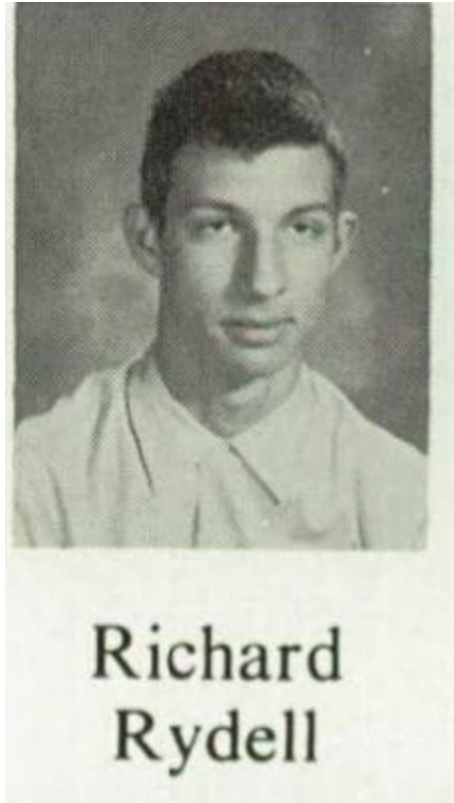

Maurice G. Rydell, 84, Carmel, died Sunday in a local nursing home. Born at St. Paul, Minn., he was an Indianapolis area resident one year. He was retired from Westinghouse Corp. Memorial contributions may be made to the Indianapolis chapter of Red Cross. A memorial service will be arranged by Leppert and Copeland Mortuary. Survivors include a son, Robert G. Rydell.

— Morris Rydell, 15 roků starý, v čís. 832 Pusey ul., raněn byl snad smrtelně kulí z 22kalibrové rifle při honu veverek v neděli, v lese St. Anthony parku. Osudná rána vyšla nahodile z rifle jeho společníka Franka Wrighta, 17 roků starého, a sice při chůzi skrze hustý podrost, kde kohoutek zbraně zachytil za proutek. Vypálená kule trefila Rydella, jenž šel napřed, do zad a prolétla životními orgány těla. Raněný nalézá se v kritickém stavu v nemocnici. Jiný případ nahodilého zranění střelnou zbraní udál se v domě F. G. Linenfelsera v čís. 63 Macalester ave., kde v neděli večer nalezena byla pí. Linenfelserová svým mužem na podlaže se střelnou ránou v hrudi. Raněná žena byla dosud při vědomí a dle jejího tvrzení vyšla rána z revolveru, když vypadl ze zásuvky v almaře, kde hledala nějaké věci, aby se mohla přistrojiti na večerní táčky.

“Minnesotske Noviny” [Czech newspaper] Thursday 25 Sep 1913 p 2 – translated on online Czech-to-English website. Morris Rydell, age 15, was hunting squirrels in the forest at St. Anthony Park MN with his 17-year-old companion Frank Wright, who shot Morris in the back with a .22-calibre rifle bullet. The bullet discharged when the “cock” of the gun caught on a “rod.” Rydell fell forward & the bullet passed through vital organs. He was in critical condition in the hospital.
