DEADLINE IS ESTABLISHED

Astoria Fisherman Convicted of Violating Sunday Law.

ASTORIA, Ore.—Jacob Hendrickson, gillnetter, was found guilty by a circuit court jury last week on a charge of fishing for salmon in the Columbia river during the Sunday closed period.

The feature of the case was the ruling of the court as to the location of the deadline at the mouth of the Columbia river. The defendant claimed he was fishing outside the three-mile limit and was not within the jurisdiction of the state. Judge Eakin held that the jurisdiction of the state extends three statutory miles west of the ordinary low-tide mark, as it exists at the present time, including any territory that may have been added by the currents resulting from the construction of the jetties.

This is the first time the circuit court has passed on this question.

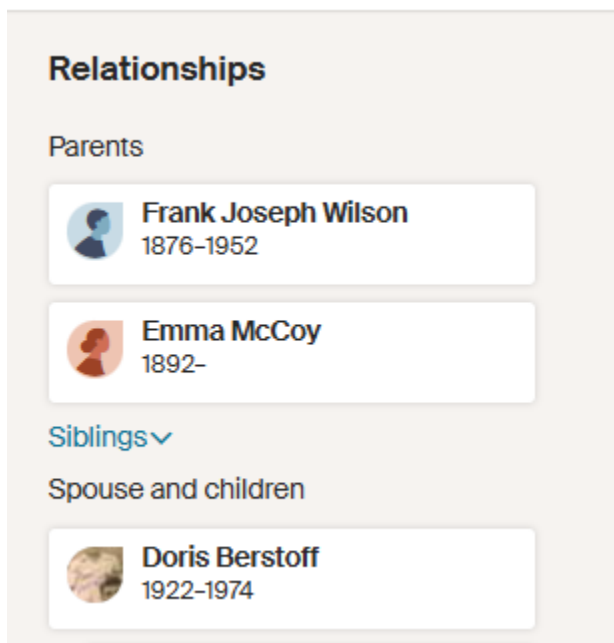

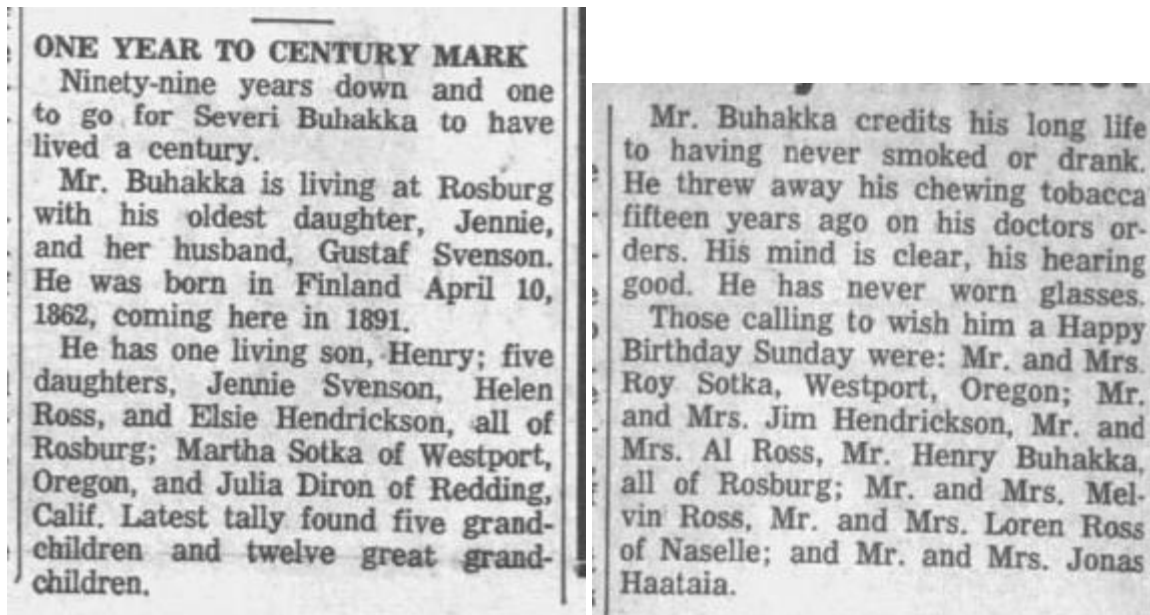

Onalaskan Deciphers Tale In Bottle

The story of a young fisherman lost at sea is the tale unfolded in a letter written in Russian and found by an Onalaska woman last year in the ice of the Bristol Bay area of Alaska.

Friends have been asking Mrs.

Dean Hamilton of Onalaska for a year now what her Russian letter said. It has taken that long for her to find someone to translate the letter she found in March, 1967, in a bottle frozen in the ice at Pilot Point, Alaska, where she was visiting her 83-year-old grandfather, Gus Griechen. Mrs. Hamilton was born in Pilot Point but had not lived or visited there for a number of years.

Translators for the icebound letter are Mr. and Mrs. Joe Generalov of Winlock who came to this country from Russia. The couple found the letter dated as July 6, but without a year. They speculate the letter is written on a page torn from a log book. The signature is that

of Mokcemova Anne of Vladivostok, Siberia.

The translation reads:

"Hello! How do you do. Now, last letter to you that I'm writing friends. We are drowning. We ran into a cliff. I already have fished three years and things didn't go right for me. Our boat broken upon the cliff and I'm still young. I'm only 20 years old and I don't want to die young. It's a big problem. Anybody that finds this not, I'm a fisherman and no one should be a fisherman. I'm thinking more now that someone will find this letter, and please copy this letter and write to my mother and let her know. She's the only one I have in the world. Good by friends, bye."

Lifelong Alaskan and Pilot Point resident Gust William "Ace" Griechen Jr., 78, died July 9, 2009, at Alaska Native Medical Center in Anchorage.

A service was held July 14 at Dago Creek with Dan Buckwalter officiating. A celebration of Ace's life took place in the Pilot Point School gymnasium. Pallbearers were Neil Nelson, Timothy Jefferies, Jay Kingsley, Dennis Griechen, Dustin Tracy and Hoyt

Ogle. Honorary pallbearers were Gust Griechen IV, Brandon Tracy, Travis Tracy, Austin Kingsley and Bryce Kingsley.

Ace was born Sept. 23, 1930, the youngest of six siblings.

He was the first pilot hired by his beloved Peninsula Airways and the first in the number of fish he caught over his sons and stepsons.

He was married twice and raised two sons, then six stepchildren, three extra children, 22 grandchildren and an untold number of others who called him "Grandpa." He fished in the sailboat days, and counted most of the bears, wolves, caribou, moose and swans on the Alaska Peninsula.

At the beginning of statehood, he racked up countless hours in Pen Air aircraft, flying 12- to 16-hour days.

Ace built at least six homes in Pilot Point, three other large buildings such as airplane hangars and many other small buildings.

He learned to ballroom dance; filled 25 albums of world stamps; fixed numerous broken-down cars, trucks, boats and airplane engines; had five or six great dogs and six cats; and owned two grocery stores.

Ace proudly served two years in the U.S. Army.

His family wrote, "Ace had countless friends, nephews and nieces, one boss and, most important of all, one savior."

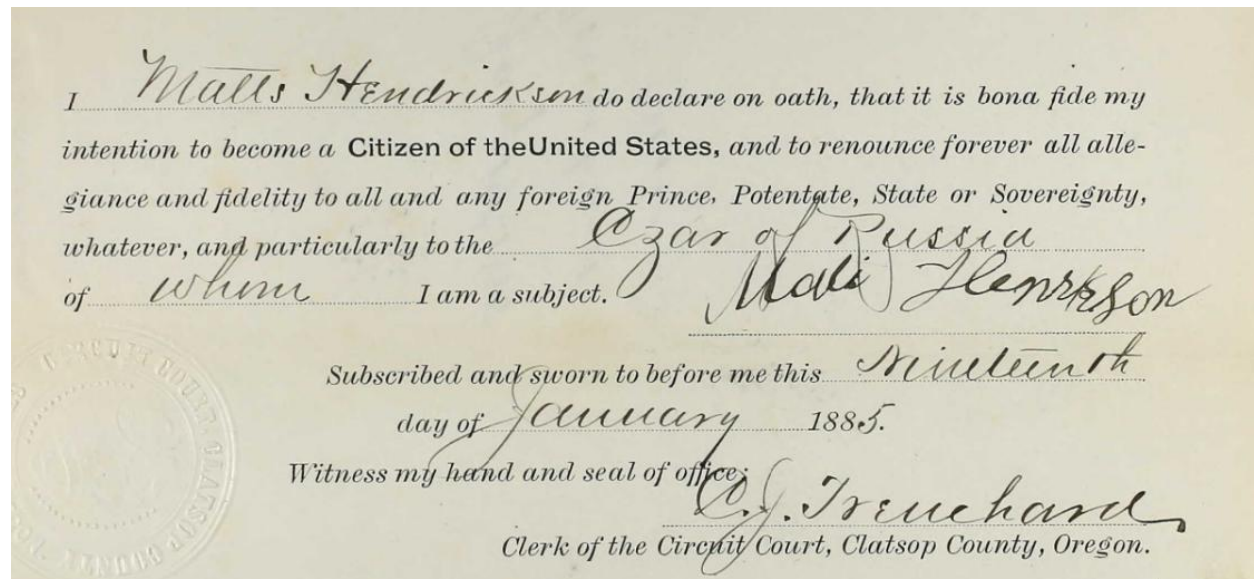

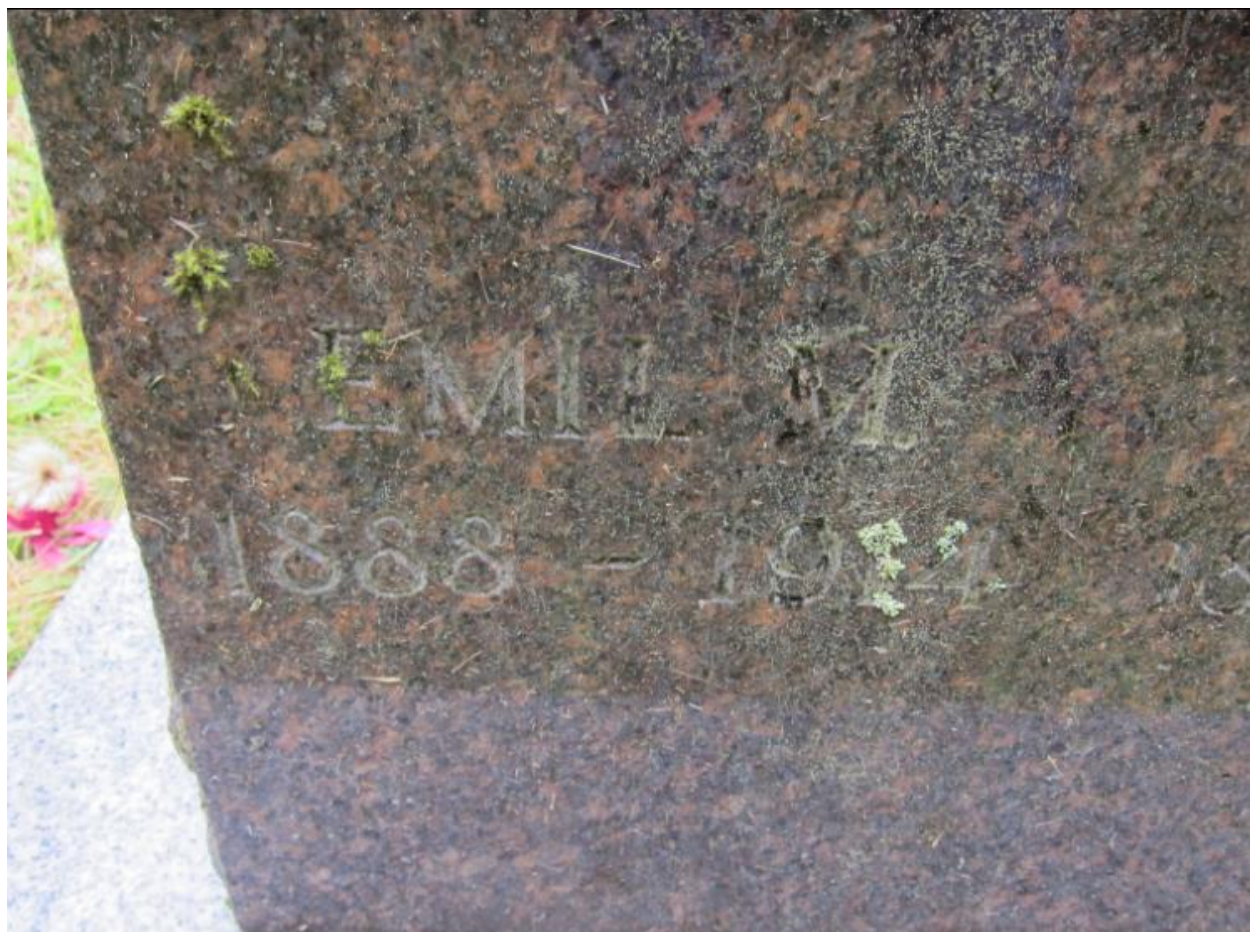

- According to Social Security records, her name becomes Anna Margurite **Griechen** in Jun 1956. Her husband appears to be Gust William ("Ace") Griechen Jr., son of Gus Griechen, a German immigrant, born 30 Sep 1883 Stettein (likely Stettin), Germany & Aglaphena Olga Griechen.
- **Gust William Griechen Jr.** was born 23 Sep 1930 in Pilot Point AK & died 9 Jul 2009 Anchorage AK. His last residence was in Pilot Point AK. His obituary indicates he was married twice, but does not name his wives.
- In the 1930 census for Kvichak, Third Judicial District, Alaska Territory, conducted 9-10 Jun 1930: apparently Gus's previous wife
- Gus Griechen, 47 Germany, parents b. Germany, emigrated 1905, alien, watchman, salmon cannery
- Olga, 25 Aleut, parents Aleut, housework, own home [wife]
- And their children, all born Aleut/mixed race – Anna (15), Alice (9), Aleck (8), Mary (6), Sophia (4) & Eli (2)
- The 1940 census for Pilot Station, Third Judicial District, Alaska Territory, conducted 10-11 Jan 1940, in 1935 living in Alaska, shows Gust with an earlier wife:
- Gust GIRECHEN, 56 Germany, naturalized, watchman, salmon cannery
- Aglaphone, 34 AK, Aleut, salmon ---, salmon cannery [wife]
- And children Alice M. (18, fish trap, salmon), Aleck V. (16, fisherman, salmon cannery), Mary A. (15), Sophie G. (13), Eli E. (11) & William Gust Jr. (9).
- Anna & Gust's son Harold Gene Griechen (born Apr 1954) becomes the personal representative of his mother's estate after her death in 1995. Another son was Harold Griechen.
- According to Social Security records, her name becomes Anna Margurite **Tracy** in Mar 1960. Her husband is listed in online genealogies as **Stanley Edward Tracy**, (24 Apr 1937 Pyatt, Marion AR – 21 Apr 1993 Clinton, Henry MO). He was the son of James Timothy Tracy & Sarah Jane Gather. Stanley is buried in Benton Green Cemetery, Roscoe, St. Clair MO, F: 66172063.
- Anna & Stanley's son was Darrel Craig Tracy, 2 Mar 1960 Kansas City, Jackson MO – 29 Sep 2009 Anchorage AK.
- According to Social Security records, her name becomes "Anna Mar. **Orloff**" in Jan 1970. She is listed as surviving daughter Anna Orloff on her father Jacob Hendrickson's Feb 1971 obituary.
- Anna's husband appears to be Matt Orloff, 23 Jan 1940 Illnik AK – 24 Mar 1972 Anchorage AK. One of his obituaries found does not mention a wife; the other mentions widow Anna. Oddly, a newspaper account reporting a divorce between Matt and Anna M. Orloff announces it occurred 21 Apr 1972. Perhaps they were in the process of divorcing when Matt died?
- Anna seems to revert to the surname **Tracy** & is listed as surviving stepdaughter Anna Tracy of Pilot Point, Alaska, in her stepmother Elsie Hendrickson's Mar 1993 obituary. She is listed in Social Security records on 14 Aug 1995 as Anna M. Tracy.

Mary may have taken the surname Hendrickson after her mother married/became involved with Jacob Hendrickson. – Social Security records her name as Mary Joy Hendrickson in Jul 1946. – Social Security lists her name as Mary Joy Shanigan as of Nov 1959. She was the wife of Nicholai (Nick) Shanigan Jr. (5 May 1925 Kanstak AK – 5 Nov 1998, in a car accident in Anchorage AK). – Mary Shanigan of Pilot Rock, Alaska, was listed in Jacob's 1971 obituary. – Social Security lists her as Mary Joy Apalone in Sep 1961 & as Mary J. Abalama as of 6 Jan 1976. – Online claims that she was also married to William Deville Smith (1919-1997) should be verified, as the data is questionable.

Matti's heirs as listed as his surviving children Henry, Herman, Oscar, Anna & Jacob. Although Hugo is alive, he is not listed as one of the heirs.
- Husband of **Sophia/Sopha Jarvi** (b. 1883) whom he married 5 Sep 1907 in Astoria, Clatsop OR. She was alive in the 1920 census for Crooked Creek, Wahkiakum Co. WA. Conducted 24 Jan 1920, Oscar HENDRICKSEN, 38 Finland, parents b. Finland, emigrated 1901, papers filed 1919, is a farmer. In his household are wife Sophie (37 Finland, parents b. Finland) & daughter Ida (11 OR) & hired man Antacor Marki (23 Finland). Sophie is alive in the 1930 census for Seattle, King WA. In the 1940 Seattle, King WA census, Oscar Hendrickson, age 56 Finland, reports he is single.
- Hugo's daughter Ida Hendrickson was born 23 May 1908.
- As Oscar Hendrickson, he petitions to become a citizen on 7 Jul 1943 & declares his intent to become a citizen on 7 Jul 1943 in US District Court, Western District of WA. Oscar says he arrived under the name of Hugo Henrikson on 19 Mar 1911 in NY. He was born 21 Feb 1883 in Wiborg, Wiborg, Finland. He says he is not married & resides at 2026 – 14th W., Seattle WA. He swore his oath of allegiance on 12 Aug 1944. No parental information is included.
- Cause of death: coronary occlusion. His WA death record reports his father was Matt Hendrickson & his mother was "Anna" (no surname).
- Cremated at Washelli Cemetery, Seattle, King WA. Not on Find A Grave as of 2 Aug 2026.

Shares a tombstone with his father Matt. Buried as Emil M. Hendrickson, 1888-1914, in Deep River Cemetery, Deep River, Wahkiakum WA. F: 21707247
- **Herman Albert Hendrickson**, 8 Feb 1890 Astoria, Clatsop OR [born in WA according to his WA death certificate] – 4 Feb 1969 Aberdeen, Grays Harbor WA. - Named as heir Herman Hendrickson, age 40, of Ilwaco WA in his father Matti Hendrickson's will, filed in Pacific Co. WA on 18 Jul 1930. Husband of **Signa/Signo/Signe Emile/Emily Hill** (1892-1942, F: 61382809) whom he married 27 Dec 1911 in Pacific Co. WA. – His WA death record lists his mother as Ann Rosevald & his father as Matt Hendrickson. - Buried in Fern Hill Cemetery, Aberdeen, Grays Harbor WA. F: 142754166
- **Oscar Sanfred/Sanfreed/Sanford Antiavaara Hendrickson**, 30 Dec 1891 Deep River, Wahkiakum WA – 13 Mar 1966 Raymond, Pacific WA. - Records list his mother's maiden name as Kaitala. - Named as heir O.S. Hendrickson, age 38, of Raymond WA in his father Matti Hendrickson's will, filed in Pacific Co. WA on 18 Jul 1930. Husband of **Fannie Mary Niemi Huhta**. (1891-1979, F: 104615857). – Fannie Niemi, age 20, b. Finland, parents b. Finland, housekeeper married 21 Aug 1909 to Isaac Huhta, age 25, b. Finland, parents b. Finland. – In the 1910 census for Portland, Multnomah OR, Isaac Huhta (23 Finland, parents b. Finland, lumberman in a sawmill, lived with wife Fannie (21 Finland. – This census was conducted 2 & 3 Apr 1910. The couple said they had been married zero years, 1st marriage for both. - Isaac Victor Huhta (3 Aug 1884 Finland – 27 Jun 1949 Portland, Multnomah OR, F: 252226516). - Oscar married Fannie Huhta on 18 Dec 1916 in Cochise Co. AZ & they are a married couple in the 1920 census (conducted 15/16 Jan 1920). - Buried in Fern Hill Cemetery, Menlo, Pacific WA. F: 104615830
- **Anna Maria Hendrickson (Thompson) Elm**, 4 Jul 1895 Astoria, Clatsop OR – 19 Jan 1978 Fairhaven, Bristol MA. - In the 1910 census, Anna M. Thompson, age 14, WA, is listed as the adopted daughter of Erik Thompson (52 Finland, b. Dec 1847) & Sophia Thompson (42 Finland, Nov 1857). Sophia indicates she has not given birth to any children. Erik is a fisherman; Sophia is a midwife. – As Anna M. Thompson, she married 6 Aug 1913 in Astoria, Clatsop OR to **David Joakim Elm (Posti/Pusti)**, 1884 Finland – 1971 MI. He was a minister. Rev. Elm is buried in Lakeside Cemetery, Hancock, Houghton MI, F: 178240682. – Named as heir Anna Hendrickson Elm, age 35, of Helsingfors, Finland, in her father Matti Hendrickson's will, filed in Pacific Co. WA on 18 Jul 1930. When her brother Jacob died in Feb 1971, she was listed as Mrs. Dave Elm of Chassel MI in his obituary.
- **Lempi A. Hendrickson**, 1897 Wahkiakum Co. WA – 1897 Deep River, Wahkiakum WA. - Buried in Deep River Cemetery, Deep River, Wahkiakum WA. She shares a tombstone with mother Anna & sister Jennie. F: 21707215

Notes:

There is a lack of information on this family.

- Some of it may stem from the availability of records online for the Alaska Territory, including newspaper files.
- Some of it may stem from the numerous immigrants from Finland in the area of WA where this Hendrickson family lived, and the repetition of names like Matti and Anna.
- Part of it stems from the fact that both of Matti Hendrickson's wives were named Anna.

Notes on Ancestry.com family trees say the children were adopted by the Thompsons. Anna Maria Hendrickson was.
