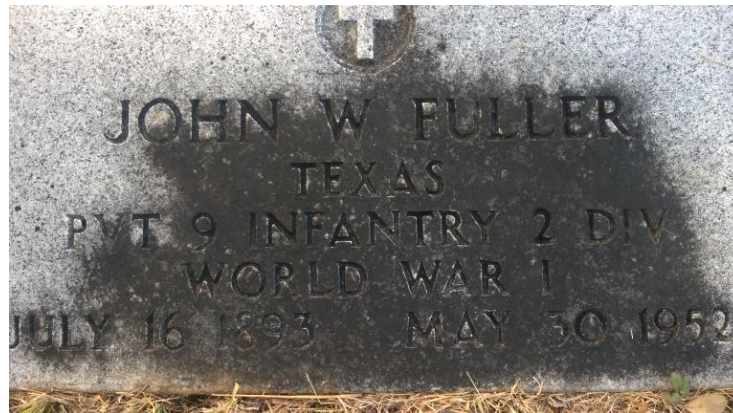

**List of Texans on  
Torpedoed Tuscania**

Washington, Feb. 8.—A large number of Texans and Oklahomans, members of army organizations, were on the ill-fated Tuscania, submarined off the Irish coast Wednesday. Who were lost probably will not be known by the war department for several days as it is necessary to cable the names of the survivors to the United States for checking.

The early estimate of 100 lost, of which approximately 75 were members of the military organization, appears from reports received today at the war department from the British admiralty, to have been too conservative. The number probably will be doubled.

The Texans and Oklahomans, for the main part, were volunteers, and are shown to have been members of practically every organization aboard but there was a detachment from Camp Travis, San Antonio. Three Dallas men appeared in the list. They are: Victor A. Mooner, whose address is given as "Dallas;" John Weatherall, Station A, Routel, and Patrick H. White of 711 South Akard Street. The other Texans listed were:

## Two Gilmer Boys On The Tuscania

The sinking by a German submarine of the Tuscania, off the Irish coast on its way over with American forces, brings us to a greater realization of the war, bringing it to our doors, and wringing the hearts of some of our own people with anxiety, while they awaited news of the fate of our boys.

On the ship were two Gilmer boys and one Gladewater boy, besides many from neighboring counties.

John Fuller, Gilmer; E. F. Young, Gilmer; Sam A. Jones, Gladewater, R. I. appeared in the list of Texans on the ill-fated ship.

A telegram to his father Sunday stated that John Fuller was among the survivors, was received here. Sunday's papers contained the name of Sam A. Jones, among the survivors, but so far as is known nothing has been heard of E. F. Young, at this writing, though he may be all right as Young would be among the last names listed alphabetically.

Besides the Upshur county boys on the ship appears the name of Roy French and L. Landrum, Mt. Pleasant; Wm. E. Howell, Kilgore; all close to us.—Gilmer Mirror.

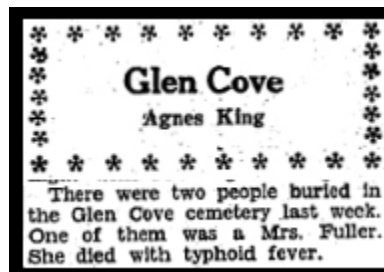

Mrs. Fuller died Sunday at 2 p.m. in an Abilene hospital.

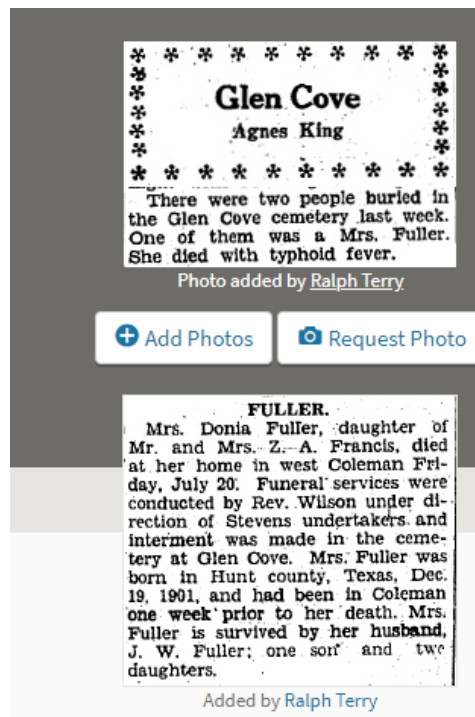

Columbus Fuller was employed in saw milling; her parents were residents of Pritchett TX. - **Columbus B. Fuller**, 1898 (Jan 1897 in 1900 census) Upshur Co. Linne had married his brother, George M. Fuller (known as “Ray” or “Cay” Fuller) on 24 Dec 1917 in Upshur Co. TX. – Eliga died of cardiac arrest following a gall bladder operation.
