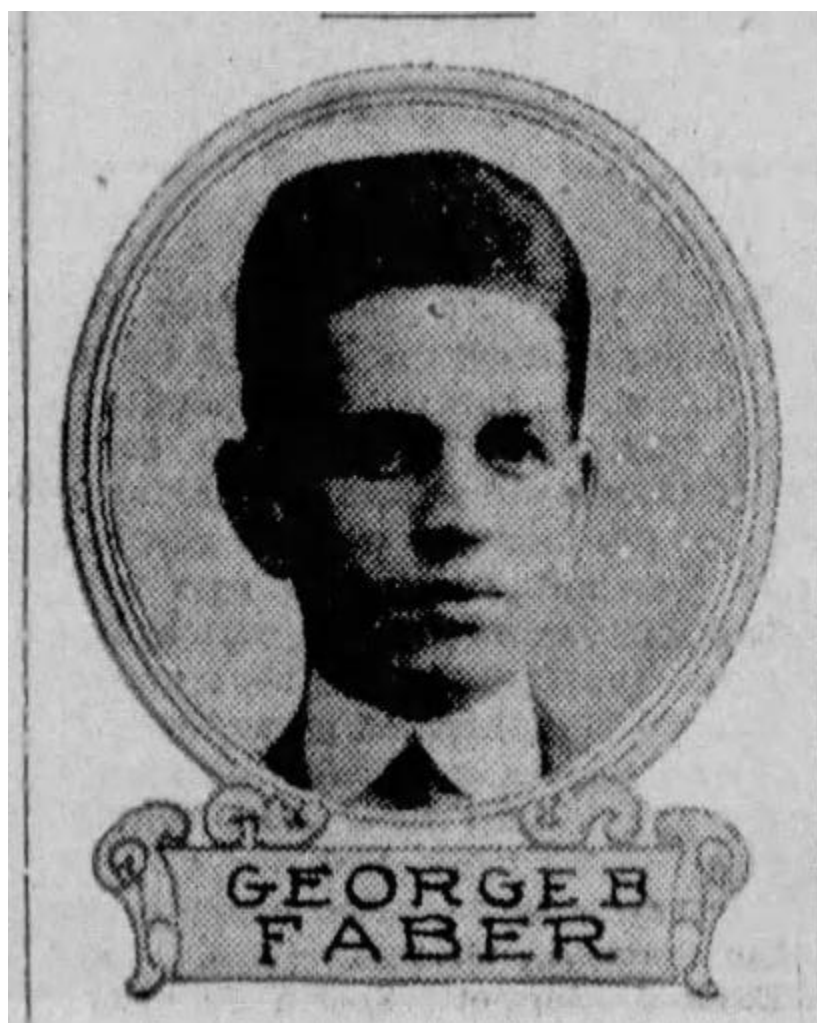

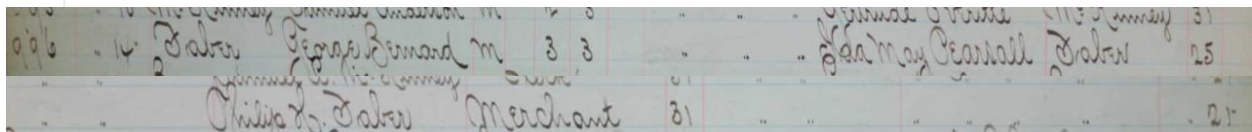

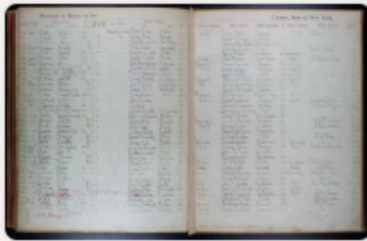

Two young men from the Rockaways were aboard the ill-fated Tuscania, being members of the 213th Aero Squadron. They are John O'Rourke, son of Mr. and Mrs. John O'Rourke, of 58 Mott avenue, Far Rockaway, and George B. Faber, son of Mrs. Edwin W. Schilling, of Rockaway Turnpike, Lawrence. John O'Rourke, who was born in Far Rockaway twenty years ago, was a student in Far Rockaway High School, but left to study for a machinist. On December 4 last he enlisted in the Aero Squadron at Mineola as a machinist and sailed with his unit some time ago. His brother, James, 18, is attending the Naval Training Station at Newport, R. I.

George B. Faber is 21 years old and a nephew of Supreme Court Justice Leander B. Faber, of Jamaica. He was born in Jamaica, but had lived in Lawrence for some years. He was a former pupil of the Lawrence High School. He enlisted in the Aero Squadron as a machinist on December 10 and soon after was promoted to first-class private.

WRONG ADVICE COSTS \$25

Motorist Finds Trooper Erred in Telling Him of Legal Speed Rate.

George B. Faber, of 222 Rockaway turnpike, Lawrence, had to pay \$25 to learn that he can't operate an automobile in Queens at the rate of 40 miles an hour, despite the word of a State trooper that he could.

Faber was caught early yesterday at 204th st. and Sunrise Highway, Springfield, by Patrolman Joseph E. Backer, of Motorcycle Squad 2.

"A State trooper told me I could travel at 40 miles along the highway," Faber told Magistrate Peter M. Daly in Jamaica Court. The court ruled that while a person may travel at that rate of speed in this State, he could not do so within the city limits.

Philip H. Faber, son of the late Bernhard L. Faber, died on Saturday, in the forty-seventh year of his age, at his home in Lawrence, L. I. He was born at Jamaica, where he lived the greater part of his life. He was associated with his father in business at Jamaica for many years. When his father died, about four years ago, Philip H. Faber conducted the business alone, but later gave it up and moved to Lawrence. The fair will take place in the Town Hall week before Christmas.

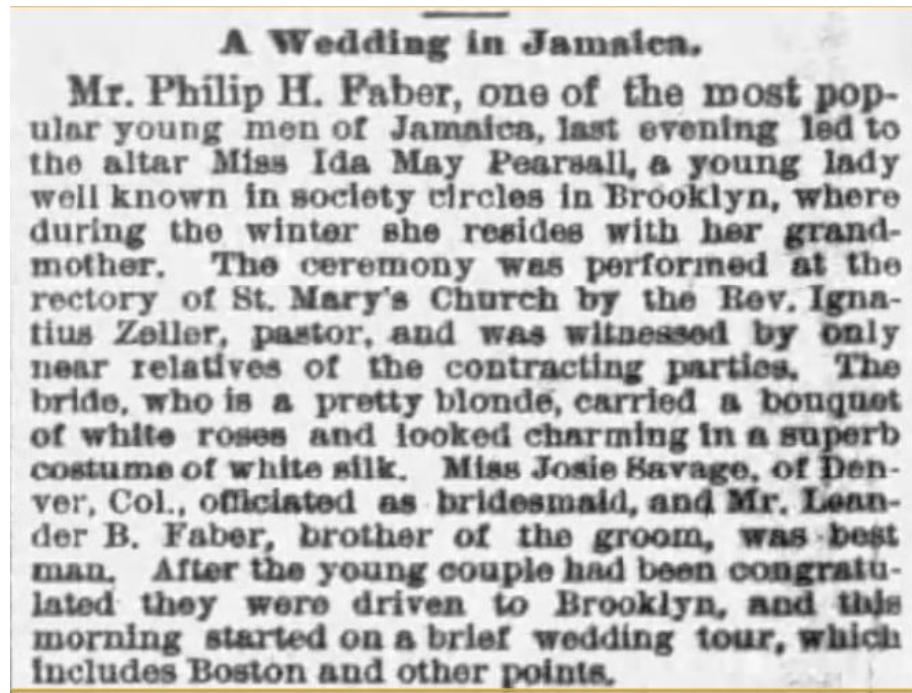

C. A. SCHILLING, 82, FORMER ROCKAWAY HOTEL MAN, DIES

Was Also Active in Civic Affairs
—Latterly Seaside Improve-
ment Co. Head.

Charles A. Schilling, an old resident and prominent civic worker in the Rockaways for many years, died suddenly of heart failure at his home, 191 Beach 101st street, Rockaway Beach, on Friday night. Mr. Schilling was in his 83d year.

He was born in Germany and came to this country about fifty years ago, making his residence in Brooklyn, where he engaged in the bakery business. From Brooklyn he moved to Valley Stream, where for several years he was in the coal and wood business. He then entered the hotel business at Far Rockaway, becoming proprietor of the old Mansion House on Central avenue, where the Columbia Theatre is now located.

After several years at Far Rockaway, Mr. Schilling went to Rockaway Beach, where he built Schilling's Roadhouse on the Boulevard at Henry street, now Beach 102nd street. The roadhouse was added to from time to time, finally it extended well towards the ocean. At the time of consolidation in 1898 Mr. Schilling erected the building used as a police station, also on Henry street.

He conducted his hotel business until about five years ago, when he retired to become president of the Seaside Improvement Company, owners of a large tract of land in Seaside. During his career in the Rockaways, he was widely known as a civic worker and was identified with many movements for the advancement of the community.

He had served as president of the old Rockaway Beach Board of Trade and the Rockaway Beach Wine and Liquor Dealers' Association. He also held membership in the Exempt Firemen's Association of the Fifth Ward, and the old Town School Board before consolidation. He was a member of Star of Hope Lodge, F. and A. M. His wife died two years ago.

Mr. Schilling is survived by three sons, Charles H. of Hewlett; Edwin W., of Cedarhurst, and Harry A., of Lynbrook, and five daughters, Mrs. Charles E. Pretz, of Cedarhurst; Mrs. Patrick H. Morrison, of Rockaway Beach; Mrs. Robert Miller, of Rockaway Park; Mrs. David Caine, of Belle Harbor, and Mrs. William E. O'Neill, of Ithaca.

Masonic services will be held at his late residence tonight, under the auspices of Star of Hope Lodge. Other services will be held tomorrow afternoon, the Rev. John C. Green, of the First Congregational Church, of Rockaway Beach, officiating. Interment will be private in Trinity Cemetery, Woodmere.

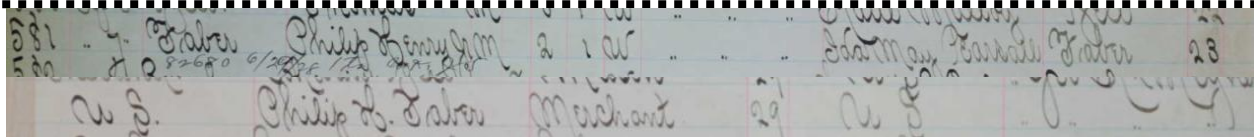
