Services for Henry I. Shaw, 86, of 1291 S. Rockledge Drive, Rockledge, are scheduled for 10 a.m. Thursday at Wylie-Baxley Funeral Home in Rockledge.

A retired electrician and a Brevard resident for 40 years, Mr. Shaw died Tuesday at Adare Medical Center in Rockledge.

Survivors include a sister living outside the state.

Calling hours are 8:30-10 a.m. Thursday at the funeral home.

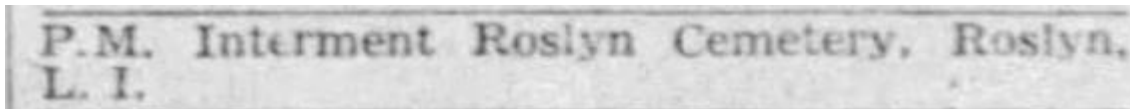

In the 1950 census, Harold & Pauline lived in North Hempstead, Nassau NY. The previous census entry is for Harold's sister Elsie Shaw Howell & her husband George. - Pauline is buried in Roslyn Cemetery, Roslyn, Nassau NY but is not on Find A Grave as of 8 Nov 2022. She died 7 Feb 1958, a resident of 265 Glen Cove Rd., Carle Place, Long Island NY.
- Walter Albert Shaw, 23 Sep 1893 Brookville, Nassau NY – 26 Sep 1918 France. When he registered for the WWI draft on 7 Jun 1917, Walter (birthdate 23 Sep 1893) lived on Glen Cove Rd. & was a driver for The Texas Co., Mineola NY. - Killed in action in WWI. Private 1st class, 138th Infantry, 35th Division. Buried in Meuse-Argonne American Cemetery & Memorial, Romagne-sous-Montfaucon, Departemente de la Meuse, Lorraine, France. F: 55996738
- Herbert Everitts/Everett Shaw, 28 Aug 1895 Oyster Bay, Long Island, Nassau NY – 29 Dec 1968. Married 16 Sep 1922 in Kings Co. NY to Lillian T. Obergfall (1896-1974, F: 2816590). His middle name on his WWI draft registration is Everitts. On his WWII draft registration, he uses Everett. He was employed in 1942 with NYC Rapid Transit & lived in Ridgewood, Queens NY. Buried in Long Island National Cemetery, East Farmingdale, Suffolk NY. F; 82600652
- Arnold Furman Shaw, 6 Aug 1899 Brookville, Nassau NY – Jun 1980 NYC, NY. SSN 050-09-0869. Married on 2 Jul 1925 in Brooklyn NY to Mary F. Fisher. On his WWII draft card, lived in Ozone Park NY with Mary.
- Elsie M. Shaw Howell, ca. 1901 NY - . Married on 22 Jul 1919 in Roslyn, Nassau NY to George Cirvan Howell (29 Jul 1894 Americus, Sumter GA – 1959, buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Cairo, Gandy GA, F: 24516083), the son of George Washington Howell & Emma Margaret Aycock. In the 1950 census, George & Elsie lived in North Hempstead, Nassau NY & had 2 male lodgers. The next census entry is for Elsie's brother Harold Shaw.
- Ernest Clifford Shaw, 17 Dec 1903 Carle Place, Long Island NY - . On WWII draft card, resident of 41 Central Ave., Westbury, Nassau NY with NOK Mrs. Pauline Shaw at same address. Employed by William Simonson, 41 Central Ave., Westbury NY.
