2. Adelard J. Gosselin vs. City of Newburyport

This was an action involving the validity of the City Ordinances as whether or not they were properly published and more particularly the validity of Chapter 19A, Section 3 of said Ordinances, wherein the City Council required confirmation of any appointment for the position of Police Captain. This case necessitated a meeting of the City Council on March 3, 1942, confirming Neil T. Kelleher, the present incumbent to said office of Captain. Further progress on this matter was as follows:

1. On March 10, 1942, there was a hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall. This hearing was continued after the introduction of some of evidence.
2. The continued hearing on the same matter was held April 8, 1942. At this time the Mayor and the City Council voted to notify Adelard J. Gosselin, that he held the position of Captain illegally.
3. After a petition for Review of this case was filed by Adelard J. Gosselin under Chapter 31, of the General Laws, this case was heard in the District Court at Newburyport on May 21, 1942, before Associate Justice Viccaro who heard the matter at the request of Nathaniel N. Jones, presiding Justice of the District Court of Newburyport. On July 8, 1942, Special Justice Vicarro filed a finding, affirming the action of the Mayor and the City Council, that Adelard J. Gosselin held the position of Captain illegally.

4. On July 30, 1942, Civil Service Commissioner Lupien notified the City of Newburyport that Neil T. Kelleher was certified as Captain of the Police Department of the City of Newburyport.

5. On August 27, 1942, Associate Justice Vicarro was served with an order to show cause why a writ of certiorari should not issue, reviewing the entire case on questions of law.

6. In pursuance of said order "to show cause etc." a hearing was held at the Essex Superior Court at Lawrence on September 14, 1942, at which time the Respondent, through the City Solicitor, filed a "Respondent's Return to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari."

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ANNUAL REPORT

7. On September 23, 1942, a hearing was held before Chief Justice John P. Higgins on the question of the denial or allowance of the petition. The matter was taken under advisement and on November 19, 1942, Chief Justice Higgins made the following finding: "Ordered that the petition for Writ of Certiorari be and the same hereby is dismissed as matter of Law."

8. On November 24, 1942, the petitioner, Adelard J. Gosselin, filed his "Claim of Exceptions" and on December 14, 1942, the petitioner filed his "Bill of Exceptions."

9. On April 17, 1943, the petitioner's "Bill of Exceptions" were dismissed.

10. On April 20, 1943, Judgment was entered for Leslie Viccarro and against Adelard J. Gosselin, thereby in effect upholding the position taken by the City of Newburyport.

Without reporting in detail, reference is made to the numerous and technical notices and counter-notices which had to be filed or studied and then sent to the Civil Service Commissioner during the process of concluding this complicated case. This report further directs your attention to the many hours of painstaking search of the law in successfully defending the position of the Mayor and the City Council with reference to the City Ordinance (Chapter 19A-Section 3).

Gosselin of this city, who was on the Tuscania when she was torpedoed off the Irish Coast Tuesday night, is 19 years old and the son of Mrs Adele Gosselin of 178 Water st. He is one of 14 children. He enlisted in the 158th Aero Squadron and was on his way to France to join the American forces.

Within a short time his mother received a letter from him stating he was pleased with the service and was anxious to see it through. A brother, Joseph, is also in the service, being present in Texas.

MAJORITY OF BAY STATE MEN SAVED

None Known Definitely to
Be Among Victims

Massachusetts Soldiers on List of Tuscania Survivors

News of the safety of a big majority of the Massachusetts men who were on the transport Tuscania when she received her death wound from a German torpedo off the coast of Ireland Tuesday, came yesterday in dispatches from Ireland and from the War Department.

Of the 29 Bay State men known to have been on the Tuscania, all have been listed as rescued with the exception of seven.

Four officers on board who claimed Massachusetts as their home were saved.

Lieut. Richard Warren of Waltham cabled Mrs. Warren of his safety Thursday, and Edward W. Borst of Newton Center reported his arrival in Ireland the same day.

NEWBURYPORT, Feb 10—Representative Carl C. Emery today received a telegram from Congressman W. W. Lufkin at Washington, stating that Ade-

larde J. Gosselin, cook, 158th Aero Squadron, son of Mr and Mrs Desire Gosselin of 178 Water st, who was on the SS Tuscania, sunk by a German torpedo, had been saved. "Please notify his family and tell them how pleased I am," said the Congressman. Representative Emery notified the family early today and there was great rejoicing. Congressman Lufkin has promised to keep special watch for news touching soldiers and sailors living in his district and to promptly transmit it.

NEWBURYPORT, Feb. 10.—Parents of Adelard J. Gosselin, aged 19 years, a member of the 158th aero squadron, which was on the Tuscania, were made happy tonight by receipt of a telegram from Congressman Lufkin announcing that his name was among the list of survivors, uninjured.

Asks for Arrest

"I call upon you, therefore, as an honest, fearless and conscientious police executive to make arrests of Mr Gillis, or anybody else in his employ who is detected selling gasoline until a license is issued by the City Council.

"This is not the duty of the State officials. It is the duty of the city Police Department, and failure to perform this duty furnishes the basis of a real ground for complaint under the Civil Service laws. I do not think this will be necessary.

"Nothing will do more to reestablish the good reputation of Newburyport at large than to see the Police Department do its duty in this matter of open and flagrant violation of the law by the chief executive whose sworn obligation is to enforce the law."

In spite of orders of the Mayor to file a formal complaint in the office of the clerk of courts against Mrs Ernest Foss, wife of attorney Foss who conducted the prosecution yesterday, charging her with having a revolver on the public streets the night of July 3, reserve officer Adelard Gosselin did not act.

He was at the police station and expressed his disinclination to make the complaint. He had been informed that Mrs Foss had a permit to carry a revolver and he felt that if any complaint was made it should be by the regular patrolman who was with him at the time of the affair.

GILLIS' BOND ISSUE ORDER GOES TO SECOND READING

NEWBURYPORT, July 30—At a special meeting of the City Council last evening, Pres Edward Bass presiding, an order recommended by Mayor Gillis providing for a bond issue of \$50,000 for sewer construction was passed to its second reading. This takes the place of an order for \$25,000 charged to a specially authorized issue, which, it was found, was invalid. The new issue is under the General Laws. The Mayor stated that if the amount proved too much for extension in Ward 6 it could be applied to two streets elsewhere.

The Mayor's appointment of Adelard J. Gosselin as a regular police officer and Henry E. Gagnon as a reserve police officer were confirmed.

LYNCH DOES NOT ASK FOR SHARE IN REWARD

Five Newburyport Officers Query Lufkin on Seizure

NEWBURYPORT, April 10—Seeking information regarding any reward for their part in the seizure of \$300,000 worth of liquor on March 24, five night patrolmen have queried W. W. Lufkin, collector of customs of the Port of Boston.

The five, who took part in the seizure, are John J. Fenders, Neil T. Kelliher, James E. Sullivan, Clinton S. Nason and Adelard J. Gosselin.

The name of patrolman Daniel J. Lynch, who is credited with being largely responsible for frustrating the rum-running attempt, does not appear in the letter.

Collector of Customs Lufkin has sent a letter to City Marshal John J. McLean, stating that if the cargo of liquor is sold and if any compensation is due the policemen they will be notified in time to submit a formal claim for the reward.

Patrolman Lynch, who saw the trucks in the vicinity of the wharf and asked for officers to be sent there, was questioned tonight on the subject, and he said that he had not applied for the reward, although some one had told him there is a possibility of the Government turning over to the police some of the money received from the sale of the liquor.

"PROSPERITY" FRAY LANDS PAIR IN COURT

Amesbury Man and Woman Fined in Newburyport

NEWBURYPORT, April 17 — A sequel to the near-riot at the prosperity exposition held in the Henchey Building, Titcomb st, last night, occurred in the District Court this morning when Judge Nathaniel N. Jones fined an Amesbury man and woman \$5 each for obstructing the sidewalk, a violation of a city ordinance. Charges of assault of an officer were filed.

Miss Verna Harper, 34, of 33 Friend st, and Joseph Lachancem, 38, of 17 Friend st, both of Amesbury, were the delendants.

The former pleaded guilty to the charge on which she was fined and to the charge of assault on patrolman Neil T. Kelleher. The latter was filed.

Because the large exposition hall, where Newburyport merchants are displaying their products and merchandise in a four-day exposition, became overcrowded, Director Norman Doyle gave orders to policemen to allow no more persons to enter. There were more than 2000 inside the building and several hundred outside the doors.

The orders of Director Doyle were resented by those outside and they attempted to gain admittance and started pushing and shoving.

Police on duty at the hall sent in a hurried call for reserves. The Fire Department also was called, but did not respond.

Patrolman Kelleher, after ordering Miss Harper and Lachancem away from the door, met with resistance. The officer's coat was torn in the struggle when he was jumped upon. The two Amesbury residents were locked up by patrolman Kelleher and A. J. Gosselin and bailed for their appearance in court this morning.

SEVERAL POLICE SHIFTS MADE BY MAYOR GILLIS

NEWBURYPORT, Sept 15—Several shifts in the Police Department took effect last night at the order of Mayor Gillis. Three night officers were put back on day duty.

Patrolmen Henry G. Fenders, Eugene Sullivan and Humphrey Haley of the day police have been given night duty. Patrolmen George Adams, Daniel J. Lynch and John J. Horgan, the oldest members of the force, were put back on day duty after working nights for many months.

Patrolman Clinton S. Nason, who has been on a South End beat nights, was given motorcycle duty. Patrolman A. J. Gosselin has been assigned to duty in Market sq days, after riding a motorcycle for months.

GILLIS GIVES POLICE PARTING TRANSFERS

Orders Widest Shakeup of
Career at Newburyport

Special Dispatch to the Globe

NEWBURYPORT, Dec 13—Although he had announced that he would make no spectacular move during the few days in office which still remain for him, Mayor Andrew J. Gillis late tonight stepped into the police station and gave orders for the most drastic shakeup of an administration which has been, more or less, just one police shakeup after another. He made no comment on his move.

This time, except for three superior officers and four patrolmen, the whole force is affected. Political observers said the Mayor's act was the result of his having been beaten at the polls by Gayden W. Morrill, who is expected to stage a police shakeup of his own when he takes office Jan 4.

The changes are to go into effect tomorrow morning.

Patrolmen John D. Foley and Daniel J. Lynch were shifted from night duty to day duty. Patrolmen George F. Adams and Adelard J. Gosselin were told to report for night duty instead of day duty. Patrolman Clinton Nason, who has been doing motorcycle duty, has been shifted to a night beat on foot.

The routes of other officers were changed.

Not long afterward the officer, A. J. Gosselin, learned he is a salesman for funeral supplies and cemetery articles and that the flowers and other goods in his car were samples.

Newburyport Police Ask Two New Officers

NEWBURYPORT, Nov. 5—City Marshal James E. Sullivan today asked Mayor F. Carens to add two policemen to the department and fill the vacancy of assistant city marshal.

The marshal claims that the police force is undermanned. By promoting a policeman to the assistant marshal's berth a new officer would have to be appointed from the reserve force. A vacancy in the ranks of patrolmen exists due to recent elevation by the Mayor of A. J. Gosselin to captain.
