WWI VETERAN DIES AT 81

William Loyd Shults, 81, of Caryville, died Monday at LaFollette Community Hospital. He was a member of American Legion Post 158 and a Veteran of World War I, the 16th Co., 20th Engineers.

Mr. Shults was the only Campbell Countian whose ship, the *Tuscania*, was torpedoed in the Irish Sea. He was one of the few to survive the ordeal.

He leaves his wife, Mrs. Nettie Phillips Shults; three sons, Bill of Rittman, Ohio, Jack of Winfall, Ind., Lee of Muncie, Ind.; two daughters, Mrs. Mildred Kaylor, Noblesville, Ind., Mrs. Betty Hicks, Dayton; brother, Harry Shults of Caryville; four sisters, Mrs. Nell S. Disney, Oak Ridge, Mrs. Rose McAfee, Mrs. Mamie Asbury, and Mrs. Ester Disney, all of Caryville; 17 grandchildren; 1 great-grandchild.

Services were Wednesday at Martin's Chapel with the Rev. Cecil Perry, the Rev. William Hensley and the Rev. Richard Phillips officiating. Burial was at Carey Cemetery with full military honors at the funeral. Martin Funeral Home was in charge.

William was not “one of the few to survive the ordeal” as there were 215 casualties from 2,179 soldiers aboard *Tuscania* - Obituary from Find A Grave 9709663

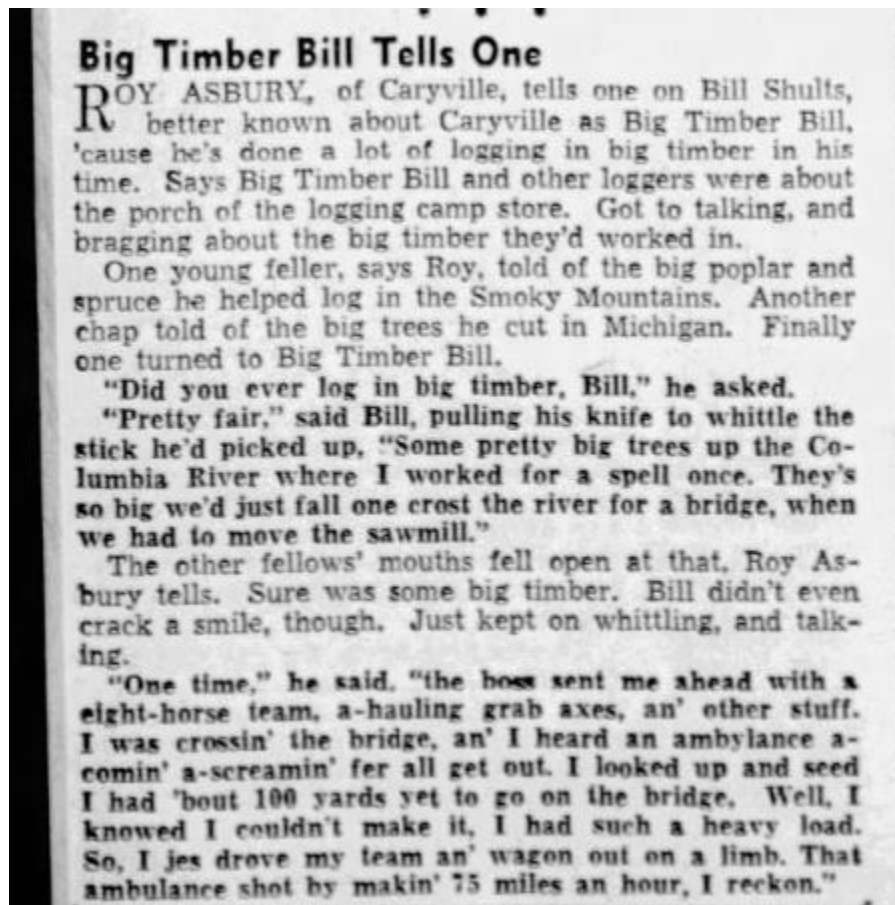
