Dies While Working At Football Field

A note of distinct sadness developed today in the Odessa Amarillo football circles when Roger Lee Hamilton, carpenter on 2nd E. 4th St., died of heart attack while working at the football field.

Mr. Hamilton, 58, was an overseas veteran in World War I, having a ship sunk while crossing the Atlantic and landing in Ireland on a raft.

Surviving are six brothers, Willie and Jess of Odessa; Cleve, Whitehouse, Tex.; Arch of Anderson, John of Stinton and Judge, address unknown; two sisters, Mrs. J. T. Foard of Rosebud and Mrs. G. M. Hammond of Iola.

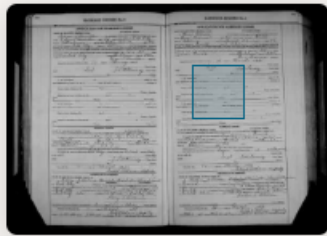

The Rev. H. S. DeVore preached the funeral sermon and spoke very highly of the life of Mr. Strawn. His father was a Methodist preacher and he was converted when a young man. Interment was at the Ural cemetery.

John Wesley Strawn was born in the State of Georgia, October 3, 1858, and died at Ural November 27, 1922. He was the son of Rev. J. W. and Mary Ann Strawn.

He was married to Mrs. Mary Choate, December 9, 1896 and to this union were born four children, two of whom now survive him, Robert and Wesley Strawn. His widow and one brother W. J. Strawn, also survive him. He is also survived by four step-children, Olin Choate, Mrs. Ed Hamilton, Albert Choate and Mrs. Annie Rogers.

Mr. Strawn has resided in Oklahoma for twenty-nine years.

Archibald Hamilton, age 81 years, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. J. T. Ford, on Thursday morning shortly after eight o'clock.

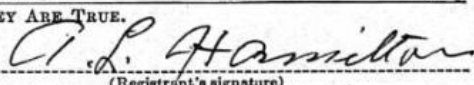

Born 14 Jan 1891 TX. - Husband of Valera Agatha Townsend (1902-1994, F: 121197596). - Buried in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Odessa, Ector TX. F: 121197537

TX – 9 Dec 1961 Pampa, Gray TX. - Husband of Gracie King Teague (1893-1972, F: 104366422). - His obituary ("Pampa Daily News" 11 Dec 1961 p 3) refers to his surviving wife Grace, 2 daughters, 1 son, a surviving half-brother Arch Hamilton of Anderson TX, Jess Hamilton of Odessa TX (relationship unclear unless half-brother is implied), a stepbrother J.L. Hamilton of Sinton TX. - Buried in Riverside Cemetery, Mangum, Greer OK. F: 104366581
- **James Hamilton**, Mar 1880 TX -
- **Grace Louella ("Gracie") Hamilton Ford**, 2 Mar 1882 TX – 26 Jul 1953 Rosebud, Falls TX. - Married on 9 Jan 1901 in Grimes Co. TX to James Thomas ("Tom") (J.T.) Ford (1881 TN – 1952 TX, F: 101374483). - They are buried in Woodland Cemetery, Rosebud Falls TX. F: 101374505

Mystery siblings/half-siblings:

- **Judge Hamilton** – listed as "address unknown" in Edgar's Oct 1945 obituary. In 1910 a Judge Hamilton, age 16, is living by himself as head of household in Falls, Rosebud TX, a farm laborer, working out. This would compute to a birthdate ca. 1894 in TX. It is not clear if this is the correct "Judge Hamilton" as there are many men with this name in Texas.
- **W.T. Hamilton** – resident of Elk City, Beckham OK in Jul 1929 when his father Archibald died.
- **J.T. Hamilton** – resident of Runge, Karnes TX in Jul 1929 when his father Archibald died. Is this James? Jesse? Judge?

Notes:

Social Security record lists father as Archibal Hamilton & mother as Obediance [sic] Thornton.

Erroneously linked on Ancestry.com to the 1910 census for Ballinger, Runnels TX, listing Edgar Hamilton (22 TX, parents b. TX, cook) with wife Maud (19 TX, parents b. TX). Their race is listed as "mulatto."

But in the 1920 census for San Angelo, Tom Green Co. TX, the man's full name is listed as James Edgar Hamilton (age 30 TX) & wife Maud (28 TX). Maude (1891-1960, F: 63758931) was the daughter of Albert Allen & Ottilla Johnson. This is a listing for James Edgar Hamilton (1887-1962, F: 63758925) and wife Maud Allen Hamilton, who are both buried in the "lot Negro" in Fairmount Cemetery, San Angelo, Tom Green TX.

"Southwestern Elk City (OK) Press" Friday, 13 Jun 1922 p 8 – a number of young people from Ural surprised Mrs. Albert Choate last Friday [6 Jun 1922] at 7:30 p.m. Games were played. Among those from Ural were Bettie Choate & Ed Hamilton.
