TX. - Born Nov 1892 TX according to 1900 census. - Married 9 Sep 1917 in Shelby Co. TX to Gladys Marie or J. Solomon (1901-1977, F: 59461723). On Find A Grave: died at age 85, retired farmer, survived by wife Gladys, 4 sons, 4 daughters, 1 brother Bertis Fancher of Garrison TX & 1 sister, Mrs. Maudie Woods of Fort Worth TX.
