Father: Columbus Lorenzo Hogle, Jan 1853 Pike River township, Quebec, Canada – 22 Jul 1937 San Diego Co. CA.

Son of Horatio May Hogle (b. 22 May 1823 Quebec, Canada) & Lydia Elizabeth Darling (20 May 1825-17 Aug 1892, buried in Sierraville Cemetery, Sierraville, Sierra CA, F: 24927925).

Columbus's father Horatio (also known as Henry M.) Hogle was a veteran of the US Civil War, fighting for the Union as a private in the 20th Regiment, Connecticut Infantry, Co. I.

Resident as of 11 Apr 1930 when census was taken of residents of Frederica Home for the Aged in Chula Vista CA. In Jan 1934, the Frederica Home residents celebrated Columbus's Jan birthday.

His first wife was Evelyn Angeline Palmer (1873). They had a daughter Edith Darling Hogle, who died at age 2 years. Evelyn & Columbus evidently divorced, as both remarried.

Columbus then married Nellie May Pratt (ca. 1877).

Her daughter Edith Darling Hogle with Columbus Hogle died at age 3 months on 8 Dec 1885.

Apparently before her daughter was born, Evelyn Hogle, age 32, had married Albert Alonzo Longley, age 31, on 7 Sep 1885 in Boston, Suffolk MA. Evelyn said she was born in Waterville VT to Francis E. & Elizabeth Palmer & this was her 2nd marriage. Albert, a clerk, said he was born in Boston MA to Francis E. & Elizabeth Longley. This was his 1st marriage. Both bride & groom were residents of Boston MA. However, in the 1900 census, the couple reports that Albert is age 33 & Evelyn age 47, a 14-year age gap.

Albert was born 25 Dec 1854 in Boston, Suffolk MA to Francis E. Longley & Elizabeth Parkin. He died in 1933 & was buried 1 Nov 1933 in Mount Auburn Cemetery, Cambridge, Middlesex MA, F: 190567719.

Evelyn's son by Albert Longley was Edwin Percy Longley (born 13 Aug 1887 Topsfield, Essex MA).

The 2nd wife of Columbus Hogle.

She was living at 185 Third Ave., Chula Vista CA when son Raymond died in Oct 1931.

CA. – In Jul 1911 in CA, Marie Hogle obtained a marriage license & married **Herbert Hiram Daley** (listed in the newspaper account as “Hubert H. Daley” of Lafayette CA, son of J.M. Daley). Herbert Hiram Daley (27 Jun 1887 Moraga, Contra Costa CA – 6 Nov 1958 Pittsburg, Contra Costa CA, buried in Memory Gardens, Concord, Contra Costa CA, F: 83244223). Herbert was the son of James Marion Daley (1845-1923, F: 21928319) & Elizabeth Jane Hunsaker (1849-1941, F: 21928318). Herbert is buried with wife Cora Amelia Root (1896-1986, F: 83244184) whom he married 4 Jul 1917. - Wife of **Claude D. Gore** (15 May 1894 Coles Co. IL-12 Feb 1980 San Diego Co. CA, F: 145996388, buried in Glen Abbey Memorial Park, Bonita, San Diego CA). - Her obituary appeared in the “Chula Vista (CA) Star News” Thursday 12 Nov 1964 p 7 (copied above). She died at age 76 in a convalescent home. She was a resident of 499 Hilltop Dr., Chula Vista CA. Retired superintendent of the Fredericka Home for the Aged in Chula Vista (where her parents lived in 1930). Survived by her husband Claude, daughter & granddaughter. - Buried in Forest Lawn Memorial Park, Glendale, Los Angeles CA. F: 85410690
- **Hester May Hogle Hill**, 13 Sep 1892 Sierra Co. CA – 13 Sep 1990 San Diego Co. CA. - SSN 559-48-4225. - Wife of **Clyde Vernon Hill** (29 Jul 1892 Houlton, Aroostock ME- 30 May 1951 Imperial Co. CA, F: 291271539). Hester & Clyde married between the 1910 & 1920 censuses. Their 1st child Margaret was born 5 Jan 1914. – Buried in Greenwood Memorial Park, San Diego, San Diego CA. F: 291271363
- **Hilda Joice Hogle Oliver Andrikides/Andros Sandmire**, 29 Apr 1895 Sierra Co. CA – 3 May 1951 Spokane, Spokane WA (in St. Luke's Hospital). – Married **Edward Frank Oliver** in Mar 1913, obtaining a marriage license in San Diego CA. Edward Frank Oliver was age 21 & Hilda “Joyce” Hogle was age 18, both residents of La Mesa, San Diego Co. CA. - “St. Helena (CA) Star” 7 Apr 1933 p 7 – 20 years ago [i.e. Apr 1913] Miss Hilda Hogle, formerly of St. Helena, married O.E. Oliver in San Diego CA [error in husband's name]. – Edward Frank Oliver was born 14 Oct 1891 & died 13 Jul 1965. He is buried in Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery, San Diego, San Diego CA, F: 3422319. On 26 Jun 1929, Edward F. Oliver (37, of La Mesa CA) married Lillian M. Smith (31, of San Diego CA). - Hilda then married **Nikolas (Nicholas) “Nick” Demetrios Andrikides**. In Mar 1922, in Los Angeles CA, Hilda Hogle, age 27, b. CA, obtained a marriage license with Nick Anrikides, age 32, born Smyrna [the former name of Izmir, Turkey]. Both were residents of Los Angeles CA. - In Jan 1924 in Los Angeles Co. CA,

when Hilda applied to be naturalized – as this was a time when US citizens who married noncitizens lost their US citizenship – her surname was Andros. When she married Sandmire, her surname was Andros. – Nicholas D. Andros was born 26 Oct 1889 in Turkey & died 13 Sep 1972 CA, buried in Forest Lawn Memorial Park, Glendale, Los Angeles CA, F: 85339145, with his wife Artemis Maithonis (1892-1980 whom he married in 1935. – Wife of **Lee Frankin (“Frank”) Sandmire**, son of Alexander (Aleck) M. Sandmire (1858 WI – 1945 WA, F: 244181959) & Alldula Bennett. Lee survived Hilda Hogle. – Lee was born 20 Jan 1891 in Mayfield, Lewis WA & died 21 Jun 1967 in Aberdeen, Grays Harbor WA. His body was cremated at Fern Hill Crematory in Aberdeen WA. – Complicating research is the situation that Lee Franklin Sandmire’s first wife was also named Hilda – Hilda Selah, daughter of Robert Selah & Rose Helmrich. Lee & Hilda Selah married 22 Nov 1912 in Spokane, Spokane WA. – Hilda Selah Sandmire was born 1894 & died 10 Dec 1927 in Spokane, Spokane WA & is buried in Riverside Memorial Park, Spokane, Spokane WA, F: 140067466. – Frank Sandmire (36) & Hilda H. Andros (33) obtained a marriage license in Los Angeles Co. CA in Feb 1929. According to the CA marriage record, they married 5 Mar 1929 in Los Angeles Co. CA. – Three months later, on 23 Jun 1929, Lee Franklin Sandmire, aka “Frank,” entered the WA State Penitentiary after pleading guilty to a charge of incest. His sentence out of Spokane Co. WA was for 7-10 years. His occupation was barber, his residence Spokane WA. If he served the maximum term, he would be released 17 Jun 1939. If he served the minimum term, he would be released 17 Jun 1936. He applied for parole in Mar 1931, Sep 1931, Mar 1933, Jun 1933 & Jun 1934. Lee was paroled 30 Nov 1934. – While Lee was in prison, Hilda resided with his parents, at least when the 1930 census for Spokane, Spokane WA was conducted 7 Apr 1930. Alexander M. Sandmire (71 WI, father b. Germany, mother b. England, 1st married at age 24) lived at 613 Crestline St. His household included his wife Alice (72 IN, father b. PA, mother b. IN, age 25 at 1st marriage, employed in a restaurant) & daughter-in-law Hilda Sandmire (age unknown, b. CA, father b. MA, mother b. CA, age 18 at 1st marriage, waitress, status: married.) – In the 1935 Spokane WA city directory, residing at 613 Crestline were Alex M. Sandmire & Mrs. Hilda J. Sandmire. – In the 1940 census for Spokane, Spokane WA, conducted 6 Apr 1940, living at 613 Crestline were Lee F. Sandmire (47 WA, barber), wife Hilda (45 CA), son Donald L. (3 WA) & father Alexander (81 WI, widowed). – In the 1950 census for Spokane, Spokane WA, living at 613 E. Springfield, were Lee F. Sandmire (57 WA, in the bottling division at a brewery), wife Hilda J. (54 CA) & son Donald L. (13 WA). Obituaries in the “Spokane (WA) Chronicle” 4 May 1951 p 15 & “Spokane (WA) Spokesman-Review” 7 May 1951 p 11 copied above. Resident of N613 Crestline. – Cause of death: subarachnoid hemorrhage” (a type of stroke). Her WA death record lists her mother’s maiden name as “Potts” instead of Pratt. – It appears Lee F. Sandmire married Violet G. Mertens on 3 Nov 1961 in Kootenai Co. ID. – Hilda’s body was cremated (or, as 1951 language termed it, “incinerated.”)

- **Edith Darling Hogle**, 28 Oct 1875 Boston, Suffolk MA – 8 Dec 1877 Boston, Suffolk MA. – A family history found online cites her death as occurring 8 Dec 1877 at 131 Poplar St.. The header on the page of her MA death record indicates Edith died in the year 1875, but she was age 2 years, 1 month & 8 days, which makes the 1877 date accurate. She died of diphtheria. – Buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, Everett, Middlesex MA. F: 284181516
