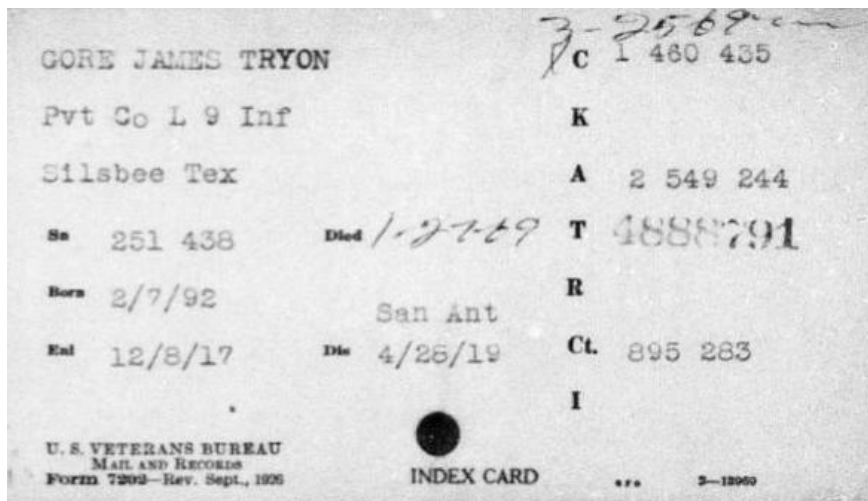

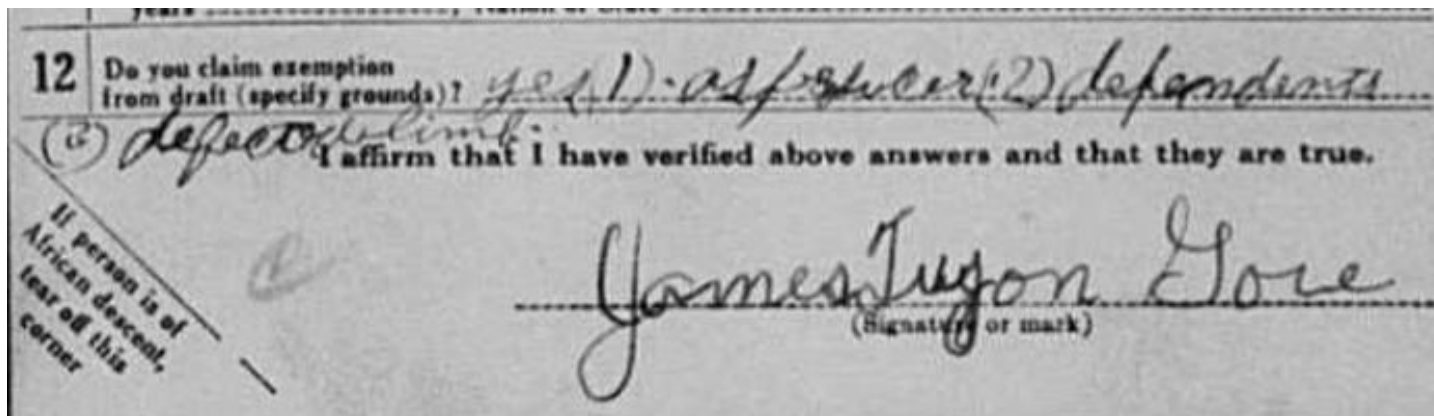

List of Texans on Torpedoed Tuscania

Washington, Feb. 8.—A large number of Texans and Oklahomans, members of army organizations, were on the ill-fated Tuscania, submarined off the Irish coast Wednesday. Who were lost probably will not be known by the war department for several days as it is necessary to cable the names of the survivors to the United States for checking.

The early estimate of 100 lost, of which approximately 75 were members of the military organization, appears from reports received today at the war department from the British admiralty, to have been too conservative. The number probably will be doubled.

The Texans and Oklahomans, for the main part, were volunteers, and are shown to have been members of practically every organization aboard but there was a detachment from Camp Travis, San Antonio. Three Dallas men appeared in the list. They are: Victor A. Mooner, whose address is given as "Dallas;" John Weatherall, Station A, Routel, and Patrick H. White of 711 South Akard Street. 12 TEXANS IN IRISH HOSPITALS

WAR DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES NAMES OF SIXTY-THREE TUSCANIA SURVIVORS.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 24.—Sixty-three survivors of the transport *Tuscania*, sunk by a German submarine February 5, still are in Irish hospitals, according to a cable report announced by the War Department tonight.

None of the men is in a serious condition and it is expected that all of them will be discharged from the hospitals within a short time.

Forty of the wounded and sick men are at Londonderry, nineteen at Larne, three at Belfast and one at Dublin. Those at Londonderry follow:

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 24.—The Associated Press list of unaccounted for stands at sixty-six, including thirty-two unidentified dead buried on the Scottist coast.

An Associated Press dispatch from London last Wednesday said latest figures at American Army Headquarters there showed that 204 Americans lost their lives on the Tuscania, 140 of whom had been identified and buried. Thirty-two unidentified had been buried, leaving thirty-two missing, who presumably had gone down with the ship.

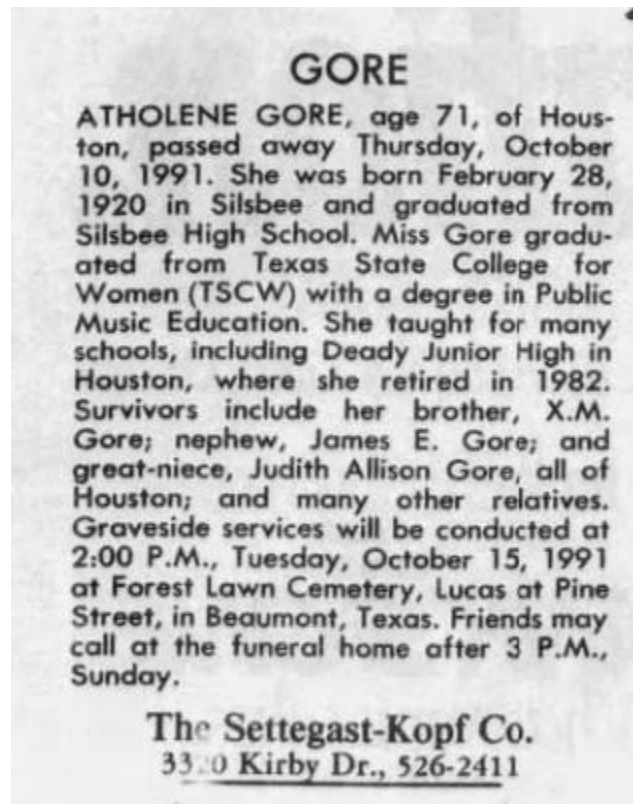

Arthur Gore, 76, Silsbee, Native, Dies

SILSBEE (Sp) — Arthur L. Gore, 76, died at 7:25 p. m. Thursday in Baptist Hospital in Beaumont, where he had been a patient since February.

Gore was a native of Silsbee and a graduate of the University of Texas with a Ph.D. degree.

AS A YOUNG man he was a teacher and principal of the high school in Montgomery, Tex. After he left teaching, he was employed as a chemist with the Gulf Refining Co. in Port Arthur until his retirement.

After his retirement he was the Silsbee representative for the International Correspondence School until he retired 11 years ago. He was interested in the promotion of the growth of Satsuma oranges in this area and at one time set out a grove of more than 25 acres of the trees for commercial purposes.

HIS ENTIRE orchard was destroyed in a freeze in 1929 and after that he replanted the orchard, experimenting with Tung trees which are used in tung oil products. This field was later destroyed by drought.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Rex O. Corley Sr., Beaumont; three brothers, Carl and Stanley, both of Silsbee, and Jim of Houston; two sisters, Mrs. Becky Hendricks, Honey Island, and Mrs. Callie Theus, Port Arthur; three grandchildren.

Funeral rites will be at 2 p. m. Saturday in Wilcox-May Pontecostal Church north of Silsbee. The Rev. W. A. Rashall will officiate. Burial will be in Forest Lawn Cemetery in Beaumont under the direction of Farmer Funeral Home.
