WOMAN TAKES OWN LIFE WITH PISTOL BULLET

Found in her room at 1307½ Texas avenue about 1:45 o'clock Thursday afternoon with a bullet wound in her abdomen, Mrs. Belva Deron, about 30 years old, died at the Charity hospital shortly after 7 o'clock Thursday night. She said that she shot herself, but refused to divulge any motive she might have had for doing so, and would not give the names of any relatives. She said, however, that her home was in New York city.

Dr. Willis P. Butler, Caddo parish coroner, gave a verdict of suicide. The body is being held at the Wellman undertaking parlors, awaiting efforts of authorities to locate relatives.

Mrs. Deron was a housekeeper for E. A. Donohoe, 1307½ Texas avenue. S. A. Milton, a roomer in the house, and E. A. Justice, 1301 Texas avenue, heard the shot, ran to the room and found her on the floor. They took her to the Charity hospital, where an operation and blood transfusions were performed in an effort to save her life.

FIND RELATIVES OF MRS. DERON

Motive Is Lacking in Case of
Woman Who Took Own
Life Thursday

No motive for suicide has yet been found by investigators of the fatal shooting of Mrs. Belva Deron, about 30 years old, who before she died Thursday afternoon stated that she shot herself but would give no reason for the act. The body was being held at the Wellman Undertaking parlors Friday night pending the announcement of funeral arrangements by a brother and sister of the dead woman who arrived Friday.

Mrs. D. L. Brown, the sister and the brother, Lawrence Oxendine, both of Leesville, could not suggest a motive for the suicide. The woman, who was housekeeper for E. A. Donohoe, 1307½ Texas avenue, would not divulge the names of any of her relatives before she died but stated that her home was in New York city. According to her brother and sister, she was born and reared in Louisiana and she evidently misled the investigators to prevent her relatives from learning of the tragedy. Mrs. Deron's husband, from whom she has been separated for some time, lives in Jasper, Texas. No word has been heard from him since the tragedy.

Early Friday afternoon, two roomers at 1307½ Texas avenue heard a pistol shot from Mrs. Deron's room and rushed in to find her on the floor with a fatal wound in the abdomen. An operation and a blood transfusion at a local hospital failed to save her life and she died several hours later. Dr. Willis P. Butler, parish coroner, returned a verdict of suicide.

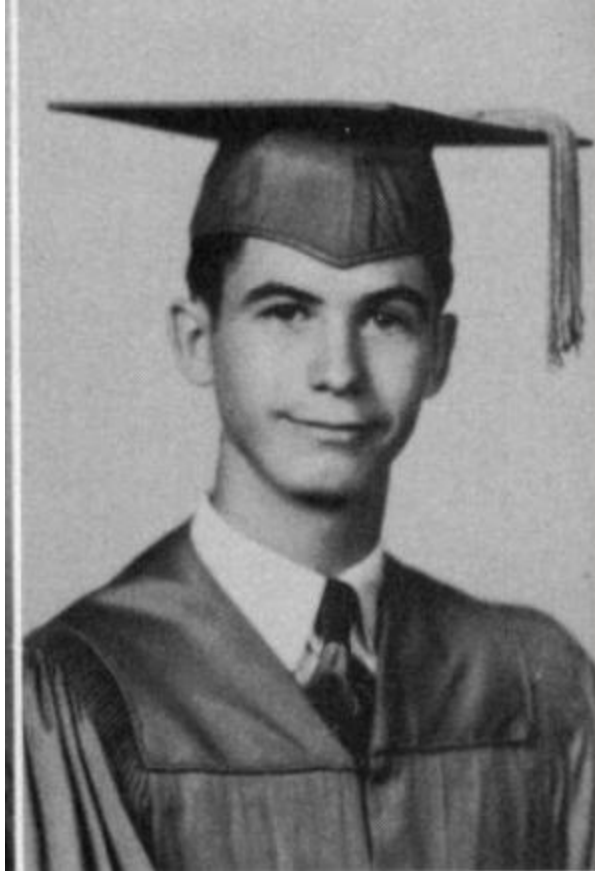

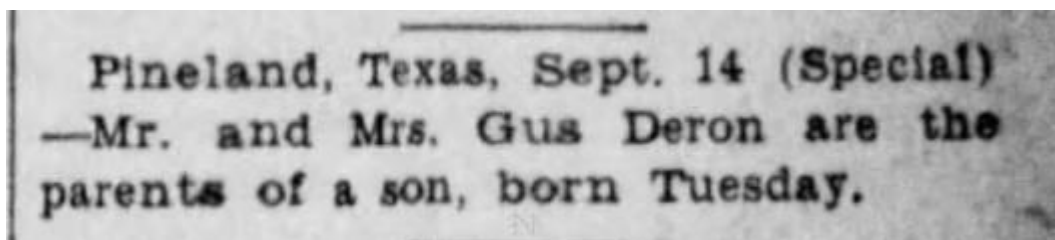

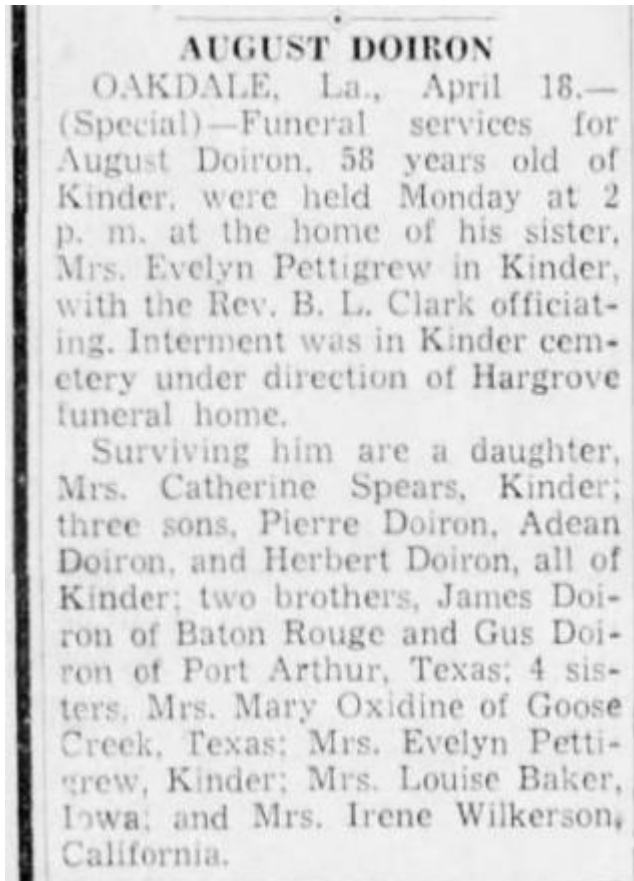

Belva & their child were listed on Gus's 5 Jun 1917 WWI draft card.

She was his 1918/1919 wartime next-of-kin & living with Gus in the 1920 census.

Committed suicide in Shreveport LA; newspaper reports indicate Gus & Belva had been estranged for some time.

"Shreveport (LA) Times" Sat., 4 Aug 1928 p 12 – No motive for her own suicide was provided by Mrs. Belva Deron, about 30 years old, who shot herself on Thursday afternoon, 2 Aug 1928. Her body is at the Wellman Undertakers firm pending funeral arrangements to be made by her brother & sister who arrived in Shreveport on Friday, 3 Aug. Her sister, Mrs.

D.L. Brown, and her brother Lawrence Oxendine, both of Leesville LA, could not suggest a motive.

Belva was a housekeeper for E.A. Donohoe at 1307 ½ Texas Ave. She would not divulge the names of her relatives before she died; she said her home was in New York City. Her brother & sister said she was born & reared in LA. Perhaps she misled authorities to prevent her relatives from learning of her death. No word has been received from her husband [not named], who lives in Jasper TX and from whom she has been “separated for some time.”

Early Friday afternoon [i.e. Thursday afternoon], two roomers at 1307 ½ Texas Ave. heard a pistol shot & went into Belva’s room to find her on the floor with what would be a fatal wound to her abdomen. An operation & blood transfusion was done at the local hospital, but those failed, and she died several hours later. Coroner Dr. Willis P. Butler pronounced it a suicide.

An earlier report – in the “Shreveport Times” of 3 Aug 1928 p 1 repeats most of those details with the following additions or changes:

She was found in her room at 1307 ½ Texas Ave. about 1:45 p.m. on 2 Aug 1928. She died shortly after 7 p.m. that evening at Charity Hospital. Dr. Willis P. Butler was the coroner for Caddo Parish LA. It was one roomer – S.A. Milton of 1307 ½ Texas Ave. – who found her; the other man was E.A. Justice who lived at 1307 Texas Ave. The men took her to Charity Hospital after hearing the shot & finding her with a bullet wound in the abdomen.

He had been a waiter. Thurman’s data conflicts; he appears to have been born ca. 1914 OK & died 2 Apr 1984 TX. In the 1950 census for Orange Co. TX, Thurman Garrett (36)

- **Irene Doiron Wilkerson**, ca. 1903 LA - . "Irene" was age 7 in the 1910 census & age 17 as Irime in the 1920 census, residing with her father Pierre & stepmother Ella. When her brother August died in Apr 1945, she was Mrs. Irene Wilkerson of California. She is not listed in the obituaries of her siblings Gus in 1958, - Online obituaries have her married in Canada to a Canadian. Not able to trace. Since she is mentioned in her brother August's obituary in Apr 1945 but not in those of her siblings in Sep 1958, Nov 1961, Oct 1962 & Mar 1969, she presumably died between 1945 & 1958. Also, since Wilkerson is found in only one source, this might be a misspelling and be Wilkinson or Wilkins or ??

Notes:

There are still people named Deron residing in Sulphur LA & Calcasieu Parish LA. There are also numerous variations of Deron that are offered as options on FamilySearch.org or Ancestry.com – Derone, DeRouen, Dairon, Doiron, Reon, etc. and also found among the members of Gus's family themselves.
