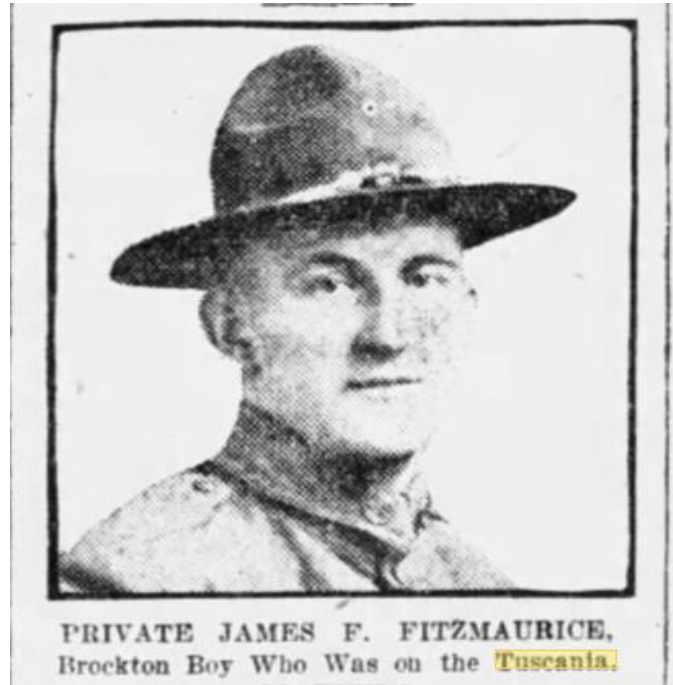

REPORTS HE IS SAFE**

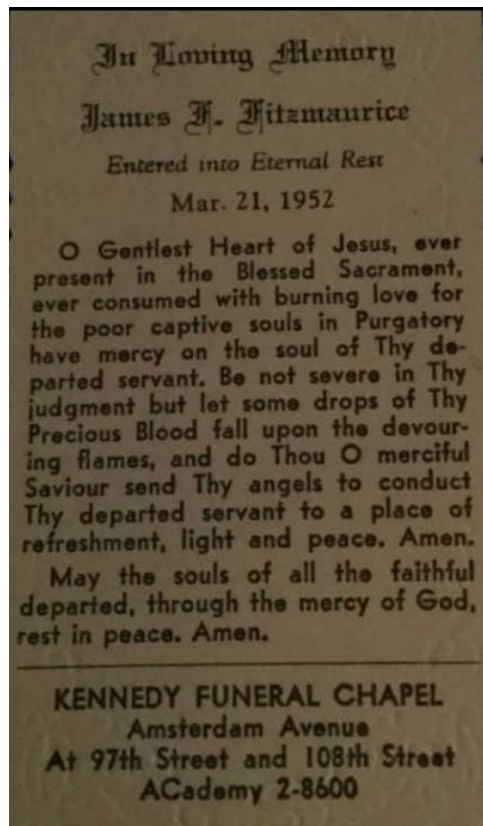

JAMES F. FITZMAURICE, BROCKTON, IN DISASTER

BROCKTON, Feb 8—One Brockton boy, private James F. Fitzmaurice, son of Mr and Mrs Patrick Fitzmaurice of 162 Forest av. was on the Tuscania. His parents have received no word from him, nor from the War Department. He was a member of the 100th Aero Squadron.

Fitzmaurice was 20 years old. He enlisted in the aviation section Nov 3, reporting at Fort Slocum, N Y, and being transferred to Kelley Field, San Antonio, Tex. where he learned the fundamentals of airplane work. He had been in the air 41 times and expected to be made a first class observer upon reaching France. He was in Brockton on a furlough three weeks ago. He was a member of St Patrick's Church and a graduate of the Parochial School.

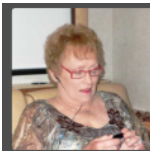

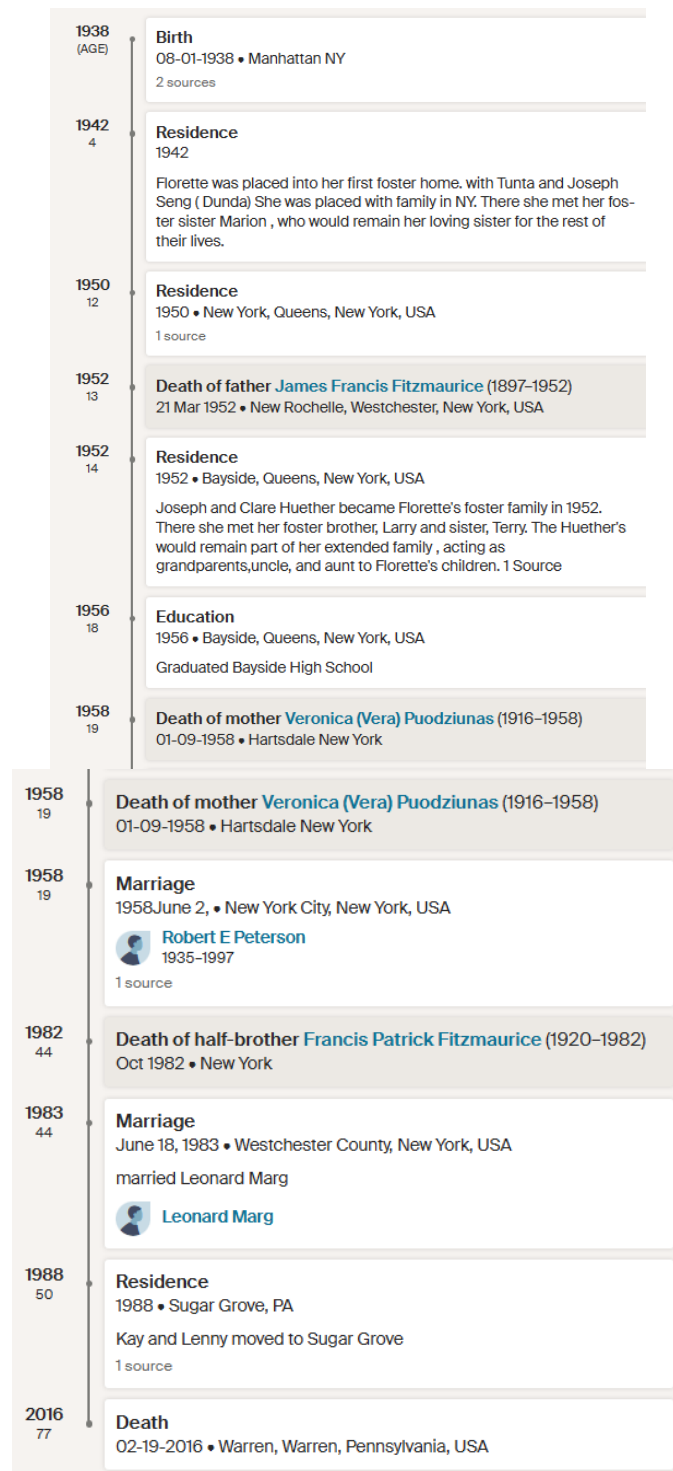

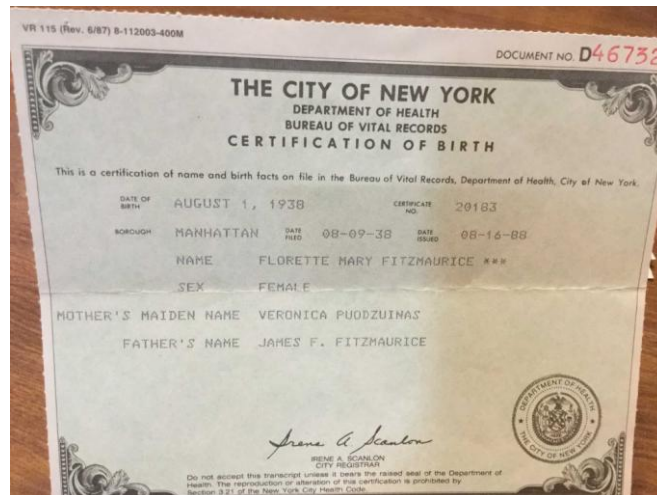

Together they enjoyed going to the Lakewood Rod and Gun, square dancing, traveling, entertaining friends, playing cards, and spending quality time with their grandchildren. 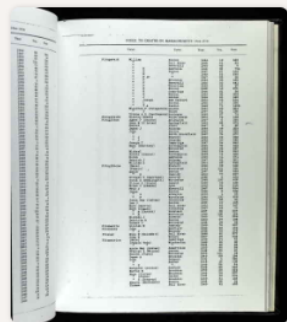

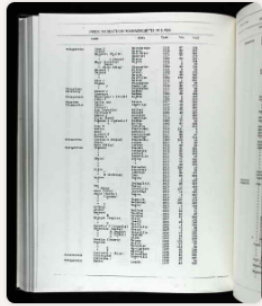

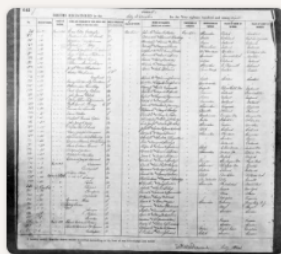

**MAN NEAR DEATH
WHEN HIT BY TRAIN**

**Stolen Ride on Express
Leads to Accident**

Special Dispatch to the Globe

BRAINTREE, Oct 20—Two Brockton men, Thomas J. Fitzmaurice, 26, of 50 Clifton av and John P. Buckley, 25, 18 Hemlock av, stole a ride on the Cape Cod express bound from Brockton to Boston tonight and Fitzmaurice is near death at the Weymouth Hospital.

He is supposed to have fallen from the space between the engine tender and the first car where he and Buckley were sitting and was hit by another train.

Buckley told police that he missed Fitzmaurice when the train was near the River-st railroad crossing here and at the crossing when the train slowed down he jumped off and ran back over the tracks shouting "Fitzie."

About 250 feet from the crossing Buckley found Fitzmaurice with both legs and his left arm cut off and several fingers of his right hand gone. Police took Fitzmaurice to the hospital where his name was placed on the danger list.

Buckley says that he and Fitzmaurice, who had been unemployed for some time, were on their way to Boston to apply for work at a C. C. C. camp.

Investigation showed that the train slowed down at the crossing after the receipt of a message that two men had been seen riding between the tender and the first car. Fitzmaurice was struck by a local train, bound to Boston that was following the express. Buckley was held by the police on a charge of evading fare and will be arraigned in the Quincy Court tomorrow morning.

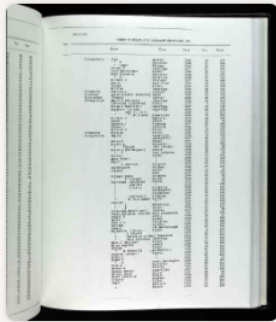
Police reported Fitzmaurice was trying to get to Boston with a companion to look for a CCC job.

At the time of James's birth, his father was a “gas workman.”

Do not confuse this Fitzmaurice family with the one that lived in Malden MA. Many of the Malden people have the same names as James's family members, and some died in the same years as his relatives.
