Tuscania Group To Hold Annual Reunion Saturday

Wausau Men Officers
Of National Association
To Meet in Minneapolis

Several hundred members of the National Tuscania Survivors' association are expected to attend the group's annual reunion in Minneapolis Saturday night and Sunday, according to S. F. Staples, 902 Adams street, association president who will preside at the business session.

On February 5, 1918, the Tuscania, a Cunard Line ship with more than 2,000 American soldiers aboard, was torpedoed and sunk off the coast of Ireland with a loss of more than 200 lives.

British Ships Rescue

The survivors were picked up by British ships which were convoying the Tuscania and landed at Bun-crana and Larne, Ireland.

After the war, the survivors banded together and now gather annually. The association has a membership of more than 900, including many Wisconsin men.

Among the contingents aboard the Tuscania on that ill-fated day were the 107th Military Police, drawn from the Fourth and Sixth Wisconsin infantry, the 107th Supply Train, drawn from the Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Wisconsin infantry, and several other companies of the 32nd division.

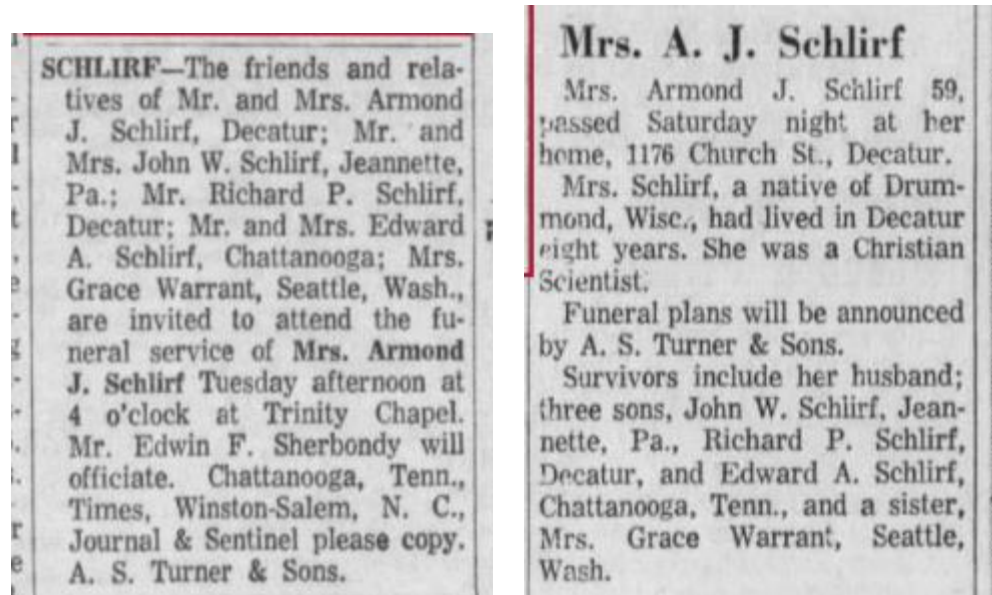

By the 1900 census, Elizabeth (1 year old) is living in St. Paul, Ramsey MN on Dousman St. with Elizabeth’s mother’s sister Belle/Isabelle/Isabella Murray (30 WI, parents b. Canada) & her husband, Edward Neuman (39 MN) who was a St. Paul MN city policeman. Belle said she had given birth to 1 child with 1 living – which if Elizabeth was adopted/fostered, is not accurate.

In the 1910 census for St. Paul, Ramsey MN, living on Leed St. is Edward Neuman (44 MN, city policeman) & his wife Belle Neuman (40 WI, b. Aug 1869) & their niece, Elizabeth Morgan, 11 WI. This entry is indexed as Newman but the writing was misread.

In the 1920 census for St. Paul, Ramsey MN, living at 1486 Sargent Ave. are Edward Neuman (39 MN, policeman), his wife Belle Neuman (30 WI, father b. VT, mother b. Canada) & daughter Beth Neuman, 21 WI (father b. England, mother b. WI).

Edward Neuman had married Belle Murray on 2 Jun 1896 in St. Paul, Ramsey MN. He died 20 Jan 1923 & is buried in Roselawn Cemetery, Roseville, Ramsey MN, F: 78756465. His wife Isabelle Murray Neuman is also buried in Roselawn Cemetery, F: 78756463. She died 6 Jan 1939.

Elizabeth apparently adopted the Neuman name; her tombstone reads "Elizabeth Neuman Schlirf." Her son Richard Schlirf's NC death record lists her name as Elizabeth Morgan while her son Edward Schlirf's NC death record lists her name as Elizabeth NEWMAN.
