LOVE COUNTY BOYS ON TORPEDOED BOAT

Some of the horrors of war were brought home to Love County people last week when it was learned that several Love County boys were on the Transport, Tuscania, which was torpedoed while enroute to France.

The boys aboard the transport were, Noah Milliken of Enville, Lon Harris of Marsden and C. E. Moore of Pike. They were all saved and the first reliable information of their safety was conveyed to this place by a telegram from Congressman C. D. Carter at Washington, to the effect that all Love County boys on board the vessel were safe. Later dispatches from the War Department to the relatives of the boys told of their safety.

The two former boys were among those who went from this county in the first draft and the latter volunteered.

I was unlucky June the 15 and got a piece of high explosive in the side but am well and trying to get a few more of those sour kraut devils. Oh, say isn't old Leroy lucky. Here is hoping he don't have to cross. Lon Harris is over here some where but I have not been able to find him yet. Old John Logan is lucky so far, but Sam Black got it about the same time I got mine or a little worse but think he will make it all right.

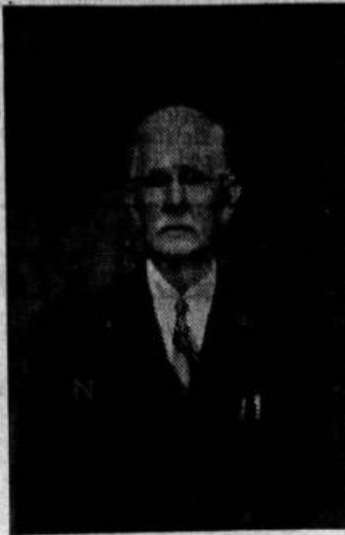

Funeral Rites For Pioneer Are Held Thursday

Ardmore and Carter county lost one of its oldest pioneers Tuesday when Rev. G. W. Whitfield died at his home here. Rev. Whitfield, a retired Baptist minister, came to Oklahoma in 1888 and spent the

remainder of his life around Ardmore, in Carter and Love counties.

Whitfield was born August 7, 1869 in Little Rock, Arkansas. He was ordained a Baptist preacher August 13, 1907, at Weatherford, Texas, where he pastored his first church.

His children recall how their father rode his horse to small community churches every Sunday to preach. Finally he acquired a horse and buggy, and rode to church in style. After many years, his horse and buggy gave way to a horseless carriage, and up to the end, he drove his faithful old car wherever he went somewhere to preach.

On September 25, 1892, he married Viola Matlock, and together they raised 10 children—eight of their own, and two orphan boys. They had nine children, but lost one, Lou Guilla, when she was one year old. Their daughters are Mrs. Willie M. Leaf and Mrs. G. C. McConnell, Ardmore, Mrs. Vida Hartman and Mrs. Lennie Martin, Oklahoma City, Mrs. Harry Cuff, Fox, and Mrs. Vada Lummus, Odessa, Texas. O. W. Whitfield, Odessa, Texas, and H. H. Whitfield, Ardmore, are their sons. The orphan boys they raised are Olen and Nolan Lummus, Odessa, Texas.

Rev. Whitfield was superintendent of the Baptist orphans home when it was at Chickasha for several years, and up until just recently, taught the Men's Bible class at the First Orthodox Baptist church.

Eight years ago, a heart attack forced his retirement from pastoral work, but he continued to work as a local missionary, preaching in small rural churches in Carter and Love counties. His children say they believe he has preached at nearly every country church in the two counties.

Fittingly, his last sermon was delivered on his 80th birthday, 43 years almost to the day after he was ordained. The sermon was preached in the Orthodox Baptist church, where he was a member, and a great number of friends and relatives gathered to hear him in his last sermon.

He is survived by 19 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren in addition to a large number of friends. His wife, the model preacher's wife—patient, forbearing, and always ready to change her own plans if necessary—said of his life:

"He lived a full life for the Lord."

Funeral services for Rev. Whitfield will be Thursday afternoon at 2:00 in the First Orthodox Baptist church. Rev. R. J. Anderson, former pastor of the church, will be in charge. Pallbearers will be J. Dewey Clemens, J. E. Martin, O. E. Brown, James R. Cox, J. Lee Davis and Sam P. McCullough.
