Forest Is Dedicated To Veterans

MADISON, Wis. (Special) — Capt. Jack Ellet Hurff, wartime commander of the U. S. S. New Orleans and now professor of naval science at the University of Wisconsin, will be among the speakers at the dedication of the Uhrenholdt Memorial forest, which will take place Aug. 15 at 2:15 p. m. on the Uhrenholdt farm near Seeley, Wis.

Hurff will speak on "A Home Memorial to Fallen Heroes." Another speaker from the University, Walter A. Rowlands, supervisor of county agents and director of the experiment station, will address the dedication audience on "Better Living from Better Forests."

Protected Land

The Uhrenholdt Memorial forest is a tract of forested land which has been protected by its owners for nearly half a century. It will be dedicated to its original owner, Soren Uhrenholdt, and a son and grandson who died in the world wars.

Over 90 wooded acres of the Uhrenholdt farm have been purchased by the Wisconsin conservation commission and will be operated as a demonstration forest following the protective practices carried out by the Uhrenholdt family. A tract of heavily timbered land amounting to ten acres has been deeded by the heirs to the commission as a permanent memorial.

Living Tribute

"The Uhrenholdt Memorial forest is a living and lasting tribute to pioneers and patriots," declared Arthur L. Hanson, chairman of the Sawyer county board of supervisors. "It was foresight combined with the spirit of the pioneer which prompted the protection for nearly half a century of a tract of pine too young for the lumberman's ax in the hey-day of logging. This young pinery provided a part-time income while it grew to the stature of a forest."

Hans C. Hanson, Sawyer Pioneer Leader, Dies

(Special to The Telegram.)

HAYWARD.—Hans C. Hanson, 86, well known Sawyer county leader for many years died at his home at Oxbo, on Wednesday.

He came to this county in May 1898 from Norway, Wis., a small settlement near Waterford. He came to Park Falls and made himself a dugout in Ojibwa where he explored that part of the territory, then all wilderness. He then floated down the Flambeau river in a crude boat which he made and which is now on display at the roadside park near Ojibwa, he landed at what is now known as Oxbo.

He homesteaded his place there then known as the town of Hayward. It was later changed to the town of Winter and now it is known as the town of Draper. He built his own school and hired a teacher. When the town of Draper was started he was elected town chairman and school director for 17 years.

He was a very active member of the Sawyer county board. He followed the profession of being a carpenter. He also built many bridges and roads in this county. He and his wife operated a resort on the Flambeau river and are the oldest settlers in that community.

The remains were removed from the Lester Anderson funeral home in Hayward, on Friday noon to lay in state at the family residence at Oxbo, until Saturday, when it was removed to Fifield, where services were held at 2 p. m. at the Congregational church there. Rev. B. P. Schoenfeld officiating. Interment took place in Fifield.

Survivors are his wife Nellie of Oxbo; three daughters, Mrs. Ruth Boury of Winter, Mrs. Mayme Christianson of Cornell, Wis., and Lucille Jackson of Wauwatosa; four sons, Arthur of Owen, William of Chippewa Falls, Harold and Elmer of Oxbo; 21 grandchildren, and 6 great grandchildren.

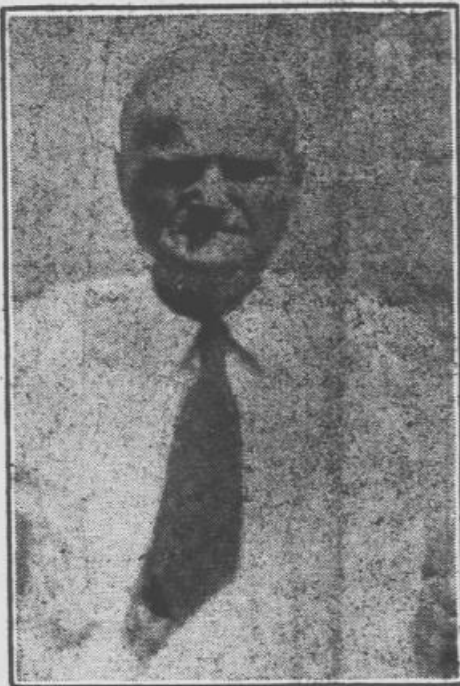

John Felch, 94, Twin Cities' last surviving veteran of the Civil war, died at a few minutes after 6 o'clock this morning at the home of a niece, Mrs. Joseph Burnett, 124 N. Lincoln avenue, Fond du Lac, where he had been living since June of last year. His daughter and two sons reached Menasha early today on their way to their father's bedside but received message from Fond du Lac, while

partaking of breakfast at the home of Mr. and Mrs. William Egan, 320 Chute street, telling of Mr. Felch's death. He had suffered from a slight cold since Monday and death was attributed to complications incident to his advanced age.

Mr. Felch was born Nov. 5, 1845, in the state of New York, and entered service in the Civil War in 1860, at the age of 15 years. He served in the army for four years and six months, attaining the rank of sergeant in the Fourteenth Wisconsin cavalry.

He was married in 1869 at Green Bay to Viola Ketchum. She died in 1933. Since the death of his wife, up to the time he went to Fond du Lac, Mr. Felch had made his home with his niece, Mrs. Egan, in Menasha. He was a member of the local post of the G. A. R., and, despite his advanced age, took an active part in all local patriotic observances of a public nature while he resided here. Together with the late Thad Sheerin, of Neenah, he represented the last survivor of the Grand Army of the Republic in Menasha and Neenah.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. H. C. Hansen, of Draper, Wis.; two sons, George and William Felch, of Fifiel, Wis., and 12 grandchildren.

Short services will be held Saturday evening at 8 o'clock in the Dugan funeral home at Fond du Lac and the body will be taken that evening to Fifiel, where funeral services will be held Monday afternoon at the Congregational church. Burial will be at Fifiel.

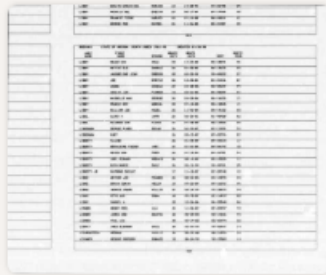

Park Falls Young Man Falls from Boat into the Water

While in bathing, escaping from the intense heat which prevailed at Park Falls the past week, Louis Schavet, one of that city's best known young men, was drowned in the Flambeau river. While the water was very rough, it was not considered dangerous. He had gone out alone in a small row boat and when about fifty feet from shore it is thought that the rocking of the boat in the waves caused him to lose his balance and he fell overboard. The young man could not swim and before several of his friends could reach him he had gone under. Mr. Schavet was well known in this city.

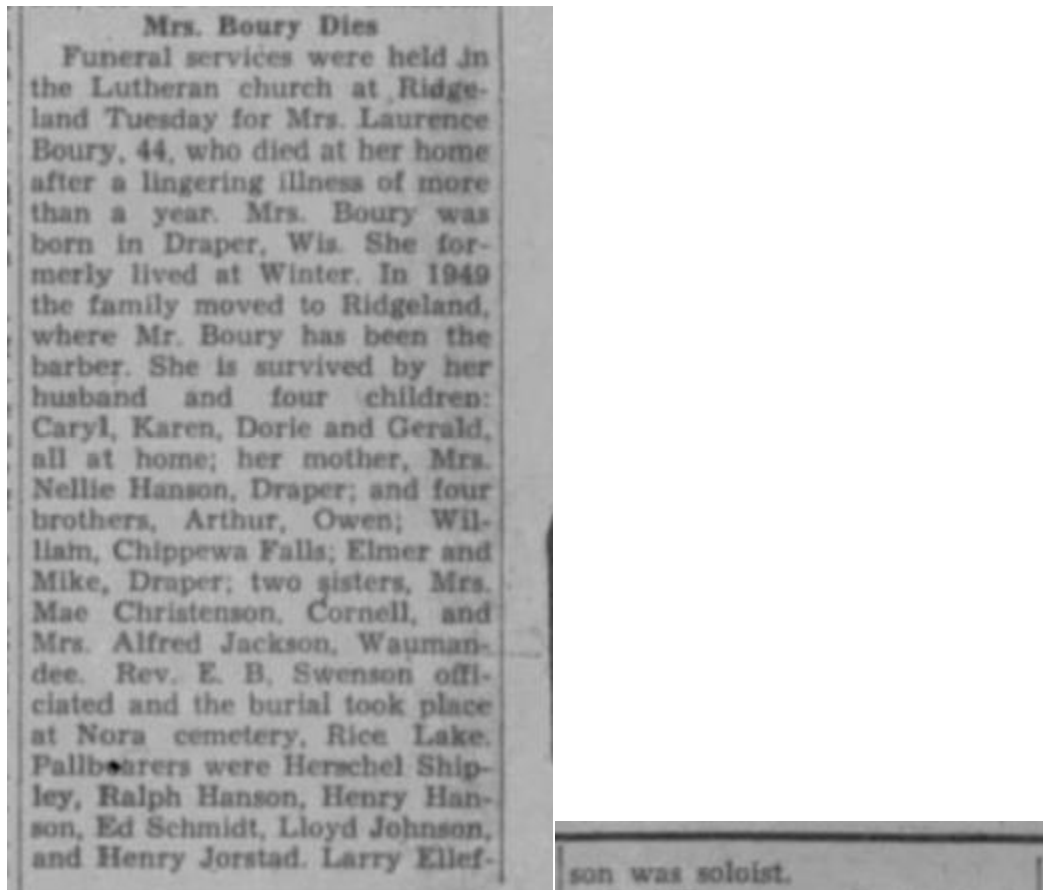

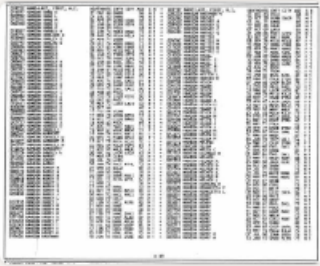

Mamie was age 21, a resident of Draper WI, born in Draper WI, daughter of Hans Hanson & Nellie Felch; also her 1st marriage - Buried in Acacia Park Cemetery, Mendota Heights, Dakota MN. F; 103236365.
- **Harold Merlin Hanson**, 4 Dec 1912 Draper, Sawyer WI – 22 Dec 1962 WI (according to the WI death record) or in the Veterans Administration hospital in Iron Mountain, Dickinson MI. - In 1940, he lived with his parents (Hans, 78 & Nellie, 63) in Draper, Sawyer WI with stepbrother Elmer Diener, 36. - On his WWII draft card (1942) Harold lived in Loretta, Sawyer WI; his NOK was his father Hans Hanson. – On 5 Apr 1946 in Paducah, McCracken KY, Harold married Iva Gertrude Gough (1924-1979, F: 93342734). - In his father’s 1947 obituary, Harold lived in Oxbo WI. – Might he be the “Mike Hanson” listed in Ruth’s Feb 1953 obituary? – Harold lived in Oxbo, Draper, Sawyer WI until 1962 when he moved to Norwalk OH. - Buried in Loretta-Draper Cemetery, Loretta, Sawyer WI. - **Lila Vera Hanson**, 26 Sep 1919 Draper, Sawyer WI– 14 Jun 1921 Draper, Sawyer WI (according to WI death record – which lists her as Vera Hanson - or 13 Jun 1921 according to obituary) – Died of “heart trouble” according to her obituary.

- **Bertrand Diener**, 8 Jun 1905 Fifield, Price WI – 2 Jul 1905 Fifield, Price WI. - His WI birth record lists his father as Herman Diener (b. Milwaukee WI) & mother Nellie (b. Green Bay WI. - His WI death record lists his death in 1905. - Although the name Bertrand is on WI birth notice, his Find A Grave record reads “Bertraud.” = Died at age 24 days. – Buried in Forest Home Cemetery, Fifield, Price WI. F: 46175317.
- **Leonard E. Diener**, 9 Jun 1906 Fifield, Price WI – . On his WI birth certificate, he is listed as the son of Nellie E. Felch & Thomas Diener. His father Herman John Diener had died 27 Jan 1906.
