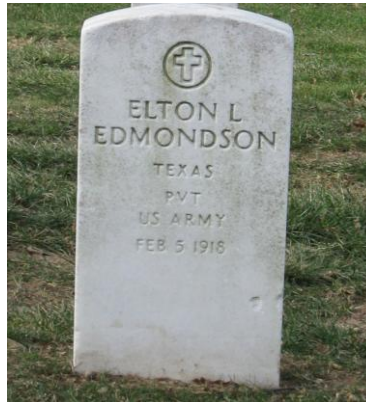

. Two Marriages of Elton Lee Edmondson

Elton Lee Edmondson was born 9 December 1893 in Brady Co. Texas and died 5 February 1918 near Islay Island, Scotland, about 7 miles off the coast of Ireland. He was aboard the British Convoy ship SS Tuscania carrying over 2,000 American troops to Europe. The ship was torpedoed by the German submarine U-77 under the command of Lieutenant Commander Wilhelm Meyer. Two torpedoes were fired. The first one missed but the second struck directly on the starboard side causing a huge explosion and a severe list which plunged troops and crew into the night sea. Of the 2,397 American troop in the action, 2,187 were rescued. Elton was one of those retrieved and then identified by fingerprints. He was buried on 8 February 1918 in Port Charlotte, Islay, Scotland - later the body was exhumed and relocated to the Arlington National Cemetery, Virginia: Section Europ Site 303. (1,2)

It seems that Elton was married twice. Evidently, descendants of either family have not known of the other. No reference to the second marriage has been found in any of the Ancestry.com records. An Email communication brought the matter to my attention. (3)

First to Mary Magdalene Hudgeons on September, 1913, presumably in Clay County, Texas. Likely in or around Petrolia, Texas. He is placed there in 1910 census and in the 1917 WW I draft registration. As known, Elton and Mary had one child, a boy named Claude Napoleon (1914 - 1993). He and mother Mary are found in the 1920 census Wichita Co. Texas in her parent's home - Henry & Minnie Hudgeons. Mary is listed as 'Lena' and is widowed. Her brother, Otis Hudgeons, lives alone on the next farm. It is interesting to note that 3 siblings: Gustis 18, Frank 15, and Ivory 13 Dillingham are in the same household, listed as orphans. Later, in In the 1930 census Wichita Co. Texas, 'Lena' and Claude are living alone next farm to her brother & family, Otis Hudgeons. Her occupation is listed as cook on family farm. Claude is listed as farm laborer at 15 yrs old. On 24 Dec 1930, 'Lena' married Aubah Dillingham in Deaf Smith County, Texas. They had 3 known children: Charles A. (Jan. 1932), Clifford Rex (Aug 1934) and Vivian Jay (Aug 1935), all born in Deaf Smith Co. Texas. Later, Aubah and Mary 'Lena' - moved to Marlow, Stephens County, She is buried in the Marlow Cemetery, Memorial #23057141.

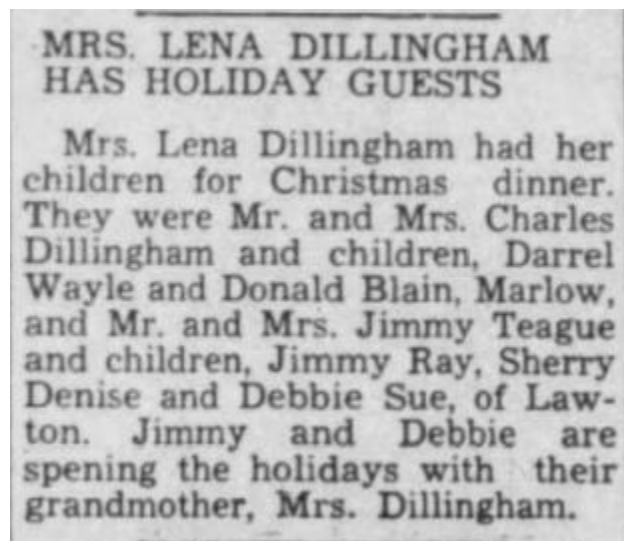

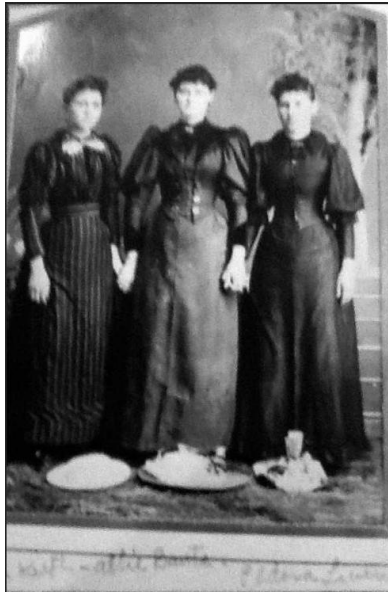
