

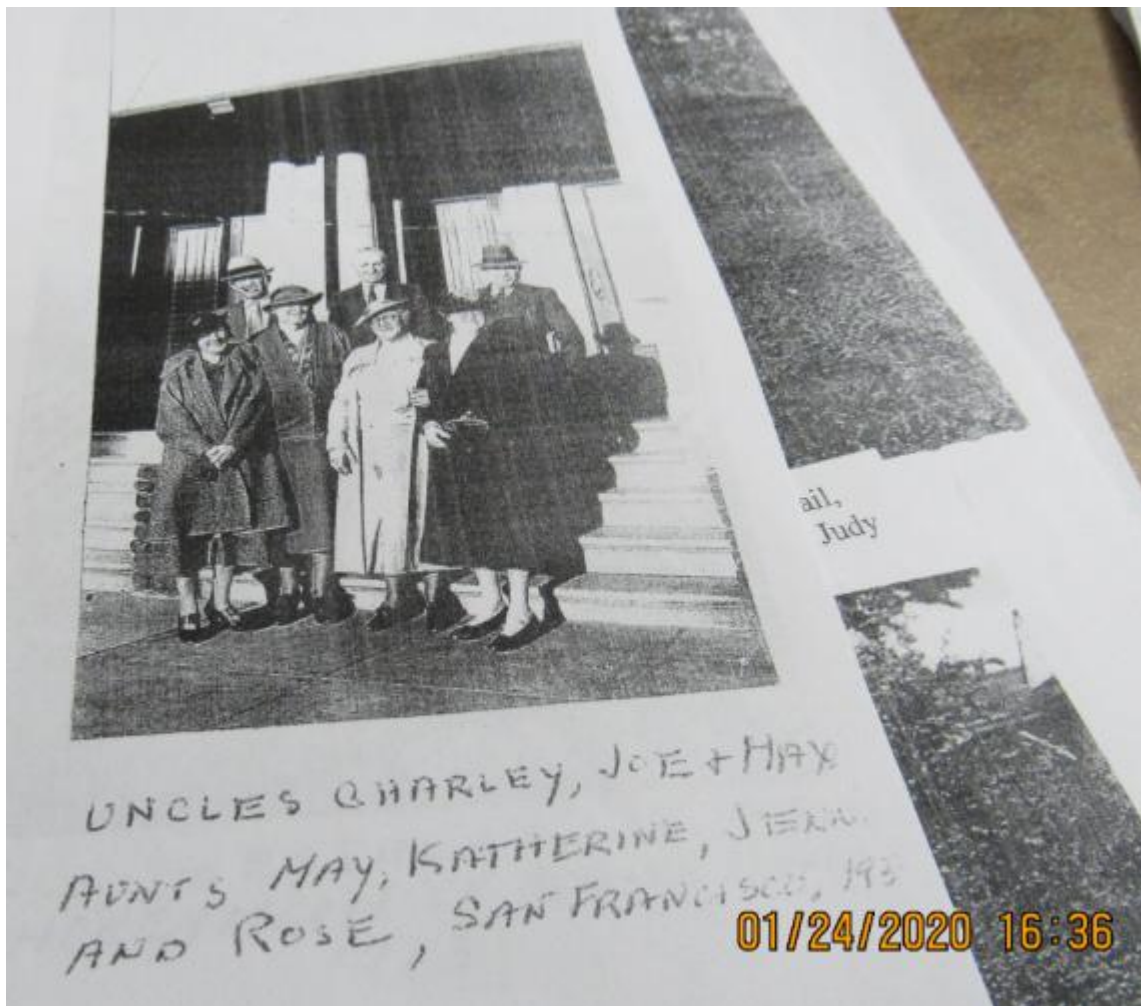

CALIFORNIANS SAVED AT SEA BY FLASHLIGHT

"S. O. S." From Pocket Lamp Results in Rescue of 39 Men Adrift After Tuscania Sank

British Dumb While Yanks Sing "Hail, Hail, the Gang's All Here," Says an Officer

NEW YORK, March 20.—(By Universal Service).—Sixteen wounded Californians arrived here on the transport Harrisburg and fifty members of the Fortieth Division debarked from the Luckenbach and entrained for Camp Merritt, N. J., this afternoon.

Lieutenant Don D. Hawley, 3739 Washington street, San Francisco, who was gassed in the Argonne and was on the Tuscania when it was torpedoed, told a thrilling story of his experiences on the transport.

For five hours Hawley and thirty-eight others were adrift in an open boat. They were saved by one man who flashed "S. O. S." signals with a pocket flashlight.

"I liked the story the newspapers in this country printed about the British singing 'God Save the King' while the Yanks stood at attention and sang the 'Star-Spangled Banner' as the ship went down," said Hawley.

"The truth," he added, "is that the British didn't let out a chirp while the Yanks sang 'Hail, Hail, the Gang's All Here,' and 'Where Do We Go From Here, Boys?'"

Lieutenant Colonel Henry Brown, Sacramento, came back in command of the One Hundred and Sixtieth Infantry. He said the regiment did not get into action as a unit.

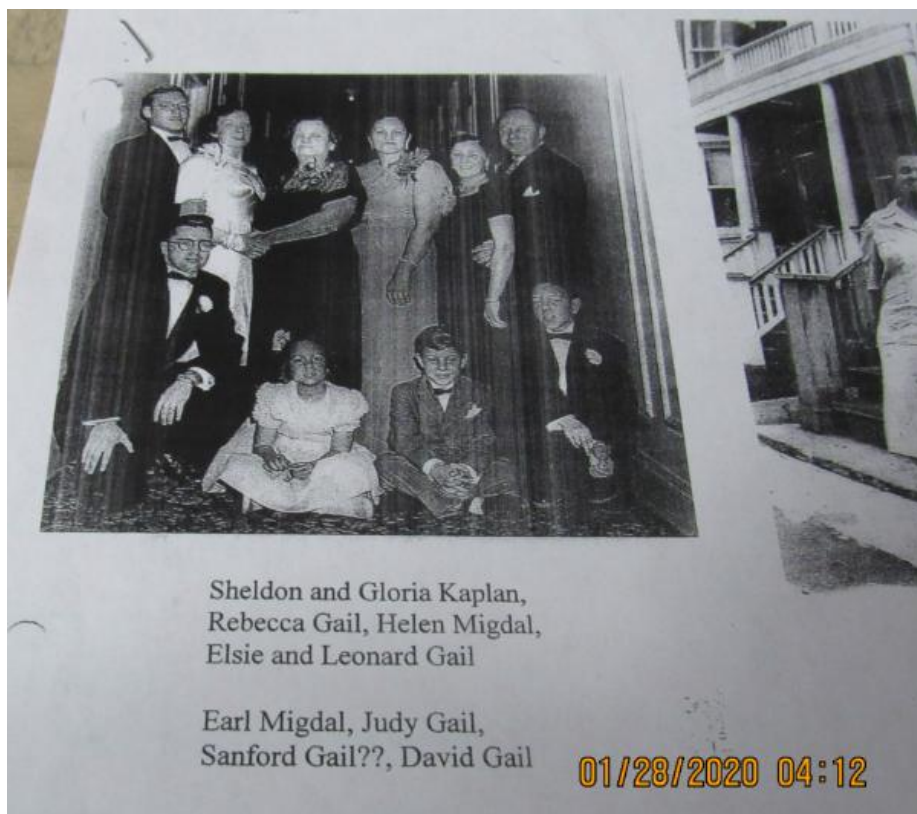

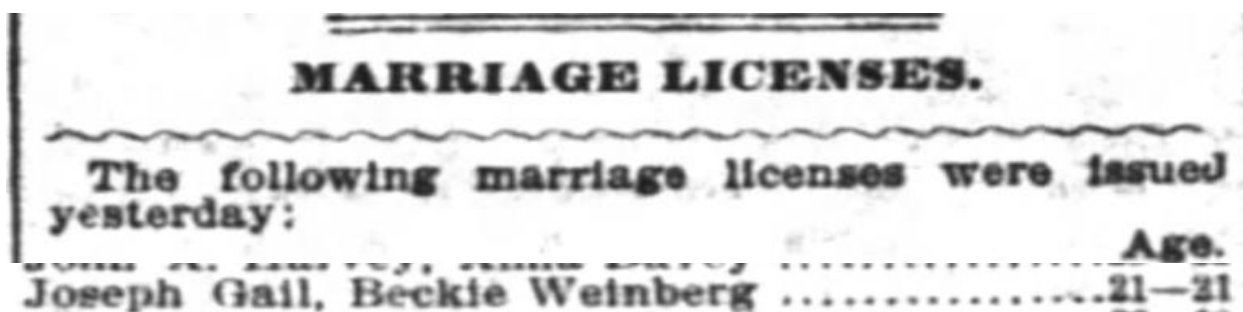
