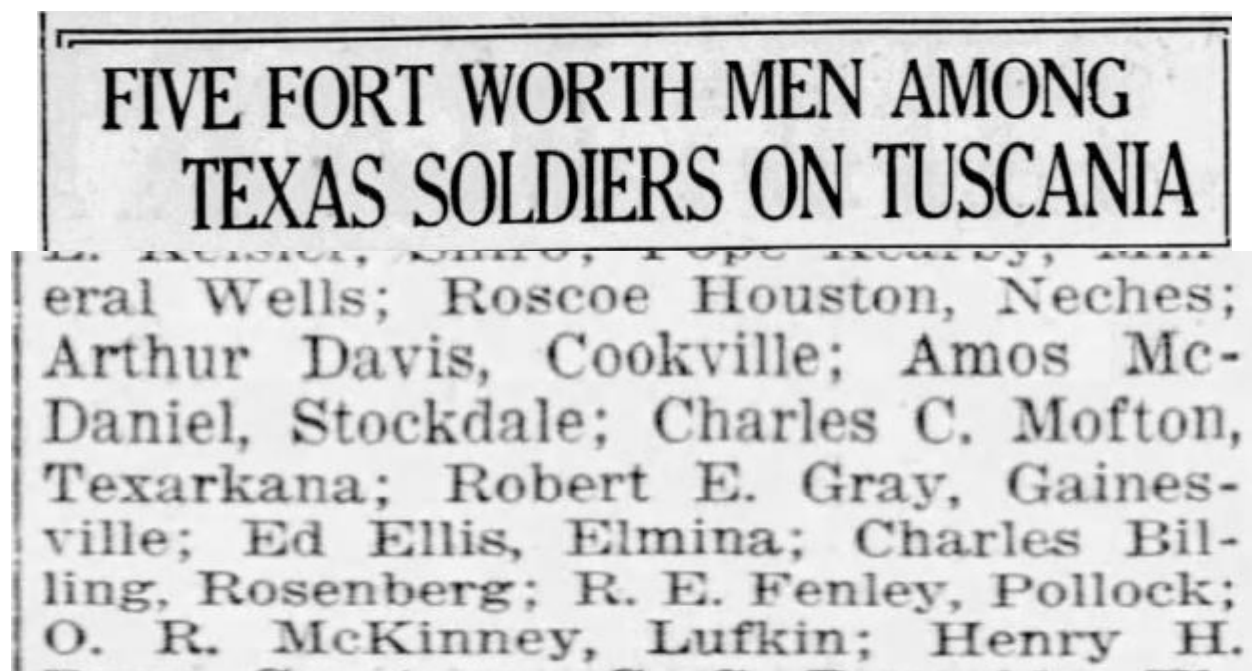

Odessan Hurt In Bar Fight

A 36-year-old Odessa woman who was injured in a disturbance at an East Second Street tavern late Thursday has filed aggravated assault charges against two persons and they remained in the city jail here Friday.

Mrs. Christine Josey, owner of the Patio Club, 1318 East Second, was treated at Medical Center Hospital for a head cut received in the fight at her tavern.

Police arrested Zelma Davis Bodwell, 38, Rock Courts, and J. W. Brown, 19, Rock Courts, and Mrs. Josey filed aggravated assault charges against the pair before Justice of the Peace E. E. Nobles.

Zelma Bodwell was also charged in city court with disturbance and was fined \$35. Brown was also charged in city court with disturbance and his fine was set at \$100.

The aggravated assault charges against the pair were to be transferred to Ector County Court Friday, officials said.

Three Released As Case Dropped

Three persons have been released from the Ector County jail after charges of aggravated assault against them were dismissed.

The trio was arrested Thursday after a woman was injured in a fight at the Patio Club, 1318 East Second.

Deputies said the victims, Mrs. Christine Josey, owner of the tavern, did not want to prosecute the case.

Released from jail were William Wesley Brown, 33, Zelma Davis Bodwell, 38, and J. W. Brown, all of the Rock Courts. They had been named in complaints filed with Justices of the Peace E. E. Nobles.

- **William Cleburn ("Bill") Davis**, 14 Apr 1885 AL - 31 May 1961 Mount Vernon, Franklin TX. SSN 458-64-8711. - TX death record: resident of Rte. 2, Mount Vernon, Franklin TX. Resident here for 6 years. Died at his residence on 31 May 1961. Born 14 Apr 1885 AL to Jefferson Davis & Mary Spruce. Survived by wife Zora. Died of myocardial failure. - William married Almeadie Alice (Meda Allis/Almeda) Kuykendall between the 1920 & 1930 censuses. She was born 8 Aug 1895 Collin Co. TX & died 5 Feb 1953 in Dallas, Dallas TX. She is buried as Almeadie Davis in Omaha Cemetery, Omaha, Morris TX, F: 121542699. - Their daughter was Mary Elizabeth (Betty) Davis

(1928-1954). = Widowed, William married on 7 Mar 1955 in Mount Vernon, Franklin ATX to Zora Getsie Buchanan, becoming her 7th husband. Zora Buchanan (19 Jan 1892 Titus Co. TX – 21 Jun 1971 Sulphur Springs, Hopkins TX) was the daughter of James Chambers Buchanan (1845-1939) & Sue I. Hendrix (b. 1859). – She is buried as Zora Burns in Mount Vernon City Cemetery, Mount Vernon, Franklin TX, F: 9967870. – On 3 May 1908, Zora Buchanan married Herman Oliver in Titus Co. TX. TX, having obtained a marriage license on 28 Nov 1921. His name appears to be Samuel Benjamin Fain Howell or Benjamin Fain Howell. In 1910, Samuel B.F. Howell (16 TN, parents b. TN) lived in Justice Precinct 3, Titus Co. TX with mother Isabelle Howell (50 TN) & sister Rosa M. AL, farmer, general farm, resides with his sister “Eulalla” Davis in Titus Co. TX. – Ed Davis lived in Cookville TX in Sep 1950 when his sister Lola died. – His wife was Hazel Harrell (1908-2006, F: 13882985) whom he married 8 Oct 1923 in Jefferson Co. OK. - In the 1930 census for Duncan, Stephens OK, conducted 10 Apr 1930, Ed Davis (30 TX, father b. AR, mother b. TX, age 24 at his 1st marriage) was a sales clerk in a grocery store. In his household were wife Hazel (22 OK, parents b. OK) , son Jackie D. (5 OK) & daughter Yvonne (4 months OK). – A convict named Ed Davis, age 36, was incarcerated in the TX State Penitentiary in Huntsville, Walker TX, convicted on 26 Apr 1933 of burglary & sentenced to 5 years. He entered prison on 6 Jun 1933 & was to serve time until 12 Sep 1937 but was paroled 3 Dec 1935 & discharged 1 May 1937. In 1950, William Ed Davis lived in Duncan, Stephens OK, age 50, b. TX, farmer, with wife Hazel (42) & son Jack D. (25). – William Edgar is buried in Duncan Municipal Cemetery, Duncan, Stephens OK. F: 80619165
