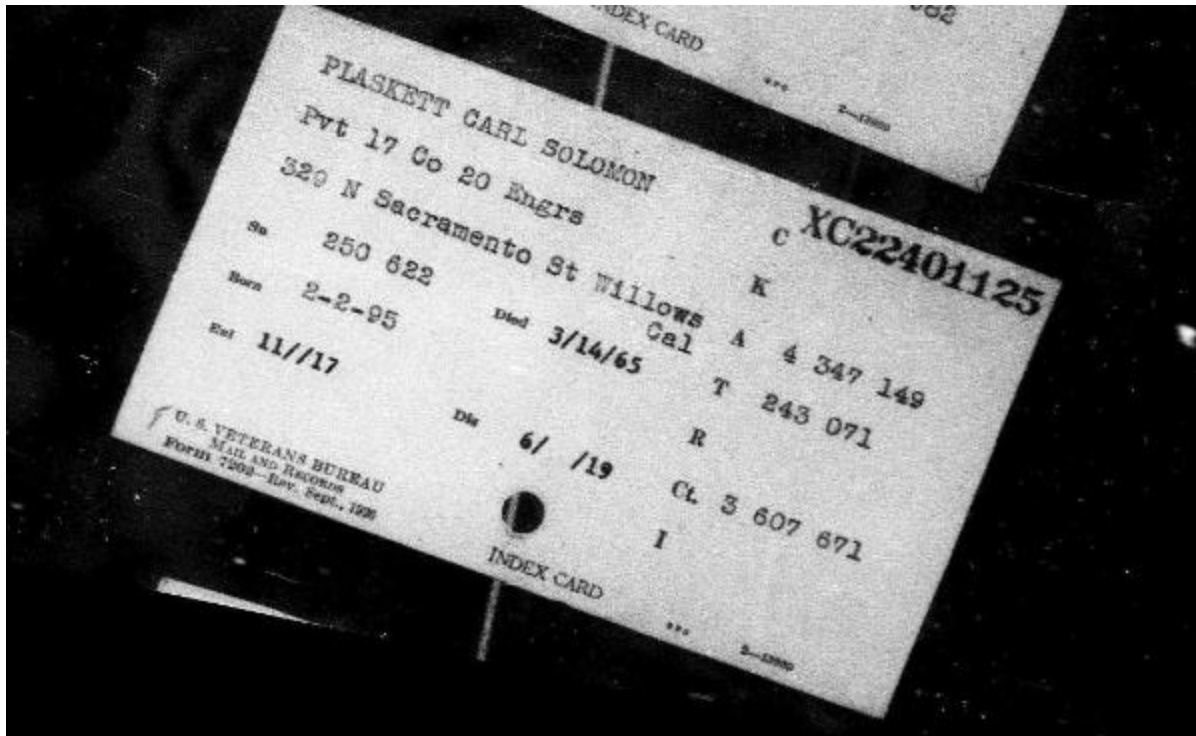
Rev. Sam Landerman, pastor of the First Methodist Church, will officiate. Interment will be in the Willows Veterans Cemetery.

SON OF BYRON G. PLASKETT FILES PETITION FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION.

Edward A. Plaskett of Gorda, through his attorney, Wallace M. Pence, has filed in the superior court a petition for letters of administration on the estate of his late father, Byron G. Plaskett, a prominent Monterey county pioneer who passed away at his home in the southern part of the county a month ago, leaving no will. The estate is community property and is estimated to be of the value of nearly \$10,000. It consists of 920 acres of grazing land and improvements, valued at \$5,000; 75 head of mixed cattle, valued at \$1,000; horses, \$500; cash, \$851.48; bills receivable, \$69.79; and a residence and three lots in Salinas valued at \$1500.

The heirs are the widow, Mrs. Martha G. Plaskett, and the following sons, daughters and grandchildren: Wm. D. Plaskett and Charles H. Plaskett of Monterey, Mrs. Frances M. Shang of Jolon, Mrs. Mary Matilda Palmer of Paso Robles, Edward A. Plaskett and Lawson M. Plaskett of Gorda, Mrs. Lucy E. Davis of Santa Maria, Mrs. Fannie M. Mansfield of Gorda, Wesley B. Plaskett of Gorda, and Clarence L., Helen I., Archie, Muriel A., and Albert A. Plaskett of Lockwood. The five last named are grandchildren.

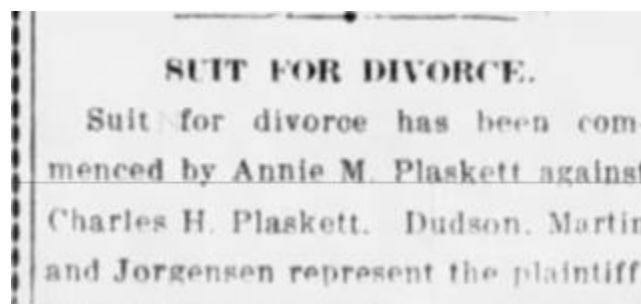

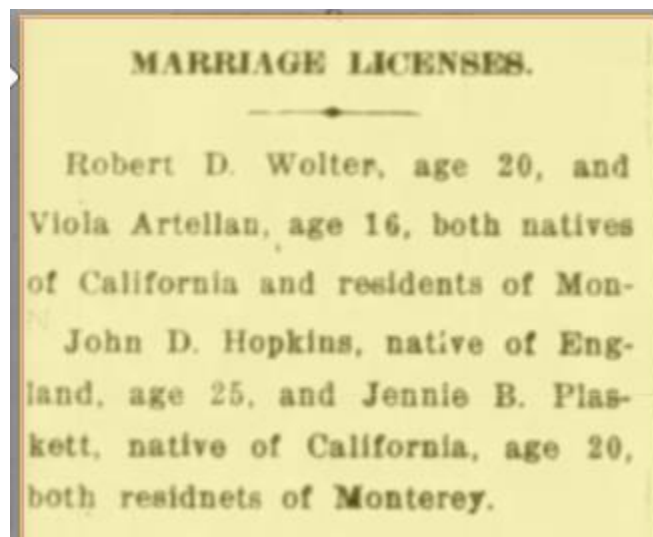

DIVORCE IS SOUGHT BY MONTEREY WOMAN AT SALINAS

Jennie Bernice Hopkins yesterday brought suit for divorce in the Superior court against John D. Hopkins.

The couple were married at Monterey August 20, 1918, and separated February 12, 1918. There is one child, aged one year, but no community property.

Divorce is being sought on the ground that defendant, for more than one year, has "failed to provide plaintiff with the common necessities of life by reason of his idleness, profligacy and dissipation," and on the farther ground that in the Superior Court of Alameda County, on August 15, 1921, defendant was convicted of a felony.

Plaintiff asks \$30 a month for the maintenance of the minor child, and asks custody of the child.

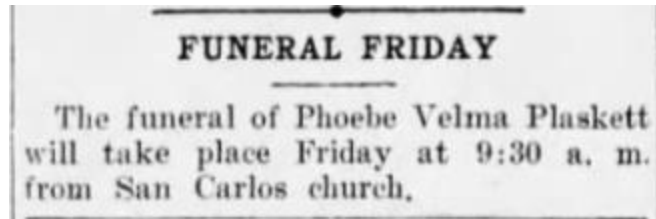
