TWO LAREDO MEN IN THE LIST; ALSO OTHERS FROM NEARBY

**LIST OF SURVIVORS OF TUSCANIA
DISASTER GIVEN OUT.**

**One Young Man from Encinal and
Two From Benavides Are Also
Among the Survivors.**

The War department on Saturday evening gave out a list of the survivors of the transport Tuscania, which was loaded with American troops when torpedoed off the Irish coast last week by a German submarine. This list proved the source of much relief to anxious relatives of the American soldiers aboard the ill-fated transport, most of whom were members of the Michigan and Wisconsin national guard, while there were a large number of Texas and Oklahoma men aboard, these being drafted men in the national army and assigned to the regiments aboard the transport.

One Laredo young man, Librado Navarro, drafted from this county, is among the survivors announced in the list, while there are two young men from Benavides, Margarito Macias and Federico Molina, and one from Encinal, La Salle county, Jose Sanchez, also in the list of survivors. The list of those lost in the disaster has not yet been announced, and consequently relatives having soldiers aboard the transport when the vessel was torpedoed will feel anxious for news regarding the list of missing, or their fate.

Another Laredo Boy Saved.

Valentin V. Hernandez, of the Economy Grocery store, yesterday received the following telegram from Adjutant General McCain, this being supplementary to the list published from Washington:

"Washington, Feb. 9. Valentin V. Hernandez, Laredo, Texas: Officially reported that Miguel Hernandez was saved from Tuscania. McCain, the adjutant general."

Thus it will be seen that there were at least two Laredo boys aboard the ill-fated transport when the vessel was struck by a torpedo, and that both are among the survivors.
