burial.

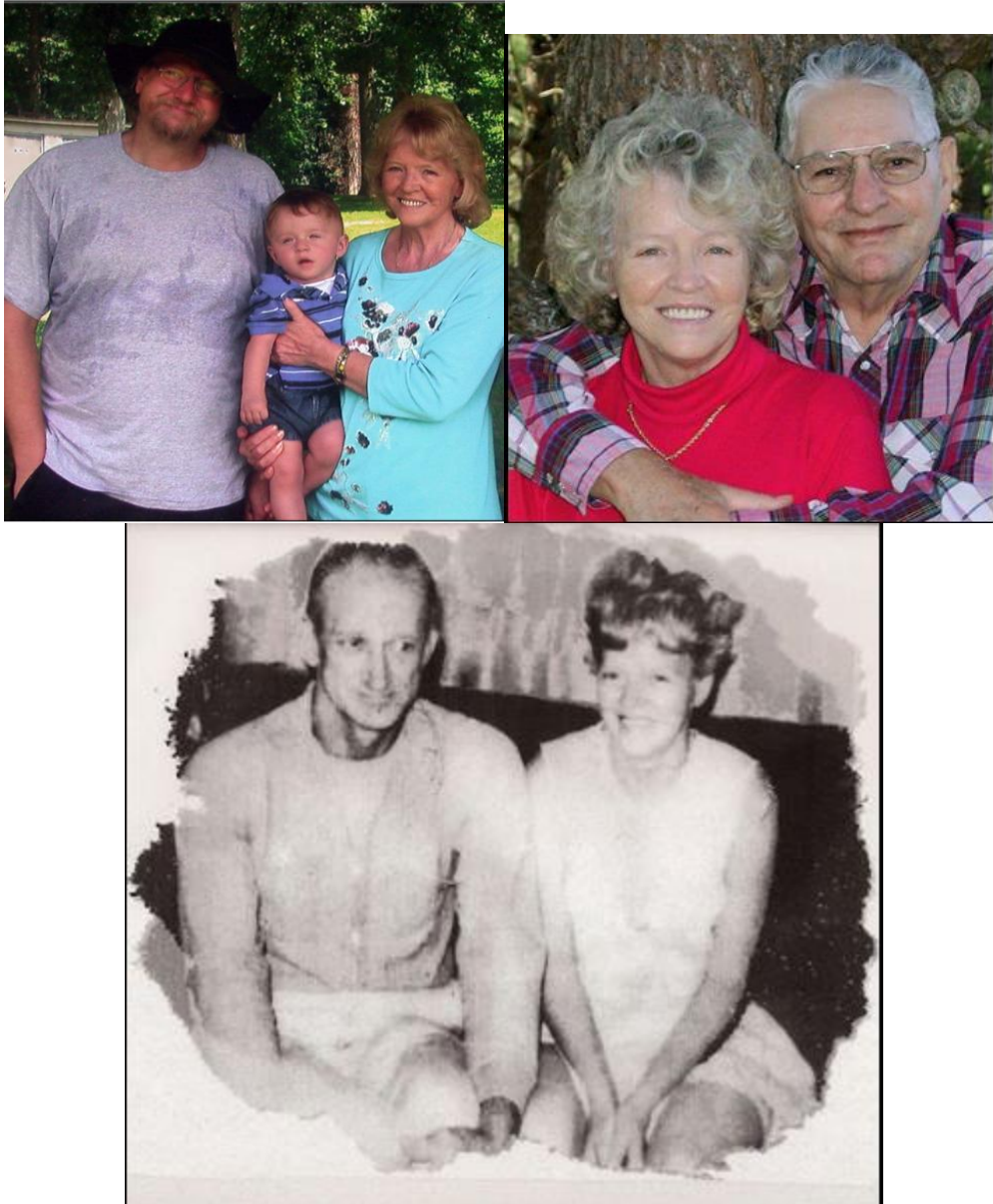

Explosion In Seth Destroys Garage

WHITESVILLE (RNS) — A cinder-block garage at Seth owned by the Jarrells Estate and operated by Kelly Hager of Seth was destroyed by fire at 11:05 a.m. Monday, according to the Whitesville Fire Department.

A spokesman for the fire department said Hager was working on a gas tank inside the garage that had been removed from a car and the tank exploded. The spokesman said the building contained several oxygen tanks and welding equipment.

The spokesman said the explosion threw debris on State Route 3, blocking traffic for about an hour.

Hager received second degree burns to both hands and face while trying to remove a car that was left inside the garage, the spokesman said. He said Hager was taken to the Raleigh-Boone Medical Center in Whitesville where he was treated and released.

Damage was estimated at \$6,000.

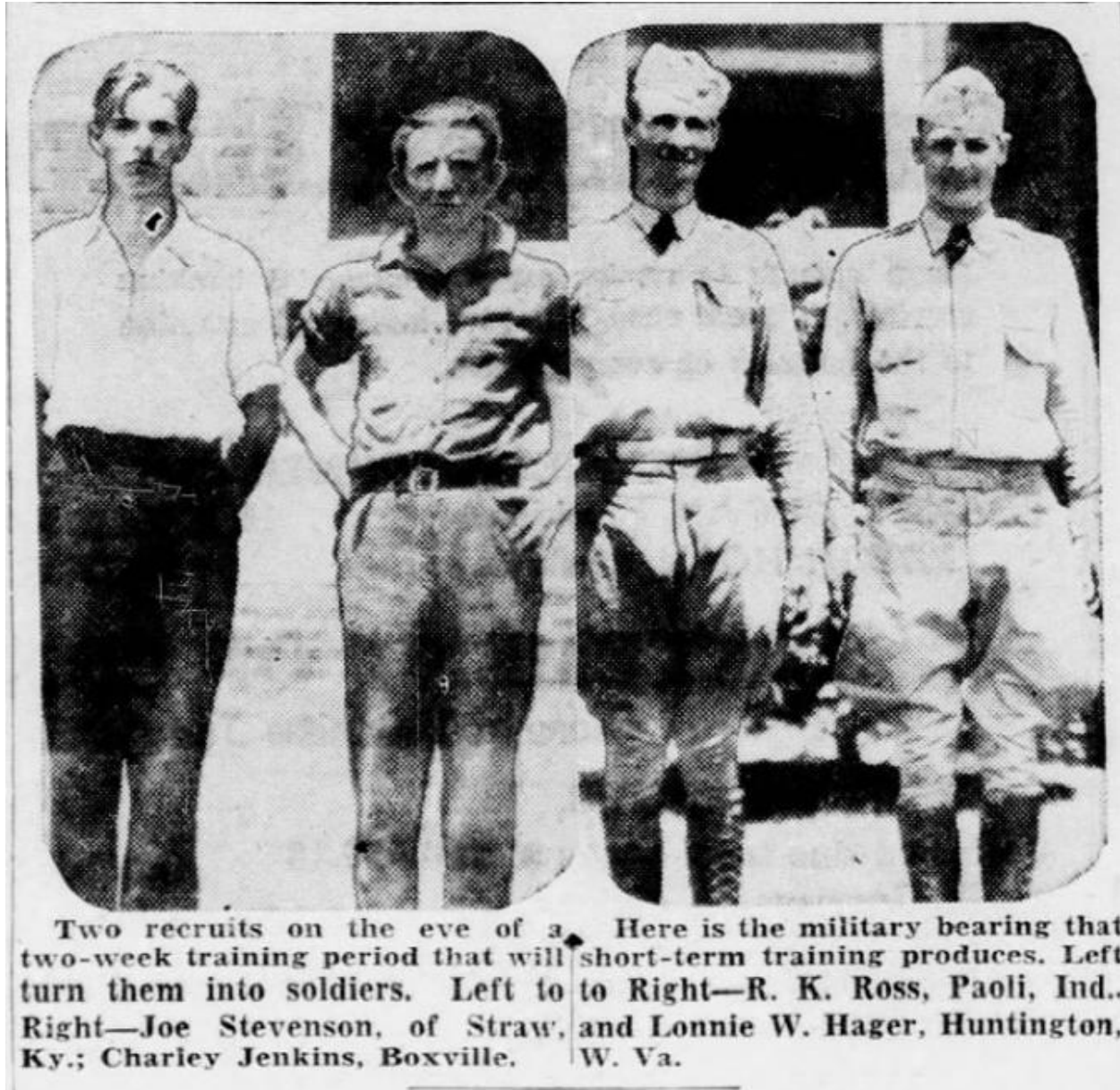

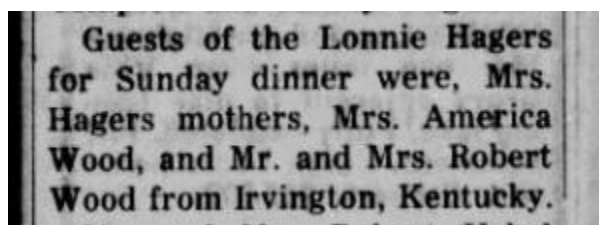

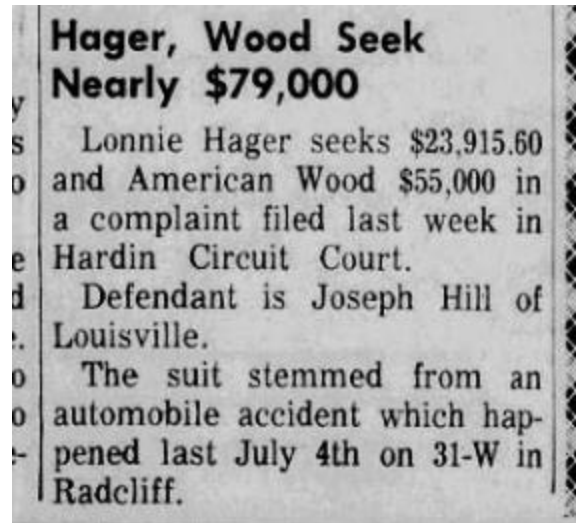

WV. Henry was the son of Perry H. Sheets & Julia Hill. He is buried in Hill Cemetery, Alkol, Lincoln WV. - Wife of Loyal Wendell Hayes (1919-1988, F: 111670874), whom she married in 1952. - Mrs. Alberta Hayes was a resident of Summersville WV in 1973 when her half-sister Eavie Thompson Hager died.- Buried in Pineview Cemetery, Orgas, Boone WV. F: 111670849
- **Louise Maxine Hager Ferrell**, 31 Mar 1925 Lincoln Co. WV – 21 Sep 2021 WV Orgas, Boone WV. - On 17 Sep 1946 in Boone Co. WV, - Louise Hager, age 21, married Harold Norman Ferrell, age 25. Harold was the son of Okey S. Ferrell & Amanda (Mandy) F. Foster. - Had surname of Ferrell when her half-sister Mary Francis d. Sep 2010; was living in Orgas WV. – Mrs. Louise Ferrell was a resident of Orgas WV in 1973 when her half-sister Eavie Thompson Hager died.- She was listed as Louise Ferrell when her sister Geneva Kinley died in Oct 2011. - Harold Norman Ferrell (1921-1987) is buried in Pineview Cemetery, Orgas, Boone WV, F: 111670998. – Buried in Pineview Cemetery with Harold, Orgas, Boone WV. F: 232336617.
- **James Edward Hager**, 19 Feb 1929 Jefferson district, Lincoln Co. WV – 27 Jul 1999 Comfort, Boone WV. - Husband of Joy Sue Perdue (1933-1984, F: 112033444), whom he married 21 Jun 1950 in Boone Co. WV. Joy Perdue was the daughter of Nathaniel Zack Perdue & Delta M. Hale & therefore the sister of Shirley Temple Perdue, who marries James Hager's younger brother, Kelly Hager. – Resident of Seth WV in 1973 when his half-sister Eavie Thompson Hager died. - Buried in Pineview Cemetery, Orgas, Boone WV. F: 103758481
- **Geneva Pearl Hager Halstead Kinley**, 16 Jul 1931 Lincoln Co. WV – 6 Oct 2011 Ripley, Jackson WV. - Married on 20 Mar 1948 in Madison, Boone WV to John Howard ("Johnnie") Halstead (1921-1992, F: 67049508). Clarence's father Allen Hager was the brother of William M. Hager, the father of Burwell Hager. WV to **Rhoda (Sissy) Sperry** [Speary] (1920-2011, F: 64335827) (aka **Redie Speary**, age 23, daughter of Theodore Speary & Valara/Vlaria Dolan. – Charles's daughter by Rosetta was Lillie Rose Hager Stevens (6 Feb 1907 Spurlockville, Lincoln WV – 17 Feb 1991 Ironton, Lawrence OH, F:26496354). – He is buried as Charley Hager in Lagrange Cemetery, Ironton, Lawrence OH. F: 27681731

- **Anthony Harrison Hager**, 24 Nov 1889 Spurlockville, Lincoln WV – Sep 1982 Logan, Logan WV. – His WV birth record lists him as Henry Harrison Hager. – Married in Jan 1910 in Lincoln Co. VA to **Lottie Edna Hager** (1895-1975, F: 102882146), the daughter of Rilen Silas Hager & Telitha (Letha) A. Estep. Lottie's brother Jessie James Hager married Anthony's brother Burwell Hager's stepdaughter, Mary Francis Thompson & Lottie's brother Albert Hager married Anthony's brother Burwell Hager's stepdaughter, Eavie May Thompson. So, Lottie's 2 brothers married the Thompson sisters. – Anthony & Lottie married ca. 1910. Lottie Hager Hager married Tolbert Adkins (1879-1959) in 1913; she is buried as Lottie Adkins in Drawdy Cemetery, Peytona, Boone WV, F: 102882146). – In the 1930 & 1940 censuses, Anthony resides with wife **Cora Dolan** (1902-1948). In the 1930 census, Anthony is age 40 & Cora age 27, residing in Logan, Logan WV. In 1940 the couple lives with her father. She died as Ora Hager. Her mother was Elvera/Elvira Lovejoy (1857-1933, F: 1803569288); her father had several versions of his first name – Zedoch, Zedic, Zedock, Zed – and varied his name Dolan, Dolen, Dolin, Dolon, as well as Olstead, Alstead, Halstead. - **Perry Green Hager**, 24 Nov 1892 Spurlockville, Lincoln WV – 5 Apr 1970 Palermo, Lincoln WV. Died in a Huntington WV hospital. – WWI veteran. – Married in 1923 to **Ellen Purdue** (1908-1994, F: 254773953) who is buried with the surname Toney. - Husband of **Clesby Lovejoy** (1905-1988, F: 43346626). Clesby was the daughter of Elliott Lovejoy (F: 36030452) & Synthia Jane Adkins (F: 36033098). Clesby was also married to Bernie Whitten (1894-1966). - WWI veteran. Retired farmer. Survived by widow Clesby, 4 daughters, 2 sons, 3 brothers: Lonnie, Anthony & Charley, all of Griffithsville WV & sister Mrs. Ella Parker of Miami FL. – Buried in Lovejoy Cemetery, Palermo, Lincoln WV. F: 43346755
- **Kathleen Ella M. Hager Cooper Olley Parker**, 3 Apr 1897 Lincoln Co. WV – 23 Aug 1984 McCook, Red Willow NE. – Usually known as “Ella.” - Married 2 or 3 Sep 1914 in Boone Co. WV to **Roman Lee Cooper** (1896 WV – 1963 OH, F: 146092451). They had 5 children, between 1915 & 1923. In 1926 Romie as he was known, or Roma, married Etha Mary Buzzard. – Married on 30 Nov 1918 to **John Olley** in Hamilton Co. OH. On their marriage record, John Olley said he had turned 30 years old on 18 Feb 1918, born in Persia to T. & Anna Olley, a resident of Detroit MI, laborer, not previously married. Ella Hager said she was age 22 on 28 Jul 1918 [this birthdate does not compute] but was the daughter of William Hager & Louisa Spurlock, b. WV, seamstress. – A John Olle (b. 15 Aug 1886 Hungary) & a John Olla (b. 16 Jun 1887 Hungary) registered for the WWI draft as residents of Detroit, Wayne MI but the birthdates don't match. - Married Dr. **Wellington Henry Parker** (1875-1969 FL), a general practitioner, in 1927 in Logan Co. WV; he is listed as W.H. Parker & she as Kathaleen Cooper. – In the 1930 census for Triadelphia, Logan WV, conducted 12 Apr 1930, Wellington H. Parker (54 WV, was a doctor in general practice. In the household were his wife Catheline E. (34 WV) & five Cooper stepchildren, ages 6 to 14 years. – In the 1950 census, Wellington Parker (age 75) & wife Ella (age 54) live in Daytona Beach, Volusia FL. - Was Mrs. Ella Parker of Miami FL in Apr 1970 when her brother Perry died.
- **Wattie E. Hager**, Aug 1899 Lincoln Co. WV – died before the 1910 census.
- **Kelley Hager**, 1903 Lincoln Co. WV – 10 Jul 1931 Huntington Cabell Co. WV. - Married **Lola Varney** (1901-1967, F: 48128422) on 2 May 1928 in Cabell Co. WV. Kelley Hager, son of William Hager, was age 24, b. Lincoln Co. WV. Miss Lola Varney, age 23, daughter of John

Varney, was born in Wayne Co. WV. – Their son Leroy Hager was born 2 months later, on 17 Jul 1928 in Logan Co. WV. Leroy died 1 Jun 2010 in Sebastian Co. AR, F: 53182845. – Previously, Lola Varney had married 3 Nov 1919 to John Harley Muncey-Spaulding. Following Kelley's death, Lola married Homer Evans in 1934 & then Flemon S. Messer. She died as Lola Messer. – In the 1930 census for Jefferson, Lincoln Co. WV, conducted 28 Apr 1930, Kelley Hager (26 WV, parents b. WV, farmer, general farm) lived with wife Lola (26 WV) & son Leroy (2 WV). The two previous census entries were for his parents & his married brother Perry's family. – Kelley's WV death certificate reports the cause of death on 10 Jul 1931 as due to "gun shot wound of spine resulting in paralysis and finally [next word indecipherable]. The wounding occurred 7 days earlier, on 3 Jul 1931. The space for the question "accident/suicide/homicide" is left blank. He died at age 28, "don't know" date of birth, and was buried in Spurlockville, Lincoln WV on 12 Jul 1931 but is not on Find A Grave as of 13 May 2026.

- **Lorenzo ("Lonnie") Walton Hager**, 14 Jan 1907 [or 1908] Lincoln Co. WV – 29 Sep 1990 Radcliff, Hardin KY. – Middle name also found as Walter – Apparently married to a woman who died, according to one of his marriage licenses. – Lonnie married **Alberta Georgia Lusk** (1917-2009) perhaps ca. 1936; the daughter of Olen Alfred Lusk (1884-1965, F: 170592904) & Hattie I. Hawkins (1885-1953, F: 1975339640). A shower (kind unspecified) is hosted for Mrs. Alberta Lusk Hager in Brandenburg KY in Nov 1936. – In Nov 1942, Alberta Hager petitioned for a divorce. Alberta then married Lonnie Glenn Matthews (1918-1981, F: 252214992) on 7 Dec 1948. She is buried as Albert Matthews in the same cemetery as Lonnie Hager, at F: 252214851. – Registered on 30 Dec 1944 for the WWII draft as Lonnie WALTER Hager, born 14 Jan 1907 Spurlockville [sic] WV, unemployed, mailing address: General Delivery, Fort Knox, Hardin KY with a "scar on nose." – On his 1 Oct 1945 marriage license & ceremony application, Lonnie W. Hager, age 38, formerly married twice (1 marriage ending in death, 1 in divorce between 1928 & 1940), soldier, his father William Hager living in Spurlockville WV, his mother Louisa deceased) – in Clark Co. IN – with **Mary Ellen Wood/Woods**, age 23, formerly married once, b. 13 Mar 1922 Irvington KY, daughter of Jess Wood & America Horsley. Mary Ellen Woods (1922-2005) has F: 201535751. – Lonnie was arrested in Jan 1947 in KY after "assaulting with intent to kill" his wife "Ellen Hager" by beating her with a gun & causing lacerations, stitches & hospitalization. The case went to court in Jun 1947; the outcome was not located. – Buried in North Hardin Memorial Gardens, Radcliff, Hardin KY. F: 198459146

Notes:

Research on the Hager family is complicated by the fact that many Hagers married other people named Hager, and similar surnames of spouses (Estep, Lovejoy, etc.) appear in family trees. It is also complicated by the lack of West Virginia newspaper coverage on Newspapers.com as of 2026.
