McDaniel of Rutherford, has a letter from him describing the sinking of the Tuscania, his rescue and the fact of his now being safe in Ireland and none the worse from the experience.

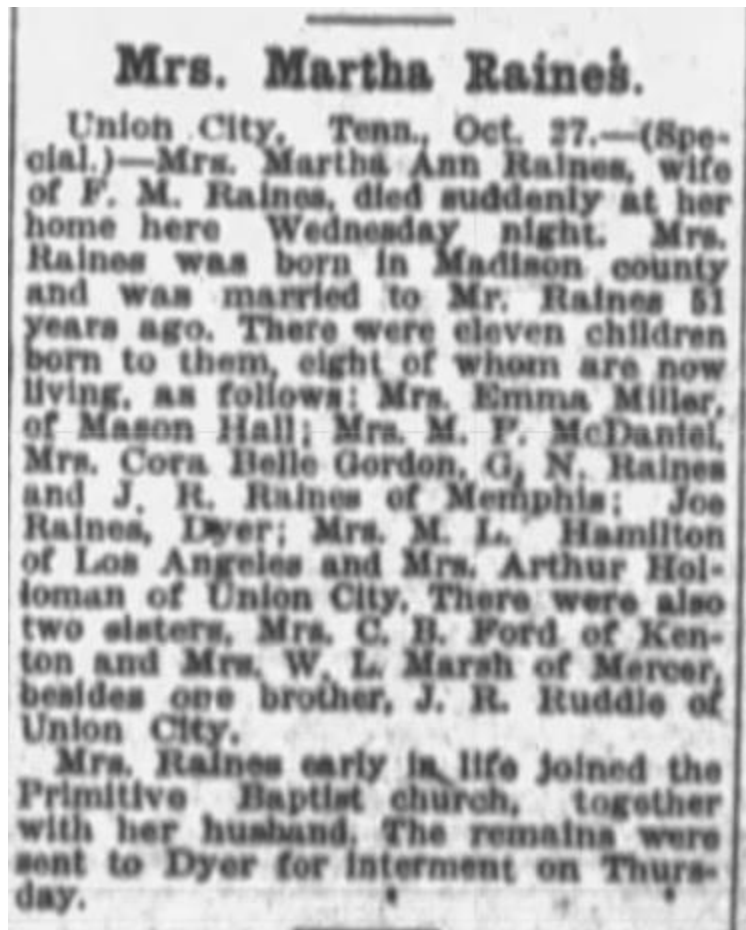
He had been a resident of Union City for many years.

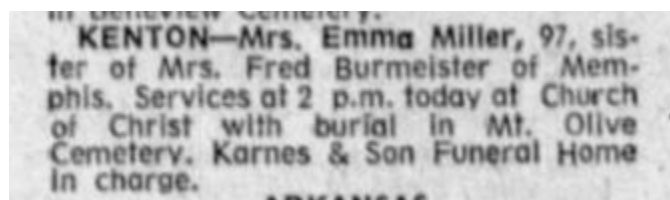

Arthur Holloman, 74, was taken into custody Wednesday on a warrant charging him with misdemeanor manslaughter for the traffic death of his wife, Willie Frances, 74.

Holloman's attorney, Edwin Thurston, said “This thing could have been handled with a summons—they didn't have to resort to a warrant of ar-

Holloman was ordered released on his own recognizance by Judge E. R. Thurman. Mrs. Holloman was fatally injured when the Holloman car was involved in a collision Saturday with a car driven by Geraldine Wingfield, wife of a police sergeant.

Holloman's family claimed police were “extremely inconsiderate” in the timing of the arrest.

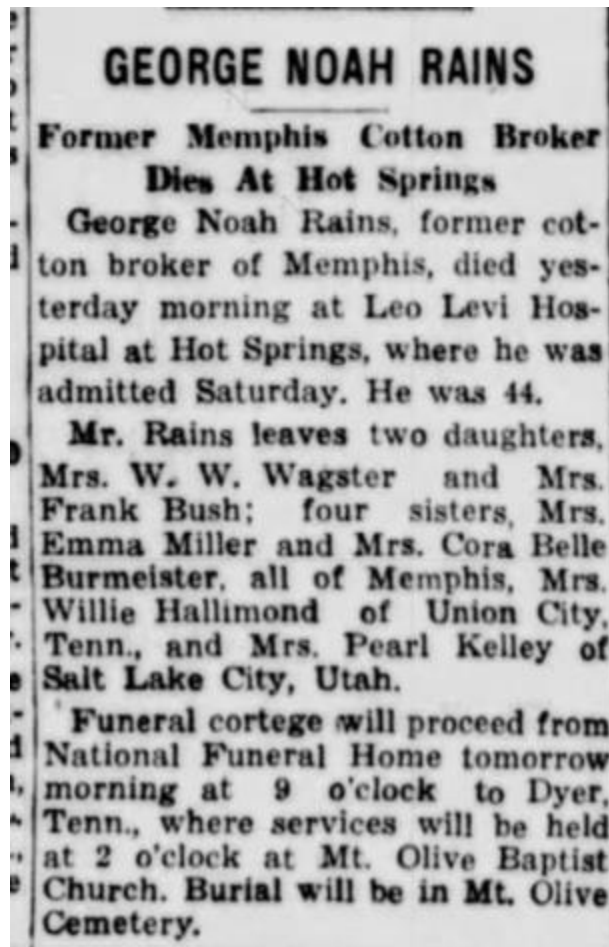
