63 ADDITIONAL TUSCANIA MEN REPORTED SAFE

War Department Receives Official List of More Survivors From the Troop Ship Which Was Sunk by a Sub.

[BY MORNING JOURNAL SPECIAL LEASED WIRE]

Washington, Feb. 24. — Sixty-three American survivors of the torpedoed troop ship *Tuscania* were reported to the war department today as recovering in Irish hospitals from the effects of injuries or exposure. The dispatch said none of the cases was serious and it was expected all soon would be discharged.

All the sixty-three previously had been reported saved, and the presence of many of them in hospitals had been recorded in press dispatches. Although today's dispatch brought the first official list of those in hospitals.
