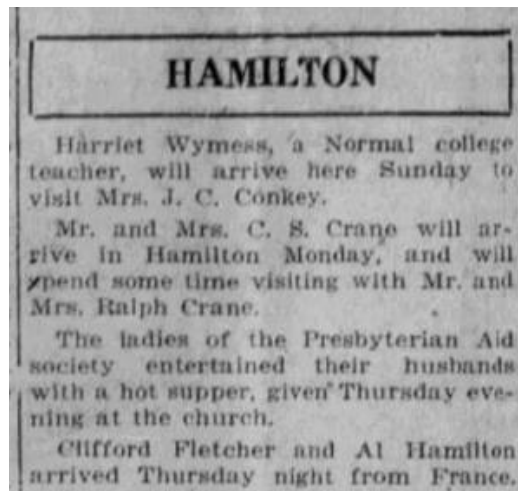

Lethbridge, Alta., Jan. 14.—Charged with false pretenses, Elmira Glidden, alias Elmira Madden, a young woman of 22 years who has been employed as a waitress in one of the cafes here, was given six months' suspended sentence by Magistrate Barker on Monday afternoon, and left for her home in Kalispell, Mont.

She bought a pair of slippers and a pair of leggings, value \$11.75 at a local store, for which she tendered a check for \$25, payable to herself and purported to be signed by Mr. Davis. On the check being refused to be cashed at the store, she took it away, saying she would cash it, but did not return. She was picked up by Constable Lowe of the city police, and when questioned by Inspector Walls, when taken to the police station, she admitted she had forged the check and that her name was not Madden.

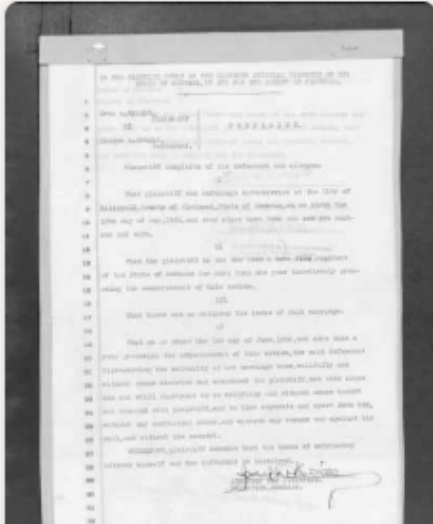

Trusty at Prison Flees From Camp

Deer Lodge, Dec. 17—(AP)—Warden Dudley Jones tonight reported the escape from a Montana state prison camp of John Hagan, 32, who was serving a two-year sentence for burglary imposed by the Glacier county district court in February, 1941.

The camp, where Hagan was working as a cook's helper, is located about 15 miles from the prison, near the Continental divide.

The warden said Hagan, an Indian rancher from Cut Bank, escaped about 4 p. m. today on a horse used at the camp.

Twelve prison trusties have been working at the camp, the warden's office reported.

Eric Avery Wright (18 Jun 1894 Gladwin, Gladwin MI – 11 Jan 1977 Lewiston, Nez Perce ID, burial details unknown, F: 217665471).

On 7 Jul 1927, Eric Wright initiated divorce proceedings claiming Elmira had “willfully and without cause deserted and abandoned the plaintiff” circa 1 Jun 1926 and then lived separately & apart from him. This desertion apparently was two weeks after their wedding. But daughter Beverley Marie Wright, who lives one day, is born 2 Jan 1928. Her father is listed as Eric Wright on her birth record.

1928

On 30 May 1928 in Thompson Falls MT, she married Peter Carl (Pete) Anderson (28 Apr 1906 Linköping, Linköpings kommun, Östergötlands, Sweden – 1 Nov 1964 Sheridan Co. WY). Peter is buried in Mountain View Cemetery, Butte, Silver Bow MT, F: 207150468. He was the son of Carl Oscar Anderson & Nanny Elizabeth Blomquist.

Was Mrs. Elmira Anderson living in Portland OR in 1945 and 1946.

Divorced Peter Carl Anderson on 30 Dec 1951 in Polson, Lake MT.

1945:

Married John Hagan in Cut Bank, Glacier MT on 26 Apr 1945. Note she did not divorce Peter Anderson until 1951 (?).

John Francis Hagan was born 1 May 1909 in Cut Bank, Glacier MT, the son of Henry Francis Hagan & Elizabeth Larrabee. The family was Native American. When John married Elmira, he had been divorced once; Elmira (already married twice) claimed to be single with no previous husbands. She also subtracted 2 years from her birth year, claiming to be born in 1905 instead of 1903.

John Hagan married Aug 1966 in Cardston, Alberta, Canada to Helen Martha Husek. He died in Libby, Lincoln MT on 14 Jan 1982. Buried in Crown Hill Cemetery, Cut Bank, Glacier MT, F: 259304773

- **Flossie Marguerite Ragan Hanson Devine**, 28 Apr 1913 Onalaska, Lewis WA – 19 Jul 1985 Spokane, Spokane WA. – Twin of Florence Ragan. – Flossie Ragan married Charles P. Hanson Jr. on 4 Oct 1934 in the Presbyterian parsonage in Yakima, Yakima WA. - Wife of Hubert Charles Devine (1907-1990, F: 156796687) whom she married 13 Feb 1942 in Yakima Co. WA - Buried in Holy Cross Cemetery, Spokane, Spokane WA. F: 156796342
- **Florence Lenora Smilie Ragan Ludahl**, 28 Apr 1913 Onalaska, Lewis WA – 27 Aug 1992 Newport, Lincoln OR. - Twin of Flossie Ragan. – Married to Frank O. Smilie, 2 Sep 1896 KS – 2 Sep 1970 Newport OR at age 71. He is buried in Mountain View Cemetery, Centralia, Lewis WA. - Wife of Ernest LeRoy (“Ernie”) Ludahl Sr. (1912-1996, F: 64779336). Florence

MN – 17 Oct 1975. - On his WWII draft card (1942) he enters a birth date of 3 Nov 1893; he is a resident of Rimrock, Naches WA. - Marriage: Raleigh Fletcher married Maxine D. Hart on 3 Mar 1921 in Kalispell, Flathead MT. - Marriage: Raleigh Ellsworth Fletcher, resident of St. Ignatius MT, b. Austin Co. MN, age 34 years, 3 months, 20 days, divorced, son of Charles E. Fletcher & Mabel Carey married Rosa Maria Wunder (1890-1990, F:3886235) buried with Raleigh) of St. Ignatius MT, age 18 years, 1 month, 3 days, b. St. Ignatius, Lake Co. MT, not previously married, daughter of Frank M. Wunder & Kunigunda Franz on 23 Feb 1933 in Polson, Lake Co. MT. His veteran’s record uses a birth date of 2 Nov 1891. He was in service 25 May 1917 to 25 Apr 1919. - His tombstone indicates he was a private 1st class in the Army. SSN 516-03-6603. - Buried in Roseburg National Cemetery, Roseburg, Douglas OR. F: 42112668
- **Nela Cora Fletcher Barney**, 26 Jan 894 WI – 23 Jun 1968 Yakima, Yakima WA. - In the 1940 census, she is living in Fairview, Yakima WA at 901 Wilson Lane, single, age 46, b. WI, no occupation, with her mother Myra Fletcher, 67 WI, widow; they had lived in the same place in 1935. – Wife of Alvin E. Barney (1881-1960, F: 174081218). – Buried in Tahoma Cemetery, Yakima, Yakima WA. F: 174081219
- **Olive Ethel [Ethel Olive] Fletcher Bolson**, 31 Mar 1899 Monroe Co. WI [or Mauston, Juneau WI]– 23 Mar 1995 Cathlamet, Wahkiakum WA. - At age 22, Olive married William L. Bolson (1891-1976, F: 174081655) on 5 Jul 1921 in Lewiston, Fergus MT. SSN 538-09-3068. - Obituary: “Longview (WA) Daily News” 24 Mar 1995 p 14 – Ethel Olive Bolson, age 95, of Cathlamet WA, d. at Columbia View Care Center on 23 Mar 1995. She was born 31 Mar 1899 in Maustin [sic] WI to Charles & Mamie (Carrie) Fletcher. She was a Gold Star mother, her son Robert Bolson having been killed in action in WWII. She spent most of her life in the lower Naches Valley in WA. Survived by a daughter & son. Burial in Tahoma Cemetery. - Buried in Tahoma Cemetery, Yakima, Yakima WA. F: 174017441
- **Harold Delmer Fletcher**. Found in online records as born 1894 WI. Not listed in 1900 census (in which mother says she has given birth to 4 children, all whom are living) and 1910 census, in which she says she gave birth to 7 children, 6 of whom are living)
- **Gladys Hazel / Hazel Gladys Fletcher Hattley Leturner**, 4 Sep 1902 WI – 19 Mar 1986 Columbia Co. OR. - At age 20, married on 5 Jul 1921 in Lewistown, Fergus MT to George Arthur Hattley. - Married Joseph P. Leturner (d. 25 Jul 1973, F: 174018633) on 23 Feb 1933 in Benton Co. WA, using her maiden surname. Joseph died 25 Jul 1973. - “Spokane (WA) Chronicle” 6 Dec 1935 p 22 – Sheriff’s officers have been asked by G.A. Hattley, S717 Della, Stockton CA, to look for his wife, Mrs. Gladys Hattley, whom he has not heard from in 5 years. He believes she is in Spokane with her parents, Mr. & Mrs. C.E. Fletcher. [Note his “wife” remarried in 1933. Perhaps George wished to find her, because in about 3 months - on 6 Apr 1936 - George Arthur Hattley married Ruby Lucretia Halliday in Alameda CA. - George Hattley, b. 27 May 1895 PA, died 29 Dec 1952 in Alameda CA. Funeral: “Oakland (CA) Tribune” 31 Dec 1952 p 21 – survived by wife Ruby & 2 children. Belonged to the boilermakers union. Death: “Oakland (CA) Tribune” 30 Dec 1952 p 15 – Killed in Oakland CA last night was George Hattley, age 57, a boilermaker, resident of 2122 High St., who was trying to walk across Foothill Blvd. at 42nd Avenue. He was struck by a car driven by Charles

Rowley, age 44, and knocked 32 feet into the opposing lane of traffic, where he was run over by 2 cars, 1 driven by Clifford Perry (age 29) & 1 by Alfred Gabriel (age 30). [Other newspaper reports note that a heavy rain was falling.] – She is buried as Hazel Gladys Leturner in Tahoma Cemetery, Yakima, Yakima WA. F: 174117170

- **Bernard Carey Fletcher**, 9 May 1906 Newberg, Yamhill OR – 17 Oct 1979 Yakima, Yakima WA. – Or born 1904? – Divorced at time of death. - Buried in Tahoma Cemetery, Yakima, Yakima WA. F: 174086037

Pre-war:

“Gogebic Iron Tribune” (Hurley WI) 1 Oct 1887 p 6 – pensions were granted to WI petitioners, among them Oliver, father of Charles Fletcher of Mauston.

Oliver Fletcher is the father of Charles W. Fletcher, the grandfather of Charles E. Fletcher, the great-grandfather of Clifford M. Fletcher. He enlisted in Co. K, 6th WI Infantry on 10 May 1861 as a corporal, fighting on the Union side in the Civil War. He was mustered out 22 Jun 1864. He was a resident of Lemonweir WI.

This will enable Charles E. Fletcher’s wife & 3 daughters to belong to the Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) post. “Spokane (WA) Spokesman-Review” 14 Jan 1951 p 36 – The John C. Fremont Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) Posts is celebrating its 51st year of service. Its charter was established 25 Mar 1900; it hangs in the IOOF hall where their meetings are held. On the charter are the names of Nela Fletcher, Ollie Fletcher, Gladys Fletcher & Mrs. C.E. Fletcher.

Wartime:

“Anaconda (MT) Standard” 11 Feb 1918 p 1 – Clifford McK. Fletcher, Victor MT, 1 of the MT men who are safe.

Post-war:

“The Missoulain” (Missoula MT) 3 Mar 1924 p 2 – Mrs. G.A. Hattley [Clifford’s sister Gladys Hazel] of Billings MT was visiting her sister, Mrs. William Bolson [Clifford’s sister Olive], at 1022 Urlin Avenue. She brought along her 6-month-old daughter who is recovering from being scalded a few days ago. The baby was sitting on her mother’s lap at the table when she grabbed a cup of hot tea, scalding her hand & both legs.
