability upon their part, to retain in kind and to hold for distribution or division in kind, any or all of them.

Sixth: I give and bequeath all the residue of my estate unto my three children, George Brew Pattison, of Manistee, Michigan, Catherine Pattison Dirkson, of Cleveland, Ohio, and Wallace J. Pattison, of Pittsburgh, Penna., share and share alike.

Seventh: None of the beneficiaries under this Will shall have power to anticipate, assign or encumber his or her share or interest in my estate, but the same shall be payable only to such beneficiary personally. No such interest shall be subject to attachment, execution, or other process by their creditors.

Eighth: I nominate and appoint my son, Wallace J. Pattison, and The Cleveland Trust Company of Cleveland, Ohio, to be the Executors of this, my Last Will and Testament, and I request that no bond be required of them as such. I further request that no inventory of my estate be made or taken in so far as the same may be lawfully omitted.

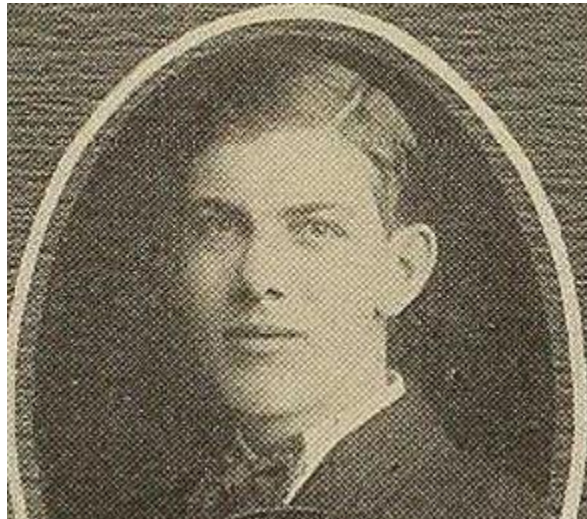
