WI; his obituary appears in the "Milwaukee (WI) Journal Sentinel" 7 Nov 1966. – Gail was survived by 6 children & her sister, Phyllis Crary. - Her obituary appears in the "Milwaukee Journal Sentinel" of 8 Nov 2009. - Buried in Good Hope Cemetery, Greenfield, Milwaukee WI. F: 175496963

Siblings: Ancestry.com family trees are very tangled (and incorrect) due to the lack of consistency in the spelling of first names & surnames by the family. Since in the 1900 census their mother Louise said she gave birth to 7 children, 7 of whom are living, the names below appear to be the complete list of siblings. Phillip was the 4th child.

- **William Steven (or G.) Gagnier**, 20 Aug 1886 Bay City, Bay Co. MI – alive in the 1920 census (19 Jan 1920) in Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI & listed in the 1923 Milwaukee WI city directory; his wife has remarried by the 1930 census (conducted 29 Apr 1930). - At age 22, William G. Gagnier Jr., son of William G. Gagnier & Louise Garrant, both b. Canada, married on 31 Jul 1909 in Milwaukee WI to Martha Growth, age 21, daughter of Fred Growth & Dora Pieschel, both b. in Germany. – In the 1910 census for Greenfield, Milwaukee WI, conducted 9 May 1910, William Giguere [Gagnier], age 23, b. MI, father b. Canada (French), mother b. Germany, was a machinist in a machine shop. Residing with him was his wife Martha, 22 WI, parents b. Germany. They had been married 1 year. - On his 1917 WWI draft card, registered 18 Sep 1917, William Steven Gagnier, b. 20 Aug 1886 Bay City MI, resided at 522 - 4th Ave. NW in Milwaukee, married with 3 children, a machinist for Pfister & Vogel. - In the 1920 census, conducted 17 Jan 1920, William Gagnier (33 MI) resides with wife Martha (31 WI) & their 3 daughters: Dorothy (9), Elenor (7) & Florence (5), all born in WI, in Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI. – Martha Emma Groth married George Julius Behling (1886-1961, F: 141049413 by the time of the 1930 census. She was born 11 Apr 1888 & died 1 Feb 1959 & is buried with the surname Gagnier-Behling in Arlington Park Cemetery, Greenfield, Milwaukee WI, F: 141049710.
- **Louise Gagnier Abelt**, 10 Jan 1888 Bay City, Bay Co. MI – 5 Mar 1967 Milwaukee Co. WI. – Her name appears as Lola in the 1900 census & on her brother Frank's birth certificate & as Julia on her sister Adele Gagner's birth certificate. - Wife of Alfred R. Abelt (1890-1961, F: 215619646) whom she married 6 Jun 1914 in Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI. - Buried in Wisconsin Memorial Park, Brookfield, Waukesha WI. F: 215619645

- **George Lewis Gagnier**, 9 Oct 1890 [1884 in military records & on headstone] WI – 4 Dec 1939 San Diego Co. CA. - SSN 554-01-5488. - As can be seen on his national cemetery interment form, his name was entered as George Louis Gagner, with the Louis crossed off in favor of Lewis. But his tombstone is inscribed George Louis Gagnier in Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery, San Diego, San Diego CA. - His interment record notes that GAGNER was a chief, boilermaker, US Navy, who died 1 Dec 1939. Interred on 6 Dec 1939 in section C, grave 33. Retired 1 Aug 1939. - The 1938 San Diego CA city directory lists George L. Gagnier (with Abbie J.), a laborer, at 1059 – 26th. - George L. Gagnier married Abbie Jane Wight (1884-1970, F: 71825722) in 1916 in Philadelphia, Philadelphia PA. He was mustered into service in 1907 at the Marine Barracks, Navy Yard, Brooklyn NY as a private. – Buried in Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery, San Diego, San Diego CA. F: 3401136
- **Earl Frederick Gagnie**, 31 Dec 1895 Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI (at 528 Hanover St.) – 24 Dec 1964 West Allis, Milwaukee WI (in the Community Hospital). – Although one census & his WWI draft registration spell his surname Gagnier, his WI birth record, the majority of censuses (1920, 1930, 1950), Social Security, his WI death record & his WWII draft registration spell his surname GAGNIE. – Husband of Frieda Erna Lewalski (8 Dec 1896 Berlin, Germany – 20 Dec 1979 WI). Earl & Frieda married 18 Feb 1915 in Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI. In the 1920 census, the couple resided with her parents, Carl & Anne Lowalski in Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI.
- **Margaret Gagnier, Feb 1898** WI (1900 census) ? - . This date must be earlier than appears on the 1900 census as her sister Adele was born in Jan 1898 & mentions “Gertie” as an older sibling. Apparently referred to as Ethel on her brother Frank’s birth certificate. Adele’s middle name might be Ethel. – Listed in the 1910 census (conducted 28 Apr 1910). – Was she the Margareta Gagnier who married Arthur White on 20 May 1916 in Milwaukee WI? Or was this Arthur Wille? – In the 1920 census for Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI, conducted 2 Jun 1930, Arthur Willre, 28 WI, parents b. Canada (English), a stock clerk, lived with wife Margaret, age 22, b. WI, parents b. Canada, on 17th St. – Was their daughter Jean Mary Wille Hills (28 Jan 1921 Milwaukee WI – 10 Oct 1999 Terre Haute, Vigo IN, F: 236668973) whose Find A Grave record says her father died when she was 4 years old? - Was Margaret’s husband Arthur Wille, 17 Mar 1892 – 27 Feb 1925, son of Fred Wille & Bertha Duwe, buried in Lincoln Memorial Cemetery, Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI, F: 132326647?
- **Adele Gagner, 6 Jan 1898** (Sunday, 12:45 a.m.) - Born to William L. Gagner, iron moulder, b. in Canada & Louise Garant, b. Canada. Their other children were Julia, George, Phillip & Gertie. She was born at 634 Hanover St. This listing does not include Earl. – Was her middle name Ethel?
- **Francis (Frank) Gagnier**, 2 Dec 1899 [1900 on Find A Grave record] Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI (at 634 Hanover St.) – 13 May 1931 Thompson Hotel, Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI. - His WI birth record lists his siblings as Willie, Lola, George, Phillip, Earl & Ethel. His father was William GAGNER, iron moulder & his mother Louise Garrant, both parents b. Canada. He registered for the WWI draft as Frank Gagnie. – Buried in Calvary Cemetery & Mausoleum, Milwaukee, Milwaukee WI. F: 23926548
