—The funeral of the late Jacob Steibel will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 at the Trinity Episcopal church and Rev. Mr. Arrowsmith will officiate. Before his death, he requested that the following persons act as pall bearers: Thomas B. Morse, H. W. Jones, Harry E. Kendell G. W. Ferguson, A. H. Wright and James O. Clifford, all members of the Royal Arcanum. He was a member of the Horticultural society and Court Belle of Foresters, who will send delegates to the funeral.

And in a separate article on the same page:

—The funeral of the late Jacob Steibel was held at Trinity Episcopal church yesterday afternoon at 2:30 and the funeral exercises were read by Rev. Mr. Arrowsmith and the burial was in the cemetery on the hill. Beautiful flowers were sent by friends and from the different organizations to which he belonged, especially from the Horticultural society. Delegations were present from the Royal Arcanum, Court Belle of Foresters and the Lenox Horticultural society.

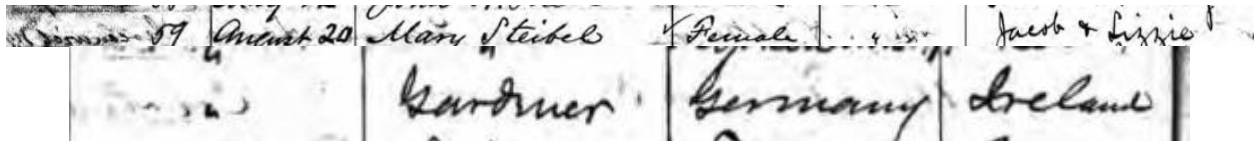

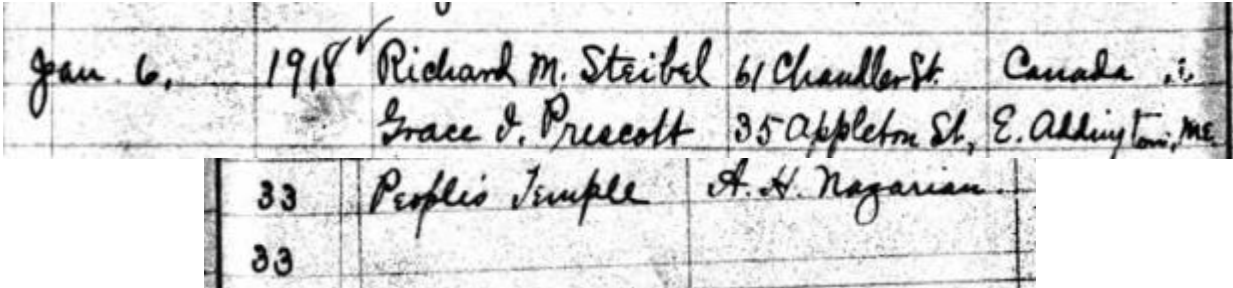

FUNERAL OF VICTIM OF COASTING ACCIDENT

Little Change in Condition of Other Members of Party.

The funeral of Miss Hazel Crosby, whose death was the result of a coasting accident in Lenox Friday afternoon was held from Trinity Episcopal church in Lenox this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock and was very largely attended. The services were conducted by Rev. Harold Arrowsmith, pastor of the church, and the ceremony was very impressive. Gathered in the beautiful church were relatives, friends and school mates of the young girl who had met such a sad death.

The pupils of the high school attended the services in a body. The honorary bearers, selected from the girl's former classmates, were W. Hagyard, Lester Brown, George Curtis, Jr., Elmer Parsons, Richard Steibel and Benjamin Gilmore. Several hymns were sung by the vested choir and a most touching eulogy was delivered by the officiating clergyman. There were a number of very beautiful floral tributes, including remembrances from the Trinity church Sunday school, members of the choir, and each class in the high school. The burial was in the cemetery on the hill. There was no session of the high school today.

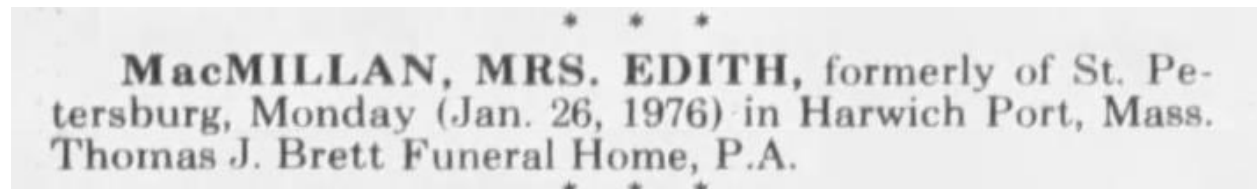
