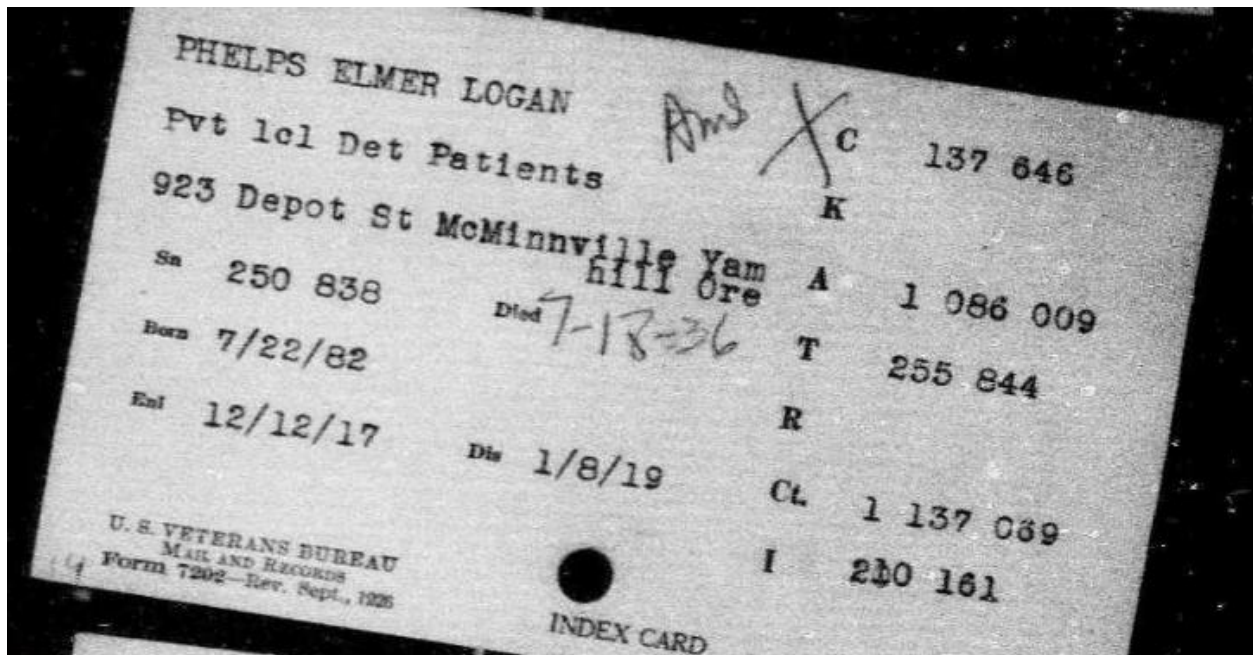

CLARKSTON, Wash., Jan. 19. —Funeral services will be on Thursday at 2 p. m. at Merchants' funeral chapel for Mrs. Jessie Campbell, 84, who died Sunday at Tri-State Memorial hospital.

Mrs. Campbell was born in Kansas and moved to Portland with her parents when a child. She attended and graduated from school and taught school there until she married J. M. Bramhall. They moved to Ames, Ore., where he was in the lumber business.

After the death of Mr. Bramhall, Mrs. Campbell was married to John Campbell of Spencer, Idaho. The couple farmed in that area until about 15 years ago, when they moved to Clarkston Heights. Mr. Campbell died in 1953 and his widow then made her home in Clarkston.

Mrs. Campbell devoted much of her time to working in the Salvation Army citadel.

Survivors include two sons and two daughters, Arthur Bramhall of Anheim, Ore.; Joe Bramhall of Klamath Falls, Mrs. Crystal Blair of Clarkston and Mrs. Lillian Paterson of Aberdeen, Wash.; two brothers, six grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

BROTHER ACCUSES \ BROTHER

Returned Soldier Makes Charge, Involving Wife; Couple Arrested.

Frank Phelps and Eva Phelps were arrested Thursday, the former at Bull Run, and the latter at Gresham, by Deputy Sheriffs Christofferson and Beckman, on a statutory charge, preferred by Elmer P. Phelps, late of the 20th engineers, who accuses his wife and his brother of improprieties during his absence in France. He left with his regiment, for Europe in December, 1917, he told officials, leaving his wife and his three children in his brother's care. He returned January 11.

The wife, who is 23 years old, was released on her own recognizance. The brother is held in the county jail in default of \$500 bail.

Buck and Elnora Monroe Endowed Scholarship designed to Supports Veterans and Single Parents

Elnora Phelps' heart was always set on attending Linfield College in McMinnville, Oregon, but WWI had other plans for her and her family. Elnora's dad served in World War I and came back with a disability. He had always promised Elnora she could attend Linfield, but he passed away when she was only 16 and she was no longer able to attend. It's something she always wished she had accomplished.

Elnora met Buck Monroe in 1947 while he was completing his education at Linfield College. They married and had three children. Buck was also a military man having enlisted and served in the Navy as a radio man on a Destroyer in WWII. He was the first in his family to attend College; the GI Bill made it possible. "I don't think Buck could have gone to school without the GI Bill. It was the financing he needed to get there," said Elnora.

Both Buck and Elnora lived a life of service. Buck was an educator and coach who began his career at the high school level and then later transitioned to Clackamas Community College as a counselor and coach. As a counselor he worked with veterans to help them stay on course. Elnora worked at two iconic Oregon landmarks. She was the manager of the gift shop at the Vista House and also the one at Multnomah Falls.

Buck passed away in 2010, and after attending the Mildred Davy Memorial Scholarship and Recognition Luncheon with her daughter Kathy Shaw, who serves on the TBCC Foundation board, Elnora started thinking about beginning a scholarship endowment. "I heard the stories at the luncheon of the students

who received scholarships and I wanted to help working mothers and working fathers to get their education," she said.

She began building toward an endowment in 2011 and in 2016 the first Buck and Elnora Monroe Endowed Scholarship was awarded. The scholarship includes a preference for veterans and single parents. "I chose to create the scholarship at TBCC because it is a growing community college with strong plans for the future," she said. "I believe in the future of the college."
