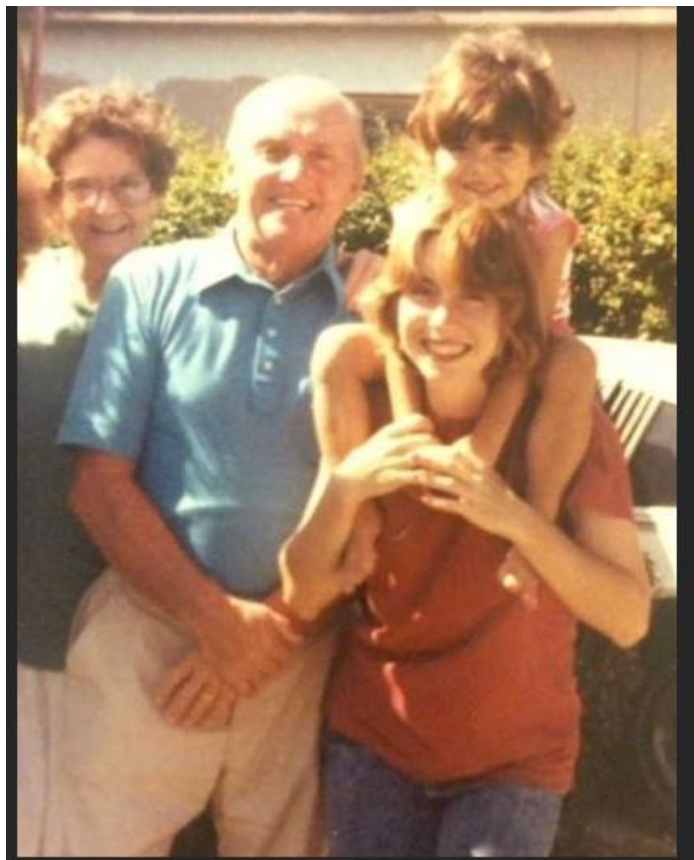

Friends of Clifford Hanley, a one time Pismo school boy, will be pleased to hear that he is living in Chicago, and is married. Hanley was one of the youngest members of the A. E. F., having enlisted when scarcely fifteen years old. He was on the Tuscania—torpedoed off the Irish coast, and he spent four hours in the cold water of the North Atlantic.

WIDEN HUNT FOR SLAYER OF GIRL

**Post Six Thousand Dollars
as Reward; Two Women

CHICAGO, Jan. 25.—(UP)—A reward of \$6,000 was posted Friday for the capture of the slayer of Laura Bucholz, 26-year-old office employe, who was clubbed to death within a block of her home in Blue Island Tuesday night.

The Blue Island city council pledged \$3,000, Mayor Paul T. Klenck of Blue Island, \$2,000, and Milton F. Goodman, millionaire head of the Reliance Manufacturing Company, where Miss Bucholz was employed, \$1,000.

SLAYER SEEN

Police, after obtaining an accurate description, announced that the slayer was a hobo who was seen after the murder, by a watchman at a railroad shanty near the Rock Island lines in Blue Island.

George Mortos, Railroad worker, said the hobo walked into the shanty with bloody hands and inquired when and where he could catch a westbound train. Mortos said he offered the man a job, which was refused, because "I want to get to California."

Police believed the clubber had escaped on a westbound train, despite the search of several hundred employes of the Rock Island lines along the freight routes.

WOMEN SAW MURDER

The railroad worker's description generally tallied with that given by Mrs. Ferdinand Rettke and Mrs. Rose Hanley, who witnessed the murder.

Miss Bucholz was returning home after working late. She was within a block of her home when she was seized, clubbed with a heavy timber, and then left dying in a clump of bushes.

Mrs. Rettke and Mrs. Hanley told police they heard the girl's screams and reached the windows of their homes in time to see her being dragged across the sidewalk into a clump of bushes. Miss Bucholz died a short time after the attack, without regaining consciousness.

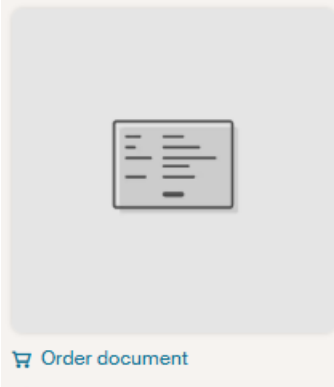

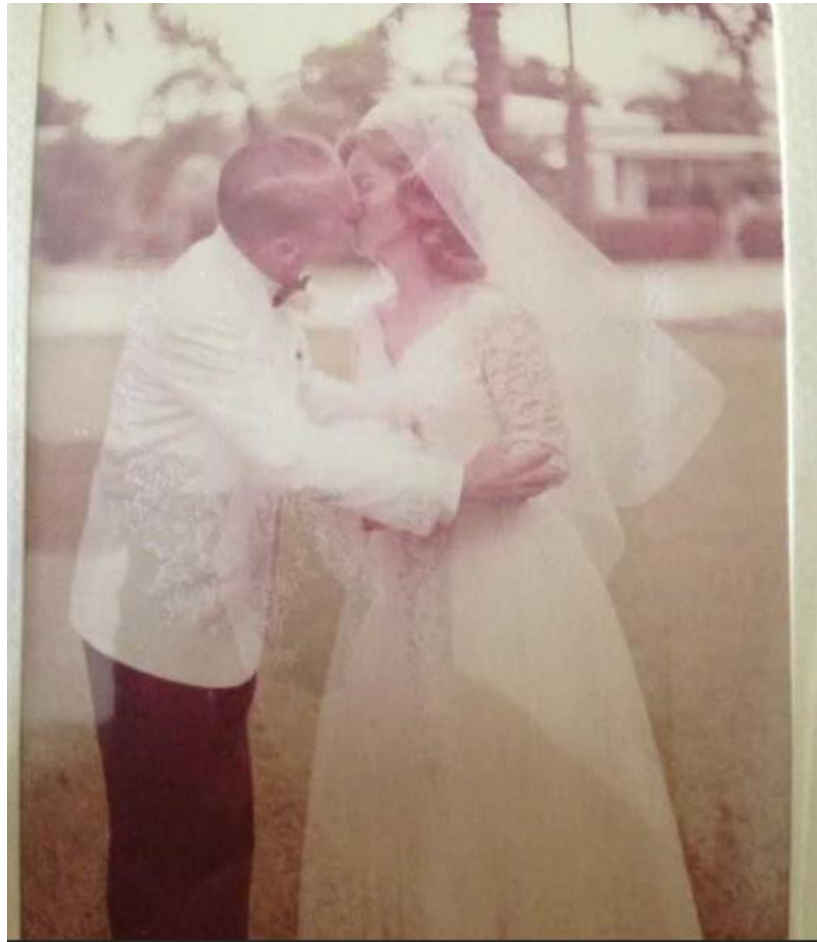

Seems as if we said a sad farewell to a lot of familiar faces last year along Talbot Street – ‘tho Earl Taylor, chair of the Downtown Development Board notes we also said a happy hello to 22 new businesses.

And, now, a retirement sale at Maxwell’s Foto Source, a downtown mainstay for 49 years.

Pat Maxwell says times have changed for the business.

Can’t argue much with that. Every selfie-snapper with a camphone is proof that the times indeed have changed . . . and maybe not always for the better!

Frank and Nancy Prothero share an appreciation of Maxwell’s, of Cliff and Pat, and staff:

“Have you heard the one about the Newfie?”

That was Cliff Maxwells’ invariable cheery greeting, prelude to a knee-slapping joke that he laughed at as hard as the listener. If good cheer were dollars, Cliff would have been a billionaire . . . and maybe he was.

Maxwell’s Camera Shop is one of the oldest retail outlets on Talbot Street. I remember it best when Nancy and I were struggling to publish a monthly magazine, a local newspaper and several books.

In the 1970s, Maxwell’s was one of the busiest retail outlets on Talbot Street. It was a community meeting place and the very best source for cameras, film, accessories and advice. Cliff even allowed us to use his darkroom before we acquired our own equipment.

On a typical Saturday, it was so busy in the store that we wrote our own receipts and left them with a cheque.

Through all those years, those wonderful staff members, Mike, Sandy and Cliff's wife, Pat, have made this the No. 1 camera shop in Ontario. We know that they deserve, not only a rest from their labours but the thanks of a whole community for the services they have rendered for so many years. We wish them well. The Lord knows we wish them well.

. . . Recently we purchased a complete 35mm film camera outfit with a variety of lenses and accessories, barely used over the past 50 years. We will shoot a good deal of black and white and we will develop the film and make the prints with equipment that we bought at Maxwell's nearly 50 years ago.

And we know that when we dip those photo paper sheets in the developer and watch those images appear like magic that Cliff will be looking over our shoulder.

"The old order changeth . . . lest one good custom should corrupt the world."

Fine and inevitable . . . but when the old order does changeth, let us fully acknowledge that which has been . . .

So, here is a toast . . . to the late Cliff Maxwell, as good a man as we ever knew, to Herman of days gone by, to Mike and Sandy and Pat for all those good years.

Thank you.

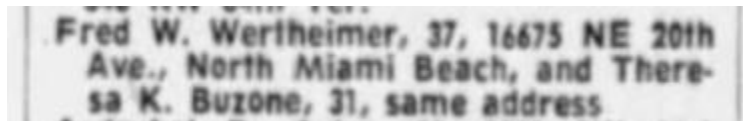

Port Huron, Mich., July 24.—Arthur Maxwell, 22, and Harold Maxwell, 17, brothers, of Detroit were drowned in St. Clair river Sunday afternoon at the foot of Thomas street. Clifford Maxwell, 18, a third brother, nearly lost his life in an effort to rescue Arthur and Harold.

BRAND WILL CASE DECIDED BY COURT

JUDGE PAVY HANDS DOWN DECISION IN NOTED LITIGATION OVER ESTATE

Judge Pavy, in district court, handed down a decision in the famous contest over the will of Mrs. Conrad Brand. The judgment of the court is a victory for both sides, but will go to the supreme court on appeal, neither litigant being satisfied with the judgment.

Mrs. Thomas H. Maxwell, born Marguerite Drummond, was adopted in infancy by Mr. and Mrs. C. Brand, the couple being childless. Mr. Brand had made a will previous to the adoption, but under Louisiana law the will became null on the birth of an heir. In this case the legal adoption of a child was tantamount to the birth of an heir, hence the will was set aside. This principle of the law was upheld by the court, and under its judgment Mrs. Maxwell became half owner in the estate, inheriting Mr. Brand's share of the community.

Mrs. Brand died some eighteen months ago leaving a last will and testament in which she bequeathed the entire estate to various heirs, including the adopted daughter. The adopted daughter attacked the legality of the will on the grounds that Mrs. Brand was of unsound mind and therefore incapable of making a will. The court ruled that the will was legal but reduced the amount she could will to two-thirds of her half of the community and this ruling gave the adopted daughter one-third of that half. The testamentary legatees were given a judgment against the community estate for some \$1700 which amount was due the personal estate of Mrs. Brand for separate funds.

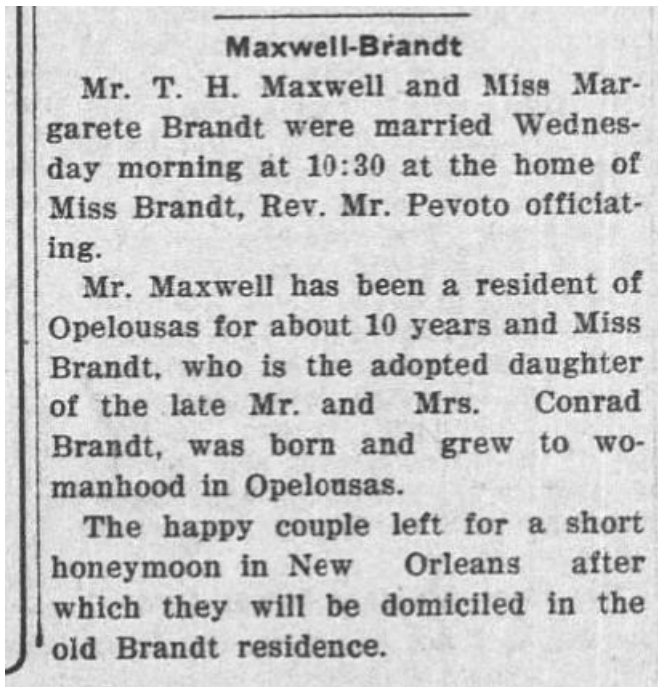

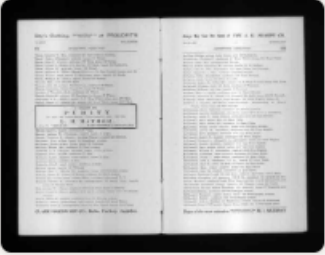

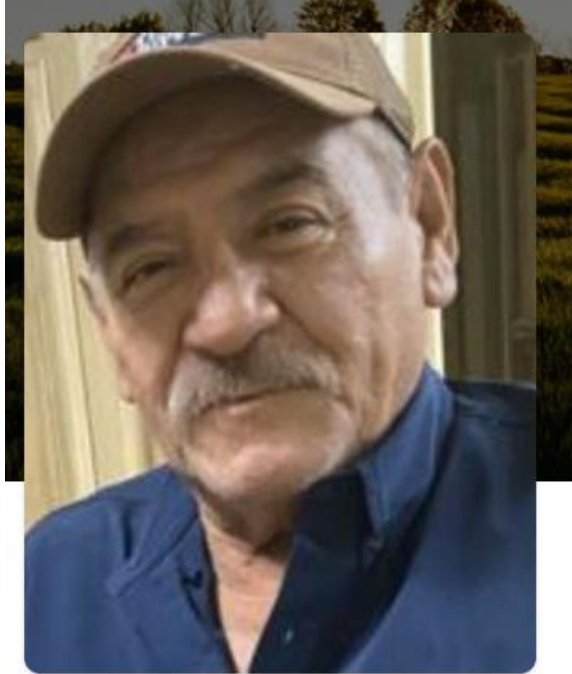

Thomas is listed as Clifford's father on his 1920 marriage license with Florence Drum. Thomas's occupation is photographer & he was born in the US. Thomas & wife Florence E. Wilcox are listed as residents of Opelousas, St. Landry Parish LA.

They divorced & Thomas married Margarite (Margaret) Ann Brand.

Thomas & Margaret had 4 sons. They are misnamed in Thomas's obituaries as "Conrad, James, Roy and Alfred." Instead they are Conrad, James Roy, Alfred and Charles.

Thomas's obituaries state he has 4 surviving sons (with Margaret) & a son Clifford from an earlier marriage.

Buried in Myrtle Grove Cemetery, Opelousas, St. Landry Parish LA.

Mother: Florence E. Wilcox Maxwell, May 1880 (based on 1900 census) or ca. 1896 (based on 1930 census) Endicott, Broome NY – alive in 1930 census

On son Clifford's marriage license with Florence Drum on 17 Jul 1920, Clifford reports his mother was born in NJ but in the 1930 census, she is reported as born in NY. She was reported on the marriage license as a resident of Opelousas, St. Landry Parish LA along with her husband, Thomas H. Maxwell.

Note that Clifford's father Thomas had already remarried, on 4 Feb 1920. Thomas may have been a resident of Opelousas LA, but it was unlikely that ex-wife Florence was.

According to the newspaper accounts when C.F. Salin was named the guardian of Clifford Vernon Hanley on 20 Sep 1917 in San Luis Obispo Co. CA, Salin said Clifford's mother, a "theatrical performer," had dropped her son off at Salin's 3 years earlier to take care of.

Father's 2nd wife: Margarite Francis/Frances [nee Drummond] [adopted name:] Brand Maxwell, 20 Dec 1893 Opelousas, St. Landry Parish LA – 3 Oct 1967.

Her 1st name is also found as Margaret and Marguerite.

According to the district court action in April 1921, when Marguerite (Mrs. Thomas H. Maxwell) contested the will of Mrs. Conrad Brand, she had been born Marguerite Drummond & was adopted as an infant by a childless couple, Mr. & Mrs. Conrad Brand.

Daughter of Conrad William Brand & Margaret Drummond (according to her TX death record).

According to Ancestry.com genealogies, she was the biological daughter of John Anderson Drummond & Alice Elizabeth Morris. Online genealogies also claim she is the daughter of Conrad & Olympia V. Brand.

The contesting of the will: Mr. Conrad Brand had made a will prior to adopting Marguerite which was made null & void under Louisiana law after the birth of an heir. A legal adoption is tantamount to the birth of an heir, so upon Conrad's death, this left Marguerite as half-owner of his estate.

Mrs. Brand, who had died about 18 months prior to the contesting of the will, had made her will, which left her estate to various heirs, including her adopted daughter. Marguerite countered that Mrs. Brand had been of unsound mind.

The court ruled Mrs. Brand's will was legal but reduced Mrs. Brand's inherited amount to 2/3 of her half. Thus adopted daughter Marguerite got 1/3 of that half.

In the 1950 census for Laredo, Webb TX, conducted 17 Apr 1950, Margaret was the head of household, which included her two married sons & one unmarried son.

Margaret Maxwell, 60 LA, widow [head of household]

Francis, 21 LA, single, furniture assembler, furniture factory [son]

Conrad, 28 LA, married, occupation left blank [son]

Angelina, 27 TX, married, piece-goods saleslady [daughter-in-law, i.e. Conrad's wife]

James R., 24 LA, married, enumerator, US Census Bureau [son]

Mary A., 19 TX, married [daughter-in-law, i.e. James's wife]

Daughter of John Richardson (b. Ontario, Canada) & Belle Gillis (b. ND) according to her MI death certificate, which notes her death from "Lysol poisoning – cause unknown."

Was it actually Clifford Vernon Maxwell, using the name Clifford V. Hanley, who married Rose Richardson on 16 Nov 1927 in Highland Park, Wayne MI?

Several items on the marriage license fit.

Clifford V. Hanley, age 26, b. NY is a photographer.

He lists his parents, however, as Lawrence Hanley & Florence Hitchcock (but Florence is the name of his mother). He was a resident of Detroit MI & claimed it was his 1st marriage.

Rose Richardson, age 20, b. Idaho, who occupation was "photographing," left her parents' names blank. She was also a resident of Detroit MI & said it was her 1st marriage.

Mrs. Rose Hanley witnessed a woman clubbed to death on 22 Jan 1929 in Blue Island IL. Rose died a few weeks later. The story was widely reported in IL & MI newspapers.

Spouse: Florence Evalena Drum [Drumm] Chapman Maxwell Johnson Osborn, Dec 1897

Susquehanna PA – 11 Aug 1976.

Daughter of James F. Drum/Drumm (1874-1958, F: 83424868) & Frances Evaline (Fannie) Ford (1878-1943, F: 83404905).

Florence Drum had married Neal William Chapman on 27 Dec 1915 in Boone Co. NY. Neal was born 15 Nov 1894 Hillsgrove, Sullivan PA & died 20 Aug 1972. Neal is buried in Vestal Hills Memorial Park, Vestal, Broome NY. F: 95791380

When she married Clifford Maxwell in 1920, both her parents lived in Susquehanna PA, where her father was a shoemaker.

Florence Drumm married 12 Apr 1936 in Sayre, Bradford PA to Lynn Johnson. On their marriage license, Lynn Johnson, age 34, laborer, b. Binghamton NY, no previous marriage, listed his father as Oscar Johnson (dead) & mother as Rose Purvis (resident of Scranton PA). Florence Drumm, age 32, beautician, b. Endicott NY, no previous marriage [although she had been married twice], was the daughter of James Drumm (miner) & Fannie Ford, both residents of Scranton PA.

Lynn Johnson was born 1901 & died 13 May 1944 in Binghamton, Broome NY. He is buried in Marathon Cemetery, Marathon, Cortland NY, F: 114145387.

She died with the surname Osborn, having married Sheldon Grover Osborn Sr. (1899-1971). A Florence E. Drum married in East Moriche NY on 4 May 1940; her spouse's name is not on the record.

Buried as Florence Osborn in Riverside Cemetery, Endicott, Broome NY.

Marriage: Clifford Vernon Maxwell, claiming to be age 23, b. Jamestown NY, resident of Binghamton NY, married Florence Evalena Drum on 17 Jul 1920 in Montrose, Susquehanna PA. She was also age 23, b. NY, daughter of James & Fannie (Ford) Drum, he son of Thomas H. & Florence (Wilcox) Maxwell. Clifford would have been age 18.

Spouse: Bridget Emily/Emmeline/Emeline Neville Maxwell, 16 Jan 1904 Bridgeport, Nova Scotia, Canada - 13 Jul 1991 Dade Co. FL.

Daughter of John Patrick Neville & Margaret Ann (Maggie) Young.

Her name appears as Patricia in the 1930 census & as Beatrice on several records (such as her son John Clifford Maxwell's Social Security record where she is Beatrice P. Maxwell. She is also listed as Bridgetta & Birdgetta in records.

US border crossing data showed her entering the US from Canada at Calais, Maine, on 26 Jun 1953 with the purpose of residing there permanently.

- **Charles Francis Maxwell**, 20 Sep 1927 Opelousas, St. Landry Parish LA – 21 Dec 1998 Nueces Co. TX. – Husband of Zita Margarita Garcia. – Charles named one of his sons after his father: Thomas Henry Maxwell. – Zita Margarita Garcia was born 27 Apr 1935 in Tepeaca, Puebla, Mexico, according to her 28 May 1985 naturalization papers filing & died as Zita Beeson on 16 Jul 2025 in Laredo, Webb TX. She had a son named Federico Gutierrez (ca. 1954 – 18 Nov 2023 Laredo, Webb TX) named as Charles's stepson in his obituary but who had predeceased his mother. Zita had remarried, to Richard Beeson, who predeceased her. Her obituary notes she is buried in Calvary Catholic Cemetery.

Notes:

Clifford was born with the surname Maxwell in 1902. He would have only 15 when he entered the Army in 1917, so this likely accounts for his birth year being reported as 1901 as he's trying to pretend he is older. One can guess that he used the surname Hanley on the "Tuscania" to avoid any revelation of his real age.

Clifford had a paternal uncle – the brother of his father Thomas Henry Maxwell – named Clifford Roy Maxwell, presumably Clifford's namesake.

"Guardian Fred Salin" – his WWI next-of-kin contact – found in San Francisco CA city directories, such as in 1916, as Fred Salin, Progressive Party, merchant, 325 Sutter.

C.F. Salin was appointed guardian of minor Clifford Vernon Hanley on 20 Apr 1917 in San Luis Obispo Co. CA. The newspaper account said Salin was made Clifford's guardian so Clifford could enlist in the aviation section of the US Army.

He appears to be Carl Frederick Salin/Saline, also known as Frederick C. Saline, 1869 – 30 Jun 1936 CA, buried in Santa Barbara Cemetery, Santa Barbara, Santa Barbara CA. F; 90544470
