Tuscania Survivor Arrives With Discharged Contingent

Fifty-two soldiers whose homes are in Oregon and Washington passed through Billings yesterday on No. 1 en route to Camp Lewis, and about 40 from Fort Russell, a majority of them Montanans, arrived last night. Forty-five westerners are due today on No. 1. The Red Cross canteen committee served both contingents yesterday and the Y. M. C. A. provided free rooms for those stopping over.

With last night's contingent was Orr Shepherd of Conrad, who was on the Tucania when she was torpedoed in the North sea off the Irish coast February 5, 1918. The Conrad had escaped with other survivors by leaping to the pitching deck of a destroyer which pulled up along side the sinking Tuscania.

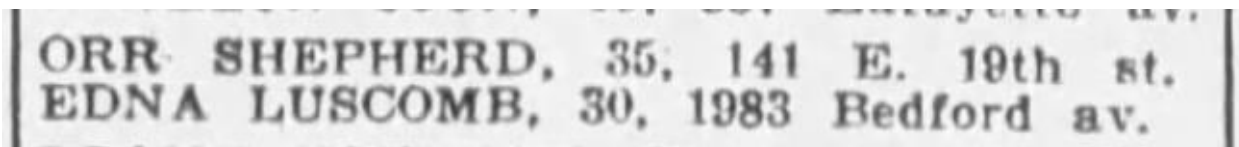

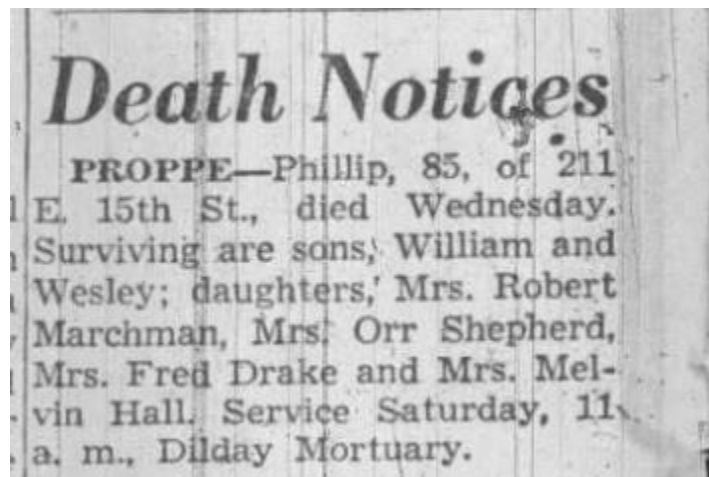
