2 Complaints Filed In Federal Court

A complaint against Tony Francisco was filed by the United States in federal court this morning, asking \$135 plus \$101.77 interest for crop production loans made in 1932.

An information was also filed here today by the United States against Isaac Glassley. The defendant is charged with selling wine to three Indian persons on Fort Peck Indian reservation at Poplar July 27.

Among the indictments returned by a federal grand jury at Helena and received at the federal court office here are five indictments charging violation of the Indian liquor laws. Those charged are:

Homer Baker, alleged to have sold wine to Virgil Lamewoman at Billings, March 21, 1947; Roy F. Jones, charged with selling liquor to Richard Little Light at Hardin March 15, 1947; Isaac Glassley, charged with the sale of liquor to Daniel Comes Last at Poplar May 16, 1947; Ernest Martin, charged with sale of liquor to Isaac Pierre of Kalispell March 11, 1947, and John Hart, charged with selling liquor to Pete Caye at Kalispell. All the men charged above have prior convictions for violating the Indian liquor laws.

Today is the anniversary of the sinking of the Tuscania on Feb. 5, 1918 during WWI and is remembered by several folks in the Bitter Root who are relatives of Elmer Cowan, a star Victor athlete and Marcus Cook of Como who lost their lives on the ship.

Among the survivors of the ship who were rescued as it was sinking by a British destroyer and landed in Ireland are J. E. Babbitt and L. B. Watters of Victor, Ike Glassley of Hamilton and Albert Tillman of Florence, a brother of Roy Tillman of Hamilton. The men were members of the 20th Engineers Division and the ill-fated ship was off the coast of Scotland.

PAIR AT SHERIDAN WILL BE TRIED IN COURT MONDAY

Sheridan. — Otto Vosika, 28, charged with violation of the Mann act, and Willard G. Bunnell, Gillette ranchman, charged with attempted extortion, are lodged in the Sheridan county jail pending trial in federal court here next week.

Both cases have been set for trial here Monday by U. S. District Judge T. Blake Kennedy. Deputy U. S. Marshal William (Wild Bill) Norred brought the two prisoners here from Cheyenne Saturday.

Indictments against the two were returned by the federal grand jury at Cheyenne in May. Vosika allegedly brought Thelma Faverty, also known as Mrs. Fred Busher, here from Deadwood, S. D., for immoral purposes. Bunnell is charged in the indictment with using the mails in an attempt to obtain \$3,200 from Bert Norfolk, another Gillette ranchman.

Vosika will be defended by R. G. Diefenderfer of Sheridan, appointed by the court when Vosika entered a plea of not guilty. Diefenderfer, who conferred with Vosika this week, said the man declared his innocence. Roy Hardy, also known as Roy Harvey, who is also charged with a Mann act violation, in bringing Kay Hertsy here from Deadwood, will be tried here next week, but it is not known who will be his attorney.

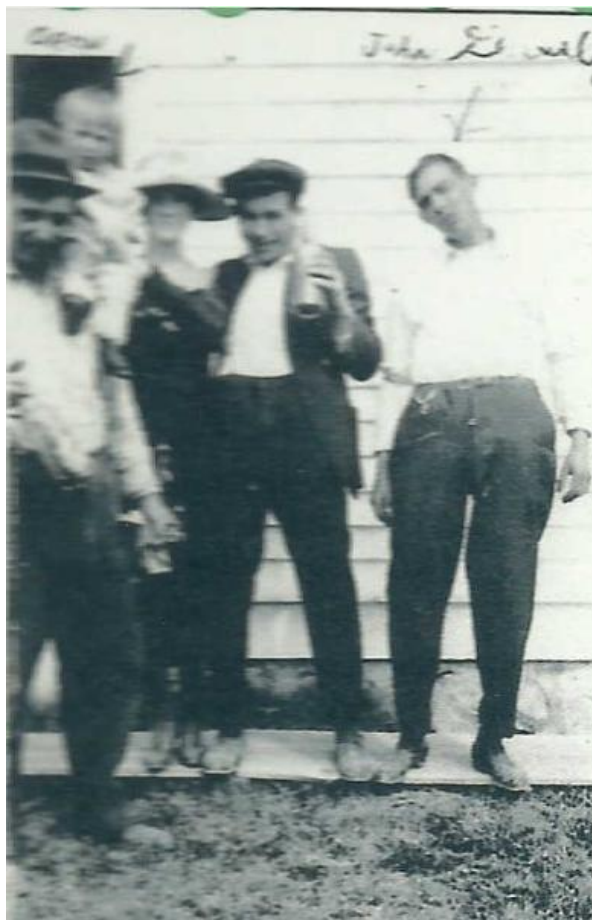
Funeral Held for Mishap Victim

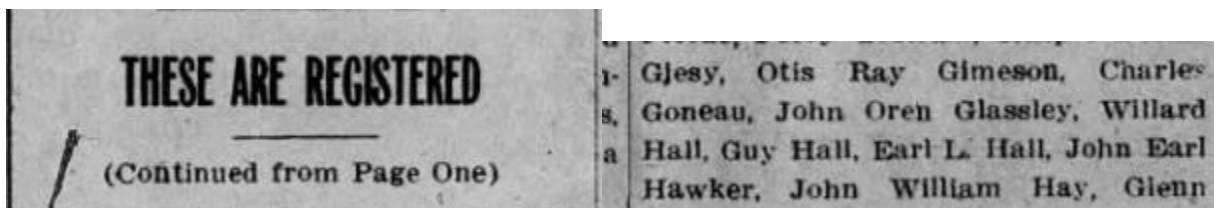

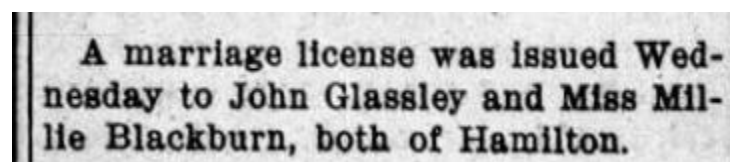

Accident Victim Does Not Recall Details of Crash

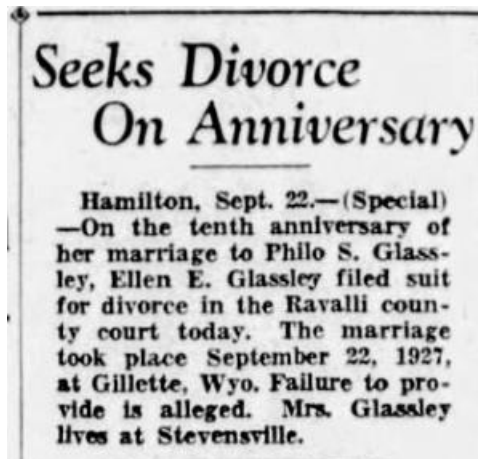

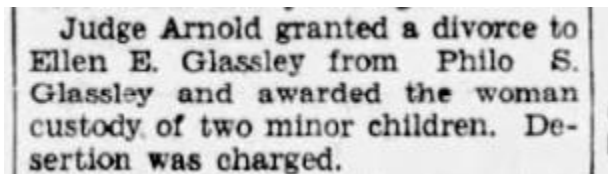

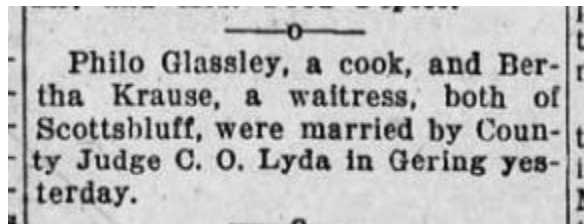

At the time of her death, her husband was Keith H. McKay but she is buried with the surname Hannah. "Helena (MT) Independent-Record" 24 Sep 1937 p 8 – "Wifey Hands the Old Man Divorce for Anniversary" – Hamilton MT 23 Sep 1937: On their 10th anniversary Ellen E. Glassley filed suit in Ravalli County Court today for a divorce from Philo S. Glassley. The couple married 22 Sep 1927 in Gillette WY. She charges failure to provide; Ellen lives in Stevensville MT. – "Ravalli Republic" 23 Jun 1938 p 5 – Judge Arnold granted a divorce to Ellen E. Glassley from Philo S. He had originally pled innocent while she pled guilty. He then changed his plea & both served probation for one year. – Now divorced, Philo was free to marry his lover, so on 21 Jul 1938 Philo married Bertha Rose Shader Krause (1916 NE – 1999 OR) in Gering, Scotts Bluff NE. Bertha Schader was the daughter of Frederick Edward (Fred) Shrader (1878 KS – 1947 NE, F: 44960041) & Myrtle Mae Goodwin (1887-1950, F: 141699906). – Philo was a resident of Cozad NE in Oct 1940 when his brother John died. – "Cozad (NE) Local" 30 Jul 1940 p 4 – Philo Glassley, who has been the chef at Hap's Café for over a year, resigned his position. – Bertha R. Glassley of Gering, Scotts Bluff NE filed for divorce on 28 Nov 1947, claiming that Philo cursed & beat her. The divorce was granted 6 Jan 1948, with Bertha receiving custody of 2 minor children. Bertha married Raymond E. Mathis on 17 Jul 1957 in Stevenson, Skamania WA; they divorced after 10 months of marriage, on 14 May 1958. Bertha married Roy H. Gies (1913-1959) on 25 Jun 1948 in Clark Co. WA. Bertha married Joseph Garbarino (1918-1985, F: 148457249) in Reno, Washoe NV on 18 Apr 1972. She is buried with the surname Garbarino in Wilhelm's Portland Memorial Mausoleum, Portland, Multnomah OR, F: 204932078. – On 20 Nov 1954 in Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai ID Philo Glassley, b, Stevensville MT, resident of Millwood, Spokane WA, age 54, married Ida Belle Shepherd May (Magistrale) b. Fulton MO, resident of Spokane, Spokane WA, age 54 on the same day they obtained a license, by a justice of the peace. Ida Belle Shepherd (27 Apr 1900 Fulton Co. MO – 10 Jan 1979 Spokane, Spokane WA) was the daughter of James Thomas Shepherd & Annie Artynitia Burns. At age 19, she had married Ira Daniel Knight, age 30, a soldier, on 2 Jul 1919 in Spokane, Spokane WA. He was the son of Charles & Sara Knight, both b. ME. Ira Daniel Knight was born 30 Aug 1889 Harrison IL & died 29 Dec 1964 on Bainbridge Island, Kitsap WA, F: 37127979). She had also married Frank Sam May (also known as Magistrale), 1893 Italy-1955 WA, F: 133001824. Ida is buried with the surname Magistrale in Fairmount Memorial Park, Spokane, Spokane WA, F: 133001973. – Accident: "Spokane (WA) Chronicle" 16 Mar 1960 p 24 – Philo S. Glassley, age 59, of N5108 Market, was injured last night when as a pedestrian he was hit by a car at Queen & Market. He was taken to Sacred Heart Hospital with shock & arm & leg injuries. – According to his WA death certificate, Philo Seldon Glassley, divorced, employed as a bartender & cook at restaurants, was cremated at the Riplinger Crematory, Spokane, Spokane WA.

Lynn, who died at age 92, will be held 3 Mar 1997 with burial in Mount Pisgah. Lottie d. 27 Feb 1997 at Pioneer Manor Nursing Home of natural causes.
