Hit by Light Truck New Haven Man Dies

New Haven, Dec. 23.—(AP.)—John T. Pettit, 62, of West Haven, a yard switchman for the "New Haven" Railroad, died in New Haven Hospital today from injuries suffered late Friday when he was struck by a light truck on Water Street near the railroad depot.

New Haven Hospital attaches said Pettit suffered fractures of both legs and other injuries.

Patrolman Nathan J. Perlman reported that the vehicle was operated by Joseph Maresca, 50, of New Haven, and that the driver was being held on a charge of violating the motor vehicle laws.

Pettit leaves his wife, a daughter, two sisters and a brother. He was a veteran of the Spanish-American War.

New Haven, Sept. 17. — (AP.)— Captain of Detectives James J. Deegan said tonight a man giving the name of Earl Clark, 27, of Bridgeport, had been arrested after a View Street resident found him in his home.

Captain Deegan said the man was arrested by Patrolmen Nathan J. Perlman and Robert H. McCoy after the intruder allegedly gave battle to Martin Koziel, 50, in whose house he was apprehended.

Koziel was quoted by Captain Deegan as saying he returned home about 2 p. m. and found a man roaming through his personal effects. With Koziel at the time was his son.

The detective head said Clark admitted six house breaks saying he had pawned the loot.

New Haven Police Accuse Two Men Of Trying 'Drop Pocketbook' Game

New Haven, July 27.—(AP.)—The "drop the pocketbook" game, which has mulcted many New Haven victims in the past, backfired today for two New York men who were arrested on technical charges of idleness and held in \$5000 bail each.

Captain of Detectives Raymond J. Egan said the men gave their names as Clarence Morris, 50, and Felton Harris, 38, and that they had been identified by Idella Mae Mitchell of West Haven and Esther L. West of New Haven as would-be perpetrators of the "drop the pocketbook" game.

The fraud, as operated successfully in New Haven many times, works something like this:

One of a scheming pair approaches a victim and strikes up a conversation. His confederate, pretending to be a stranger, comes along with the news that he has just found a pocketbook

containing a sum of money. He offers to divide the money with the other two, but the intended victim first is required to produce money of his own as a sign of good faith. If the game works as it's supposed to, the victim is left with his good faith and no money.

Police said Mrs. Mitchell charged that Morris and Harris made such a proposition to her on a downtown street today, but Mrs. Mitchell, recalling that a relative of hers recently had lost \$40 in a similar swindle, went into a store and asked a clerk to call a detective.

Detective Nathan J. Perlman arrested one of the men and Policeman Michael McCaffrey the other.

After the arrest, Mrs. West identified the pair as two men who had tried unsuccessfully to interest her in a "lost" pocketbook, police reported.

Sometimes her husband is referred to as “Louis Gold” but he is Samuel Meyer Gold (originally Goldfarb), whom she married 17 Aug 1902 in Manhattan NY. Samuel was born 10 Apr 1877 in Russia (which became Poland), the son of Meyer Gold. He died 18 Oct 1946 Jersey City, Hudson NJ. Samuel & Lena are buried in Washington Cemetery, Brooklyn, Kings NY.
