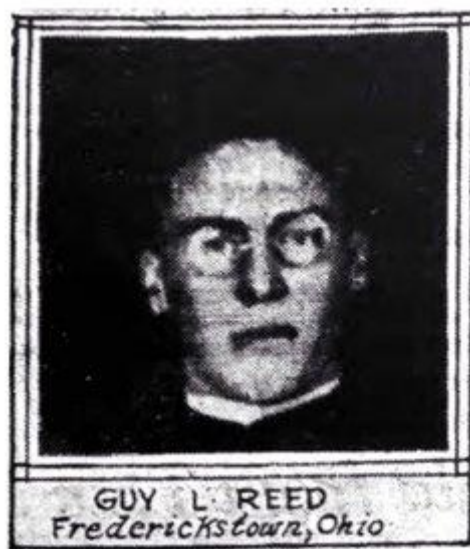

TUSCANIA PASSENGER WRITES BRIEF NOTE

Guy L. Reed Merely Reports He Is In Land Of The Living

SPARTA, March 14—Mr. and Mrs. Carl Reed have received a card from their nephew, Guy L. Reed, who was one of the boys on board the ill-fated Tuscania, written "somewhere in England." Reed says, in connection with his trip over and his health, "I am all O. K. Was sick some of the way over, but nothing serious."

Mrs. Bert Hulse, a sister of Harry McCormick, who was also in the 100th Aero Squadron with Reed, received a letter from her brother saying that both were well, but this is the first word received from Reed. His uncle and aunt reside north of Fredericktown.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by his loving wife, Janet Raylene Reed, and a sister, Rosalie Baker.

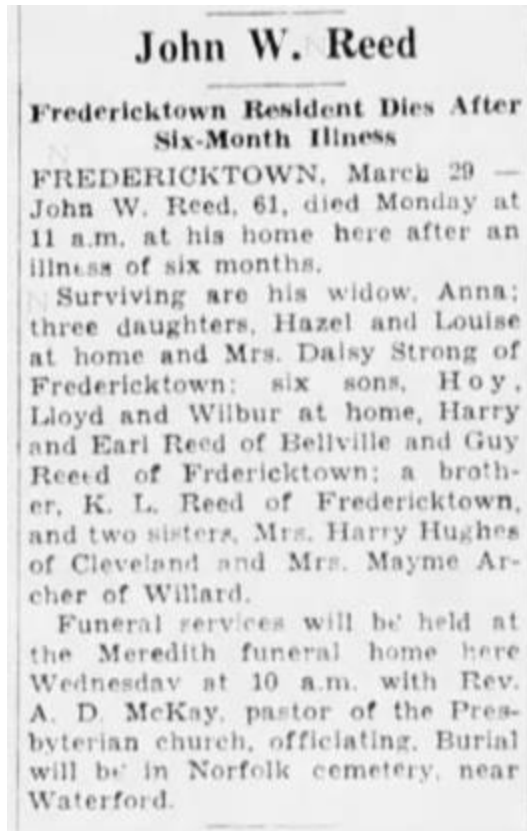

being put up and Ruhl's son, Robert, 8, were injured in the accident. They were reported "greatly improved" today at Mercy hospital in Mt. Vernon.

Ruhl suffered burned feet and shock, and his eight-year-old son suffered slight burns and a puncture wound in the left thigh when the antenna toppled over, hit a power line and struck the child. Mr. Reed was killed instantly.

Another man reportedly helping with the work, escaped injury because he was holding a rope attached to the antenna which hit a high tension wire.

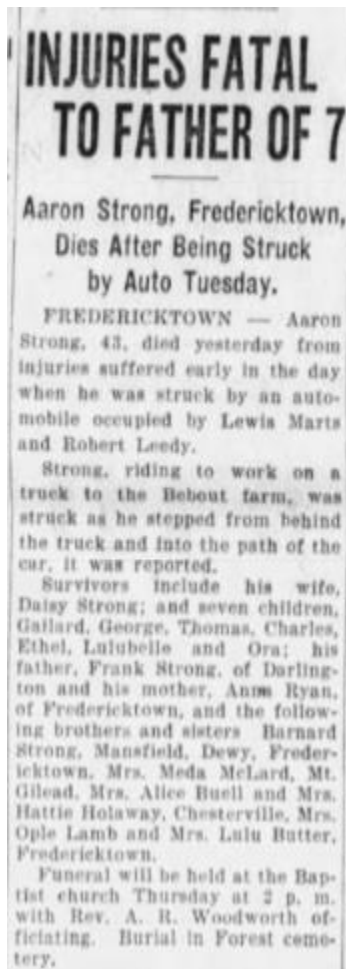
