Government Notifies Family of Rescue of Tuscania Survivor

Special to The Inquirer.

READING, Pa., March 28.—Joy prevailed at the home today of Andrew Shounliskey, of whom nothing had been heard since the torpedoing of the troopship Tuscania, which he was known to be on, when an official telegram was received stating that Shounliskey was among the survivors and had been landed safely "somewhere on the Irish coast." When they found out he had been on the ship and was not listed among the survivors the family gave him up for lost. He is the eldest of six children, and, with his father, was the sole support of the family until called to the colors.

LeRoy Hinkle, of this city, was also reported to have been on the Tuscania, but no word of him has been received from the government.

The Tuscania sank on 5 Feb 1918 & Andrew's family found he was alive on 28 Mar 1918 -

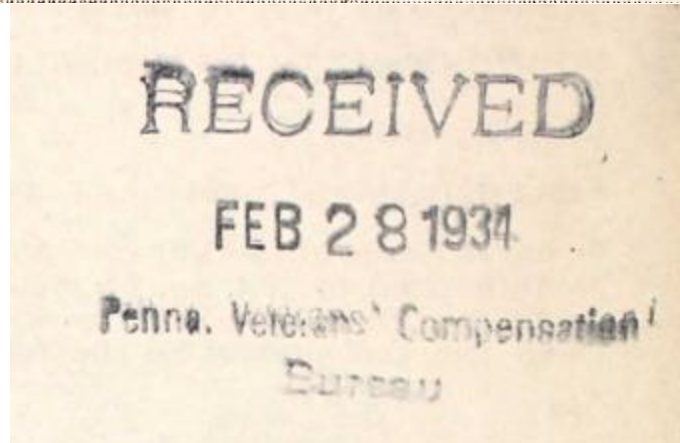

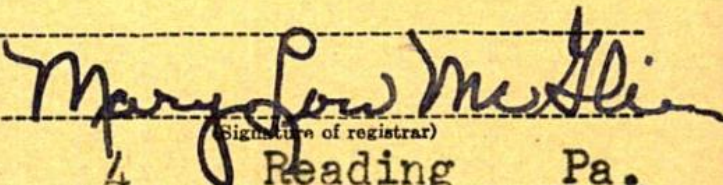

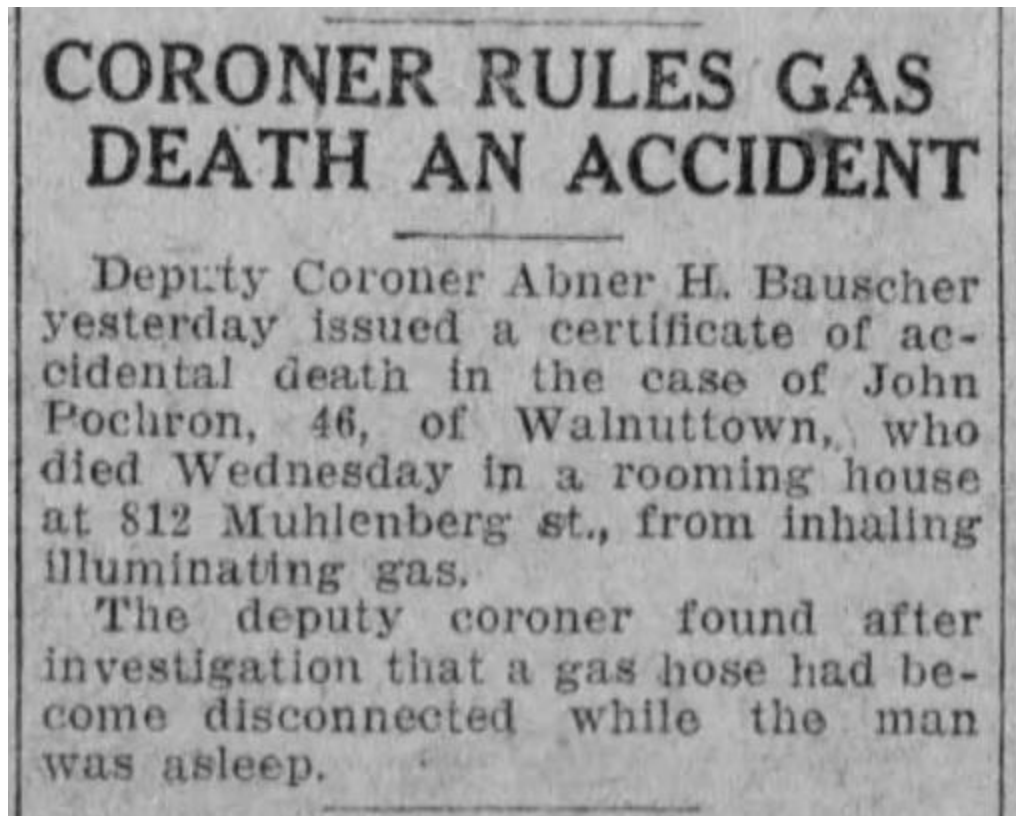
