Just 10 hours after receiving the official draft list from Washington, D. C., Sheriff S. E. Roberts and Deputy County Clerk Miss Eleanor Whitmore completed the entire Deschutes county list, a list of the 74 called on the first draft, and sent out notices to all the men on the first call last night. The work took several days, as a matter of fact, the lists being compiled from an authentic copy of the master list, which was furnished to the members of the county draft board by The Bulletin, early in the week.

Since the sending of draft notices, claims for exemption may be made at any time now, up to the beginning of examination for the conscripts, which will be conducted by the draft board on August 7, 8, and 9, in Bend. Following the examinations, the work of the exemption board will commence.

Deschutes county's complete list is as follows, the first number corresponding with the number stamped on the registration cards, while the number to the right indicates the order of liability to service:

BEND SENDS 16 NEW RECRUITS

Sixteen men, all of draft age, left Bend last night to enlist in various branches of army service, the majority of them going into the Twentieth Regiment of Forestry Engineers. They will report at headquarters in Portland and probably be sent east immediately to prepare to leave for France.

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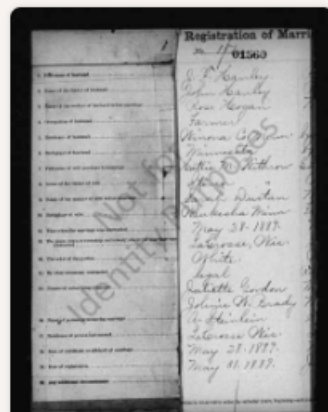

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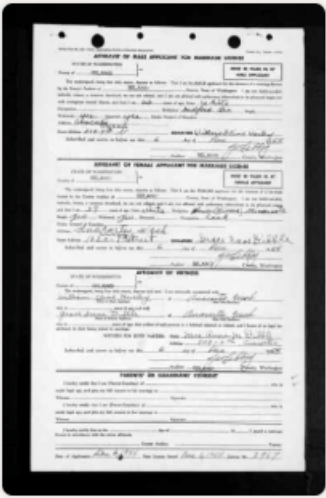

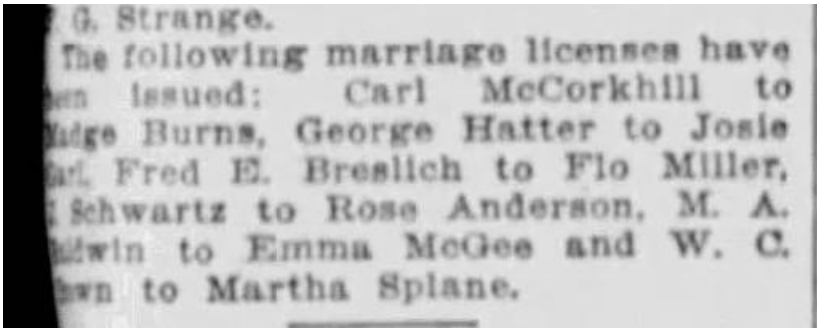
