Seven Prisoners Steal Clothes And Flee Jail

Six Others Left Naked In Upshur
County Jail Remain In
Lock-Up

[Special Dispatch to The Sun]

Buckhannon, W. Va., March 5—
Seven prisoners crawled through a
hole in the wall apparently dug from
the outside and fled the Upshur county
jail here early today, all being at
large late today. Six others declined
a chance to escape because they were
naked. The fleeing men stole their
clothing.

The escaped men are Thomas Cur-
rence, Aubrey Rinehart, Harry Hall,
Bantie Bacorn, Lawrence Smith, K. A.
Simons and Hobart Quick, the last
named being held on a lunacy charge.
Various charges were pending against
the others.

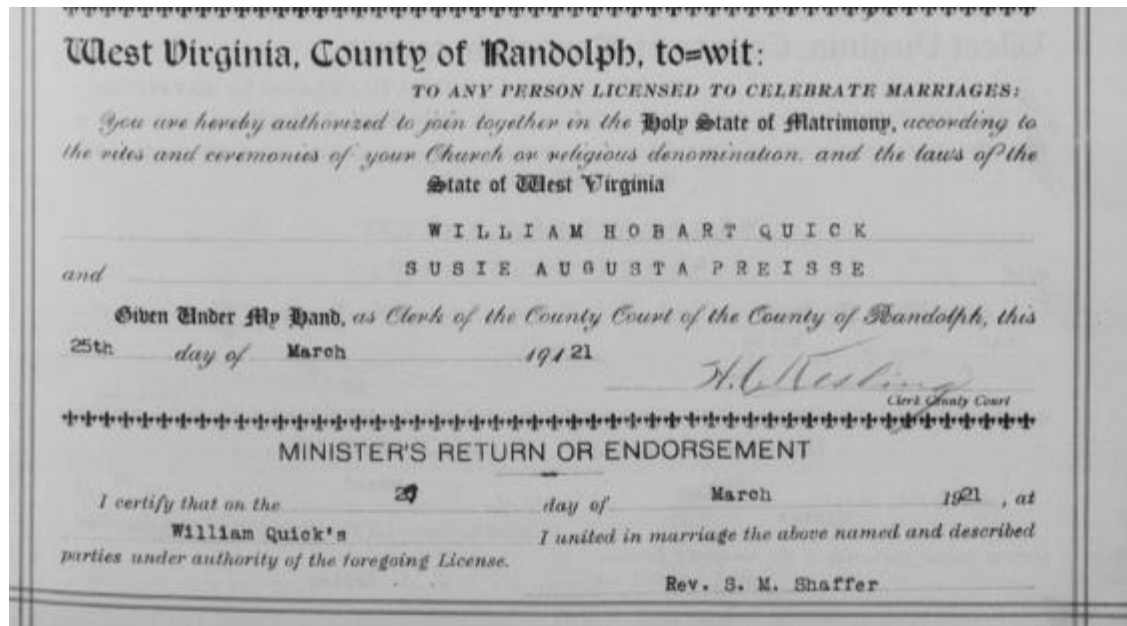

"Baltimore Sun" 6 Mar 1934 p 21 - Buckhannon WV: 7 prisoners crawled through a hole in the wall dug from the outside & fled the Upshur Co. WV jail early 5 Mar 1934 & are at large. Six other prisoners declined to escape since they were naked, the escapees having taken all their clothes. Hobart Quick was being held "on a lunacy charge/" Three days after the jail break, Hobart is placed in the Veterans Hospital in Chillicothe, Ross OH (admission date 8 May 1934) where he will stay until his death on 22 Aug 1965. His WV death record lists his hospitalization as lasting 11,366 days.
