Two More New Yorkers On Tuscania Safe

Two more New Yorkers who were aboard the torpedoed transport *Tuscania*—Walter J. Martin, of 550 Hamburg Avenue, Brooklyn, and Frank Soffin, of 1,447 Fulton Avenue—were reported in the War Department's revised list of survivors yesterday, as alive and unhurt.

Israel Soffin, father of Frank Soffin, had word of his son before the list was published. It came in the form of a cablegram, which briefly announced "Arrived safely." In other cablegrams from survivors, the censor has deleted the name of the point of origin. Possibly, through oversight, Soffin's message disclosed his presence in Buncrana, Ireland.

Soffin, twenty-six years old and a salesman prior to his enlistment, is a private in the 158th Aero Squadron.

The addition of the name of Lester McKenna, private in the 213th Aero Squadron, to the list of survivors in Irish hospitals, leaves none of the twelve Flushing boys on the transport to be accounted for.

BLACKMAN AMONG THEM

Seven Manhattan Boys Join Ranks of Survivors.

The names of five Brooklyn men and two Long Islanders have been added to the government's list of Tuscania survivors.

Lieut. William B. Blackman, son of Dr. W. W. Blackman, of 519 Clinton avenue, has been listed. His parents received a cable from him Saturday night, which was published in Sunday's Brooklyn Times.

Seven Manhattan men are among the survivors.

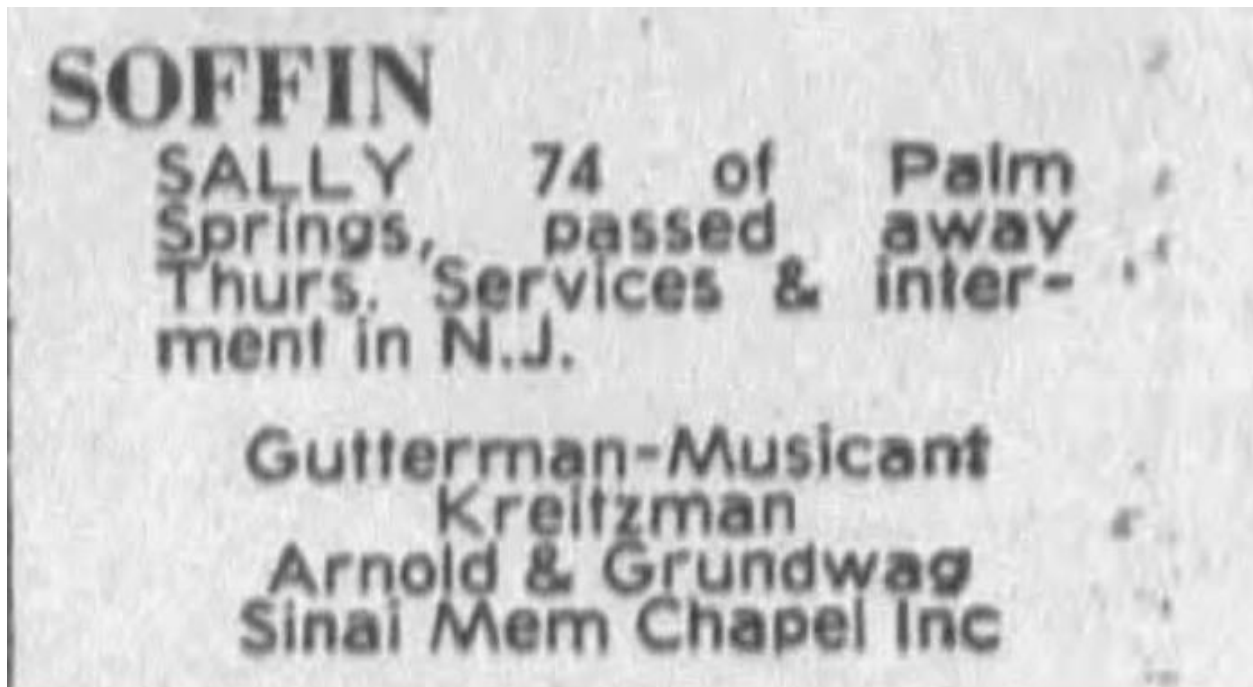

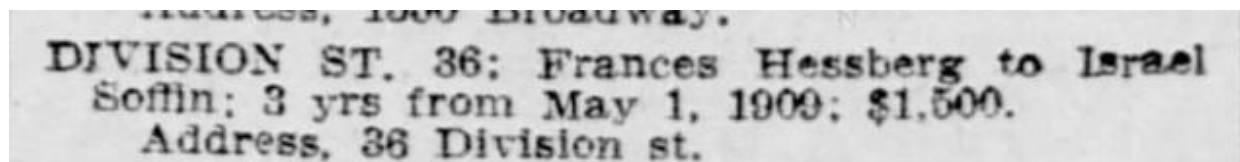

Notes:

Frank's brother William Roy Soffen lists his birthplace as Slutsk, Russia, on his WWII draft registration. This town is now in the country of Belarus. Until WWII, the city was predominantly Jewish. Nazi massacres by the German Army of the Jewish population occurred in 1941, 1942 and 1943. As of 2022, the Jewish population is now less than 100.
